I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 8 to the contract with Leo A. Daly Company (R2011-0112) in the amount of \$349,602 to provide architectural/engineering design services for a new Library Annex to be located on Cherry Road in West Palm Beach; and
- B) A budget transfer in the amount of \$614,602 in the Library Impact Fees Fund from the Reserves to the Annex capital project.

Summary: Since 1999, the County on behalf of the Library Department has leased space within the Mil-Lake Plaza located on Lake Worth Road in Greenacres. On November 20, 2012, the Board approved a final renewal option to extend the lease to March 31, 2015. This CSA will provide design services for a stand-alone facility to meet the Library Department needs to replace the existing leased space. These services will include the architectural and structural design with mechanical and electrical, parking, landscaping, irrigation and site lighting. Leo A. Daly Company has a continuing services contract for architectural services which provides for a Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal of 32% SBE, 12% M/WBE. The participation on this CSA is 39.5% SBE, 14.0% M/WBE. When added to the consultant's participation to date, the SBE participation is 28.2%, M/WBE participation is 6.6%. Leo A. Daly Company is a Palm Beach County firm using all Palm Beach County subconsultants. The estimated construction cost is \$3,500,000 and will be funded from Library Impact Fees. (Capital Improvements Division) District 7 (JM)

Background and Justification: On July 27, 1999, the Board approved the initial lease agreement for a period of six years with two options to extend each for one year. The Board approved to exercise each of these options. On January 15, 2008, the Board approved Amendment No. 1 extending the term for 3 years and for two options to extend each for two years. On November 20, 2012, the Board approved the final renewal option to March 31, 2015. The County does not currently have any County-owned space available for the Library Department's use. The Library Annex provides for acquisition, preparation, and storage of library materials, as well as the Outreach Services Section which includes talking books, books by mail, the bookmobile, and the volunteer literacy tutoring program. The space requirements for this facility will be approximately 30,000 sf.



SCOPE OF SERVICES

D. BIDDING & CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION PHASES
Bidding will consist of responding to questions and clarification requests from
the PBC-selected CM. The Construction Administration Phase shall include
shop drawing review and processing and related activities. The Construction
Administration has been assumed to be a nine (9) month duration. Site visits
by the Architect will occur weekly. Site visits by the Consultants will be as
required.

<u>DELIVERABLES</u>

One submission which is to include three (3) half size and seven (7) full size sets of plans and ten sets of specifications for review and comment will be provided at the conclusion of the Schematic Design & Design Development Phases and one submission which is to include three (3) half size and seven (7) full size sets of plans and ten sets of specifications for review and comment will be provided at the conclusion of the Construction Document Phase. Two Signed and Sealed sets of drawings and specifications will be submitted for Building Department permitting.

CONDITIONS

- A. The project design will reflect the PBC Policy & Procedures Manual for Design Professional, dated May, 2009.
- B. Site surveying services are not included in this scope of service.
- C. PBC will provide drawings and specifications for the existing book conveying system to be relocated into the new facility. PBC will directly contract with the system vendor to relocate the system.
- D. Leo A Daly will field measure and document the existing shelving system to be relocated into the new facility. No other existing furniture is anticipated to be relocated.
- E. The site has already been rezoned by PBC to accommodate this project. As discussed on 1/28/13, no Site Plan Approval processes are anticipated or included in this proposal.
- F. Landscape improvements are limited to the area immediately around the new building, the new parking area islands and possible limited extension of the existing north perimeter buffer adjacent to the new building.
- G. On 1/24/13 the PBC User confirmed the space does not require special humidity control to protect the contents. The design will be based on ASHRAE standards for this type of facility.
- H. On 1/24/13 the PBC User confirmed the facility does not require an emergency generator.

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- Voice / Data services are limited to providing IT raceways and/or cable trays which would allow a PBC-contracted IT Contractor to route cabling from the dedicated IT equipment room to locations coordinated with PBC. This proposal assumes the IT cabling infrastructure ESS/ISS design will be provided by the PBC-contracted IT Contractor. An IT room as defined by NFPA75 is not anticipated or included in the proposed scope.
- Cost estimating services are not included in this scope of service.
- K. LEED certification services are not required or included in this scope of service.

SCHEDULE

It is anticipated Construction Documents will be complete and ready for building department submission within six (6) months of receiving our formal notice to proceed. A nine (9) month Construction Administration Phase has been assumed for this project.

COMPENSATION

Compensation to Leo A Daly shall be a lump sum as stipulated below. Billing shall be on a monthly basis based on the percentage of completion of the work.



EXHIBIT C VOLUNTARY COMMITMENTS

ENGINEERING

- 1. The property owner shall construct a west approach left turn lane on Cherry Rd at the easterly driveway. Any and all costs associated with the construction shall be paid by the property owner. These costs shall include, but are not limited to, utility relocations and acquisition of any additional required right-of-way.
- a. Permits required by Palm Beach County for this construction shall be obtained prior to the issuance of Building Permits for more than the 32,383 of PBC Sheriff's Training facility (currently existing as gymnatorium) and the 3,072 of ancilliary maintenance building (currently existing as maintenance building). (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING Eng)
- b. Construction of the improvement shall be completed prior to the Issuance of the first Certificate of Occupancy after the COs have been issued for the 32,383 sf Sheriff's Training Facility and 3,072 sf of maintenance building. (CO: MONITORING Eng)
- 2. Prior to March 30, 2010 or to the issuance of new building construction permit, whichever shall occur first, the property owner shall combine the property into a single lot of record in accordance with provisions of Article 11 of the Unified Land Development Code. (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING-Eng)

COMPLIANCE

- 1. In granting this approval, the Board of County Commissioners relied upon the oral and written representations of the petitioner both on the record and as part of the application process. Deviations from or violation of these representations shall cause the approval to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for review under the compliance condition of this approval. (ONGOING: MONITORING Zoning)
- 2. Failure to comply with any of the voluntary commitments of approval for the subject property at any time may result in:
- a. The issuance of a stop work order; the issuance of a cease and desist order; the denial or revocation of a building permit; the denial or revocation of a Certificate of Occupancy; the denial of any other permit, license or approval to any developer, owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; the revocation of any other permit, license or approval from any developer, owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; revocation of any concurrency; and/or
- b. The revocation of the Official Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or any other zoning approval; and/or
- c. A requirement of the development to conform with the standards of the ULDC at the time of the finding of non-compliance, or the addition or modification of conditions reasonably related to the failure to comply with existing conditions; and/or
- d. Referral to code enforcement; and/or
- e. imposition of entitlement density or intensity.

Staff may be directed by the Executive Director of PZ&B or the Code Enforcement Special Master to schedule a Status Report before the body which approved the Conditional Use, Type II Variance, Development Order Amendment, and/or other zoning approval, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.E of the ULDC, in response to any flagrant violation and/or continued violation of any condition of approval.

Departmental administrative actions made pursuant to this condition may be appealed as provided in the Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as amended. Appeals of any revocation of a Conditional Use, Type II Variance, Development Order Amendment or other actions based on a Zoning Commission decision shall be by petition for writ of certiorari to the Circuit Court, Appellate Division, 15th Judicial Circuit of Florida. (ONGOING: MONITORING - Zoning)

TIERRA SOUTH FLORIDA, Inc. (TSF) is pleased to submit this proposal for providing subsurface exploration at the site of the subject project. This proposal includes a summary of our understanding of the project, an outline of our proposed scope of work, an estimate of the total job cost, and our anticipated schedule for completion of the work.

PROJECT INFORMATION

Limited information regarding the proposed development is available at this time. We understand that the proposed construction will consist of a 1-story structure that will include material receiving, cataloguing & distribution facility with office and tractor trailer loading dock. The proposed building will cover an area of approximately 30,000 square feet. The project site is located along Cherry Road, in West Palm Beach, Florida. We assume the entire site is accessible to truck mounted drill rigs. Loading information has not been provided at this time.

PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK

We propose to drill five (5) Standard Penetration Test (SPT) borings to a depth of 20 feet below existing grade, and three (3) auger borings to a depth of 6 feet below existing grade. Additionally, we propose to perform one (1) Bore Hole Permeability (BHP) test per South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) standards. Some adjustments in the boring depths may be necessary depending upon the subsurface conditions encountered.

PBC Library Annex Proposal No. 1301-042 Revised

Within the borings, penetration resistance testing will be performed in general accordance with the requirements of ASTM designations D 1586. Borings will be approximately located in the field by our drilling personnel by measuring distances with a tape from known reference points. Elevations at boring locations can be interpreted from a topographic plan if furnished by others.

Prior to drilling at the project site, TSF will notify the local utility companies and request that underground utilities be marked. Our experience, however, is that the utility companies will not mark privately owned utilities. Our proposal assumes that private utility lines will be located in the field by others prior to mobilization of the drill rig. TSF will recommend a utility line locating service upon request.

Upon completion of the field exploration, visual classifications will be performed and some laboratory testing, if necessary, will be performed on select samples.

A geotechnical engineer will evaluate the results of all drilling and laboratory testing. A report will be issued for each phase that contains the exploration data, a discussion of the site and subsurface conditions, geotechnical recommendations for foundation and pavement design, and a discussion of some construction considerations.

ESTIMATED COST

It is proposed that the fee for the performance of the services outlined above is determined in accordance with the attached fee schedule, and that the work is performed pursuant to the TSF General Conditions enclosed herewith and incorporated into this proposal.

SCHEDULE AND AUTHORIZATION

TSF will proceed with the work after receipt of a signed copy of this proposal. With our present drilling schedule, we can commence work within several days of project approval (weather permitting) and fieldwork will take about one day to complete. The written report can be submitted about two weeks after completion of the field exploration, depending on the extent of the laboratory-testing program. Verbal preliminary recommendations can be made to appropriate parties prior to submittal of the written report.
