6	TO APPROVE A FINE SCHEDULE AND THE FORM OF
7	CITATION TICKETS TO BE USED FOR MINOR VIOLATIONS
8	AS SPECIFIED IN THE PALM BEACH COUNTY CODE
9	CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE XI THAT OCCUR WITHIN PALM
10	BEACH COUNTY NATURAL AREAS AND THAT VIOLATIONS
11	AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE XI, DEEMED TO BE MAJOR
12	INFRACTIONS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, SHALL
13	REQUIRE A HEARING DATE BEFORE THE GROUNDWATER
14	AND NATURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION BOARD OR
15	HEARING OFFICER OF THE COURT.

17	Whereas Palm Beach County Natural Areas are part of the heritage of
18	the citizens of Palm Beach County; provide opportunities for passive recreation,
19	environmental education, and scientific research; serve as show places for
20	residents and visitors; and enhance the overall quality and diversity of life in
21	Palm Beach County; and

23	WHEREAS, the alteration or misuse of these natural areas will cause an
24	irreparable aesthetic, educational, scientific, and cultural loss to the citizens of
25	and visitors to Palm Beach County, and will result in potential harm to, and
26	degradation of, groundwater, surface waters, air quality, and native plant and
27	animal populations; and

29	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to prevent the
30	harm recited above and protect and maintain the native biological diversity of
31	County-managed natural areas by promulgating appropriate regulations to
32	govern public use of these natural areas; and

34	WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners approved Ordinance
35	94-13 (i.e. Chapter 11, Article XI of the County Code a.k.a. the "Natural Areas
36	Ordinance") to set forth those regulations governing public use of the natural
37	areas and provide appropriate enforcement of those regulations; and

39	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners by resolution may
40	establish fines to be imposed for minor violations of Chapter 11, Article XI; and

42	WHEREAS, it is the purpose of Article XI, Section 11-271, to provide
43	additional, cumulative remedies; and

45	WHEREAS, all monies collected as a result of violations of Article XI
46	shall be deposited in the County's Natural Areas Fund;

48	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

Citations must be paid within 30 days from the date the citation was issued. By paying the citation you will be deemed to have admitted the violation and to have waived your right to a hearing on the issue of commission of the violation.

You may request an extension of time to pay the citation in person at any Clerk &Comptroller branch location. A \$25 administrative fee plus a reasonable down payment is required at the time you request the extension. If payment is past due, you will also be charged a late fee and compliance letter fee. The extension allows for three equal payments over a 90-day period.

STEPS TO PLEA "NOT GUILTY" TO MY CITATION:

You must notify the Clerk & Comptroller's office in writing at the address listed below within 30 days of the citation issue date if you wish to contest the violation in county court. Your citation number and your correct mailing address must be provided.
