<u>Summary</u>: Eric Malkin is a current at-large member of the Fair Housing/Equal Employment Board. He was re-appointed to the board on January 11, 2011 to complete a term that expires on January 9, 2013. Mr. Malkin has expressed an interest in reappointment and has met the attendance requirement during his current term. The board is composed of nine (9) members. Seven members are district appointments and two (2) are at-large. The Ordinances require that the appointees should reflect, to the greatest extent possible, representation from the protected groups identified in the Ordinances and who have experience and interest in equal opportunities. The board meets quarterly. A memorandum was sent to the Board of County Commissioners on October 12, 2012. Countywide (DO)

Background and Justification: The Board of County Commissioners enacted Ordinances 95-31 and Ordinance 90-1, as codified in Sections 2-261 through 2-313 of the Palm Beach County Code and Sections 15-36 through 15-64, respectively, establishing the Fair Housing/Equal Employment Board. This board serves as a quasi-judicial body empowered to hear and decide upon the merits of employment and housing discrimination complaints investigated by the Office of Equal Opportunity. The board meets quarterly. The Board currently consists of 8 members and there is a District 6 appointment vacancy. The current makeup of the Board is: Caucasian: 5 (62%), African American: 2 (25%) and Hispanic: 1 (13%). The gender ratio (female: male) is: 4:4. This nominee is a Caucasian male.

Pursuant to the Policies and Procedures Manual Board Appointments, the Department requested that the Chair and members of the Board of County Commissioners submit nominees to for this at-large position.

Since "Retirement", Eric has dedicated the past several years to various areas of community service. Currently, he is a Volunteer in the Office of the Statewide Prosecutor for Prescription Drugs and serves on the Fair Housing and Equal Employment Opportunity Board for Palm Beach County, having been appointed in early 2010 to fill an at-large seat by the County Commission; the State Attorney's Ad Hoc Advisory Board and State Senator Maria Sachs' Blue Ribbon Committees for Education, Emergency Planning and Health Care. I. AUTHORITY:

Ordinance No. 90-1 adopted January 31, 1990, as amended by Ordinance No. 95-31 adopted on August 15, 1995; as amended by Ordinance No. 95-42 adopted October 17, 1995; as amended by Ordinance 07-042, adopted December 18, 2007.

II. APPOINTING BODY:

Board of County Commissioners

III. COMPOSITION.QUALIFICATIONS.TERMS & REMOVAL:

This Board shall be composed of nine (9) citizens of Paim Beach County, seven (7) appointed as District appointments to serve for staggered terms of two (2) years, and (2) at-large by the BCC to serve for one (1) year. Thereafter all appointments shall be for two (2) years. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments for the remainder of the vacant term. Each member shall serve without compensation. Each district appointee may be removed without cause by the appointing Commissioner at any time, and at large appointees may be removed without cause by a vote of the BCC at any time.

EXTENDED COMPOSITION:

IV. MEETINGS:

The Board shall meet on a regular basis and as necessary to conduct Administrative Hearings. Notice of time and place of the meeting shall be given to all board members and all parties scheduled to be heard, and shall be made public. The chairperson may call an unscheduled meeting. Upon no less than 24 hours' notice, and meeting may also be called by the Director upon the request of three (3) members of the board.

V. FUNCTIONS:

To promote and encourage fair treatment and equal opportunity in housing, public accommodation and employment for all persons, to promote and encourage mutual understanding and respect and to endeavor to eliminate discrimination against and artagonism for all persons; to cooperate with governmental and non-governmental agencies and organizations having like or kindred functions; to make such investigations and studies in the field of fair housing, public accommodation and employment; to assist various groups, agencies, of the communities to cooperate in educational programs and campaigns devoted to elimination of discrimination in housing, places of public accommodation and employment; to aid in permitting PBC to benefit from the fullest realization of its housing, public accommodation and employment resources; to recommend to the BCC the acceptance of certain grants and contracts from foundations and other sources for the purpose of carrying out purposes of these ordinances; to recommend to the BCC methods for elimination of discrimination and intergroup tensions.
