I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A) Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, a Grant Modification with the U. S. Department of Homeland Security Transportation Security Administration, to provide an additional \$52,000 in annual reimbursable funding, for Homeland Security Enforcement at the Palm Beach International Airport; and **(B) Approve** a budget amendment of \$52,000 in the Sheriff's Grants fund.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) accepted this grant for \$1,252,000, on November 16, 2010 (R-2010-1938). On October 2, 2012, the BOCC accepted a Grant Modification providing additional FY2012 funding of \$52,500 (R-2012-1440). This Grant Modification will provide additional annual FY2013 funding to offset the costs associated with the salary and benefits of five (5) deputies and the costs associated with the care of five (5) TSA canines. Reimbursable costs for this award include, but are not limited to: supplies such as kennels, vet care, vehicles, and dog food. The purpose of this grant program is to provide maximum coverage during peak airport operating hours and to maintain the ability to promptly respond to threats and suspected threat explosive devices which affect air carrier operations. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. <u>Countywide.</u> (PGE)

Background and Justification: The U.S. Department of Homeland Security Transportation Security Administration awards grants for the purpose of providing Homeland Security Enforcement programs. The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office is responsible for the overall safety and security of the Palm Beach International Airport. The Palm Beach International Airport could be victim to a terrorist attack and therefore PBSO takes every reasonable measure to ensure the safety of the citizens of Palm Beach County and travelers who utilize this airport. In our efforts to provide safety and security of this site, PBSO has applied for and was awarded the aforementioned grant to enhance the Homeland Security measures we are taking in Palm Beach County. The grant period is from 10/01/2010 through 09/30/2015. The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Number for this program is 97.072 the Contract number is HSTSO2-11-H-CAN637.

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A) Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office a U. S. Department of Homeland Security Transportation Security Administration Grant for continuation of Homeland Security Enforcement at the Palm Beach International Airport, in the amount of \$250,500, for the period of October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2015; (B) Approve a budget amendment of \$250,500 in the Sheriff's Grants fund.
