I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$167,390 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO).

Summary: Florida Statute 932.7055(5) provides that the seizing agency shall use Forfeiture proceeds for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education and prevention programs, or for other law enforcement purposes, which include defraying the cost of protracted or complex investigations, providing additional equipment or expertise, purchasing AED's, and providing matching grant funds. F.S. 932.7055(5) also requires that no less than 15% of the LETF's previous year's revenues be used for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and school resource officer programs of various non-profit organizations. The PBSO's FY 2013 estimated donation requirement will not be finalized until year-end close-out. The PBSO's support of these programs exemplifies its strong commitment to the prevention and reduction of crime throughout the communities it serves and its desire to put money back into these communities to support organizations that provide such services. The year-to-date transfer for all donations to outside organizations after approval of this item is \$627,927. The funds are requested here are to aid PBSO and qualified organizations that meet the requirements set forth in F.S. 932.7055. Use of LETF requires approval by the Board, upon request of the Sheriff. The current State LETF balance is \$2,113,190. Approval of this request will reduce the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund balance to \$1,945,800. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with F.S. 932.7055. Below is a table indicating the organizations the PBSO seeks to fund and the corresponding amount of funding proposed per respective organization or agency. Organization Purpose:

The mission of the Achievement Centers for Children and Families (ACCF) is to provide programs and services designed to help low-income families break the cycle of poverty while preparing children for academic success.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

The program to be funded is for services provided to 94 teens from 12 to 18 in our Afterschool, Beacon Center Extended Day and Teen Programs at the Village Academy which is located at 400 SW 12th Street, Delray Beach, FL 33444. The Center is open when teens need a safe haven during those critical non school hours, from 2:00p.m. to 7:00p.m. every day after school. Without the Center, the vast majority of these young people would spend those hours in unsupervised situations and statistically be far more likely to become involved in negative behaviors.

What results are you committed to achieving?

The Achievement Centers is committed to keeping young people out of trouble with the law and in school. In addition to providing a safe, supervised and educational haven, the Center provides an array of opportunities which help youth improve their academic and physical performance. As youth who are significantly behind in school are much more likely to drop out, the Center provides certified teachers and volunteers to help them improve academically. Staff also provide encouragement and incentives for the youth. Attendance is tracked as well as reading and math FCAT scores and school attendance. The Center's experience works as statistically, afterschool youth stay in school longer, graduate at a much higher rate and outperform their same school peers.

Our mission is to help animals in need, especially those that are injured, abused, neglected or abandoned. Pet overpopulation creates an atmosphere favorable to animal cruelty, neglect and owner irresponsibility. We believe that pet sterilization is the most effective way to address this problem.

Safe Harbor's Safe Neighborhood Program is dedicated to reducing the number of unwanted, loose and abandoned animals as well as addressing the public safety issue of cat/dog bites through our low cost sterilization service. According to the ASPCA, "...more than 70% of all dog bite cases involve unsterilized male dogs, and that an intact male dog is 2.6 times more likely to bite than a neutered dog." Safe Harbor has been a leader in low cost sterilization since 1985 after opening the second low cost spay/neuter clinic in Florida. Safe Harbor has sterilized thousands of cats and dogs in an effort to reduce the number of unwanted, uncared for and abandoned cats and dogs. Our Safe Harbor Safe Neighborhood Program is rooted in our low cost spay/neuter program.

What results are you committed to achieving?

By reducing the number of unwanted pets we are committed to achieving a reduction in free roaming cats and dogs as well as a corresponding reduction in animal bites. According to the HSUS, "The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in Atlanta, GA, estimates that nearly 2% of the U.S. population is bitten by a dog each year. This translates to more than 4.7 million people per year, most of whom are children." According to Palm Beach County Animal Care & Control, in six years, one female dog and her offspring can theoretically produce 67,000 dogs. Using this formula, Safe Harbor has prevented the birth of literally millions of unwanted dogs and cats. Pet sterilization works.
