I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve on preliminary reading and advertise for a Public Hearing on April 16, 2013 at 9:30 a.m.: an Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, adopting rates for the Glades Utility Authority Service area; incorporating the rates into the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department's Uniform Policies and Procedures Manual; providing for repeal of laws in conflict; providing for severability; providing for inclusion in the code of laws and ordinances; and providing for an effective date.

Summary: On January 15, 2013, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (County) approved the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement Establishing the Glades Utility Authority (First Amendment). Pursuant to the First Amendment, the County will absorb the Glades Utility Authority (GUA) water and wastewater system and customers and reduce current rates by 6.5%. These reduced rates will be charged to customers for a period of eight (8) years. After the initial eight (8) years, the GUA's rates will revert to the County's rates plus seven (7) percent. Existing GUA rates are approximately 75% higher than current County rates, and revenue from the rate differential will be used to pay debt service on the bonds being absorbed and to pay "Host Fees" to the Cities of Belle Glade, Pahokee, and South Bay. The proposed ordinance will adopt the rates currently being charged by the GUA and include those rates in Chapter 6 of the Water Utilities Department's Uniform Policies and Procedures (UPAP) Manual. The revision does not affect any rates currently being charged to existing Water Utilities customers. <u>District 6 (MJ)</u>

Background and Policy Issues: Since 1981, the Department has utilized the UPAP Manual as the guiding document for providing services to the public. The UPAP is a codification of the Department's rates, fees, policies and procedures governing the provision of potable water, reclaimed water, and wastewater services. Chapter 6 of the UPAP contains the approved rates and fees for water and wastewater services, connection fees, guaranteed revenue fees, and miscellaneous fees and charges.

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-__

ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY AN COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, RATES THE **GLADES** UTILITY ADOPTING FOR AUTHORITY SERVICE AREA; INCORPORATING THE RATES INTO THE PALM BEACH COUNTY WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT'S UNIFORM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS PROVIDING FOR AN ORDINANCES: AND AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the County has entered into the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement Establishing the Glades Utility Authority ("First Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the First Amendment, the County is to absorb the Glades Utility Authority ("GUA") utility system, including all of its assets and customers; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to the First Amendment, the County is required to charge certain rates, fees and charges to the customers in the Glades Utility Authority service area; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to adopt a GUA Rate Schedule for customers within the GUA service area and to incorporate the GUA Rate Schedule into the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Uniform Policies and Procedures Manual ("UPAP").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF GUA Rate Schedule:

The GUA Rate Schedule of rates, fees, and charges shown in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby adopted. The rates, fees, and charges set forth herein shall become effective for customers within the GUA service area on May 1, 2013. For any rates, fees, and charges not set forth in the GUA Rate Schedule, the standard Palm Beach County rates, fees, and charges shall apply to customers in the GUA service area.

Section 2. INCLUSION IN UPAP:

The schedule of rates, fees, and charges shown at Exhibit "A" shall be included in the UPAP and made available for public inspection during normal business hours.

Section 3. REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT:

All local laws and ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY:

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 5. INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES:

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Palm Beach County Code. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article", or other appropriate word.

Section 6. EFFECTIVE DATE:

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the Department of State.

- Residential \$50.00 per dwelling unit for Individual or combined service with a \$750.00 minimum.
- Non-Residential \$50.00 per ERC based on meter size for individual or combined service with a \$750.00 minimum.

CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION FEE

Four percent (4%) of total estimated cost as provided by the developer and approved by the Department for all potable water, reclaimed water and/or wastewater construction improvements with a \$500.00 minimum for Residential and Non-Residential projects. This fee is due prior to the pre-construction conference.
