I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A work task order to Annual Agreement R2010-0592 in the amount of \$146,879.34 with Last Devenport, Inc. (LDI) for professional services.

SUMMARY: Approval of this work task order will provide the professional services necessary for the preparation of a design study, design plans and construction bid documents for Lyons Road from Hillsboro Canal to S.W. 18th Street (Project). The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the Project is 15%. The SBE participation committed for this Project by LDI is 100%. LDI is a Palm Beach County company and is a certified SBE.

District 5 (MRE)

Background and Justification: On April 3, 2012, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) renewed an Annual Agreement R2012-0474 with LDI to provide professional services required for Palm Beach Countywide (County) civil engineering projects. The County now desires LDI to prepare a design study, design plans and construction bid documents for the Project as detailed in Exhibit "A" of the attached work task order. 

SCOPE OF SERVICES

I. HORIZONTAL PROJECT NETWORK CONTROL

Using the information supplied by Palm Beach County, we will establish the Right-of-Way for Lyons Road. A traverse will be run through the route and all found monumentation will be tied in. The survey will be oriented to Palm Beach County horizontal control (NAD 83/90 Adjustment). The Palm Beach County Survey Department will supply all the sectional control information along the proposed route. In addition, we will prepare a Right-of-Way Procurement Map for the County Survey Department.

The limits of the survey are from Hillsboro Canal to 1000' north of SW 18th Street (limits are shown on Attachment 'B').

II. VERTICAL PROJECT NETWORK CONTROL

A level run will be performed along the route using the existing Palm Beach County benchmarks (NAVD 1988). Benchmarks will be set along the route, not exceeding 1,200 feet apart. All benchmarks will be set outside of the proposed right of way, where they are not likely to be disturbed and will be of a permanent nature.

III. BASELINE LAYOUT

We will lay out the baseline at 100' intervals setting appropriate points at each station. The baseline will be laid out within the limits of the route. These baseline points will be used in the topographic and cross section phase to locate features and facilitate checks.

IV. REFERENCE POINTS

We will reference the baseline at intervals not exceeding 1,400 feet along the route and at all changes of direction. These points will be used to replace disturbed baseline stations. We propose to set four (4) references.

V. SECTION TIES AND PROPERTY TIES

We will tie in section corners and property corners along the route to check the present alignment of Lyons Road. We will try to locate as many corners as possible to positively establish the current right of ways.

VI. TOPOGRAPHY

A topographic survey will be performed along the route. This survey will tie in all visible features such as, but not limited to, signs, light poles, guardrails, utilities, walks, edge of pavement, curbing, striping, drainage structures, trees, etc. These locations will show all features within the corridor from right of way to right of way extending to 10 feet outside the proposed right of way. We will locate the easterly side of all adjacent houses along the westerly boundary of Lyons Road within the route, as well as providing the finished floor elevations. In addition, we will locate the trees that fall within the right-of-way and within parcels to be acquired.

VII. CROSS SECTIONS

Cross sections will be done along the route at 100' intervals and at inlet locations. These cross sections will cover the roadway to the right of way lines and extend to 25 feet outside of the proposed right of way as provided.

On the curb and gutter we will obtain elevations on the front of curb, the flow line as well as the face and back of curb.

VIII. SIDE STREET SURVEYS

We will obtain topographic survey information for 200' along SW 18th Street, and 100' along SW 21st Street, as shown on Attachment 'B'. No survey information of the side streets will be obtained beyond the 25' cross section limit, except driveway profile information.

IX. ASBUILTS

We will attempt to get asbuilt information on all the pipes leading out of any storm structures found. When obtaining readings on the drainage structures, we will be sure to locate the rim and grate elevations, inverts and bottom elevations, pipe material, sizes and direction of flow as well as showing the next upstream and downstream structure.

X. LEGAL & SKETCHES

We will prepare legal descriptions and sketches as required. These sketches will be based on record ownership data and record plats provided by Palm Beach County. All sketches will be consistent with the requirements of Palm Beach County and Florida Minimum Technical Standards. At this time it is estimated that four (4) legal descriptions and sketches will be needed for this project at \$450.00 each totaling \$1,800.00.

XI. CLOSURE



As requested, TIERRA SOUTH FLORIDA, INC. (TSF) is pleased to submit this proposal for the above-referenced project. The proposal is based on an email dated January 25, 2013. This proposal includes an outline of our proposed scope of work, an estimate of the total fees, and our anticipated schedule for completion of the work.

PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK

All work performed by TSF will be in general accordance with Palm Beach County and FDOT standards. The proposed scope work for the preliminary study is as follow:

- We understand that the project will include adding a southbound lane on Lyons road for a length of 1000 feet. We propose to drill 10 auger borings to a depth of 5 feet
- 2) We propose to drill 10 auger borings to a depth of 5 feet for the section of Lyons Road north of SW 18th Street.
- 3) Perform two Borehole Permeability Tests, one 500 feet north of SW 18th Street and one 500 feet south of SW 18th Street.
- 4) Obtain Two (2) pavement cores to investigate the pavement failure.

Boring locations will be approximately located in the field by our personnel by measuring distances with a tape from known reference points. Elevations at boring locations can be interpreted from topographic plans if furnished by others.

Prior to drilling at the project site, TSF will notify the local utility companies and request that underground utilities be marked. Our experience, however, is that the utility companies will not mark privately owned utilities. Our proposal assumes that private utility lines will be located in the field by others prior to mobilization of the drill rig.

Upon completion of the field exploration, laboratory testing will be performed on selected samples. The study will be summarized in accordance with the FDOT's Soil and Foundation Manual.

A geotechnical engineer will evaluate the results of all drilling and laboratory testing. A preliminary report will be issued that contains the exploration data, a discussion of the site and subsurface conditions, geotechnical recommendations for pavement design/failure analysis, permeability test results and a discussion of some construction considerations.

ESTIMATED FEES


