

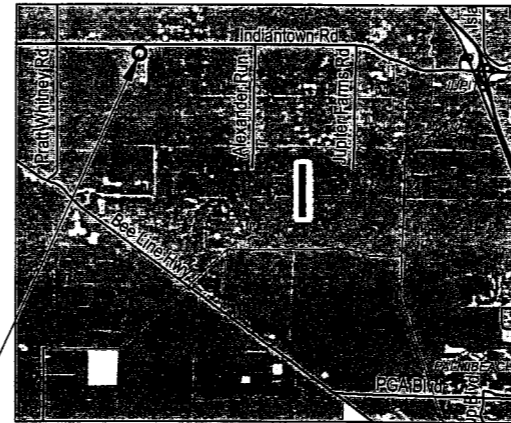

GENERAL NOTES

- ALL NORTHING AND EASTING COORDINATES ARE NAD 83/90. ALL ELEVATIONS ARE IN THE NAVD88 DATUM.
- MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC, IF NEEDED, SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT FDOT ROADWAY TRAFFIC DESIGN SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS AND THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (M.U.T.C.D., 1988 EDITION).
- ANY PUBLIC LAND CORNER WITHIN THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE PROTECTED. IF A CORNER MONUMENT IS IN DANGER OF BEING DISTURBED, AND HAS NOT BEEN PROPERLY REFERENCED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY PBC WITHOUT DELAY.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT ALL PERMANENT REFERENCE MONUMENTS AND TAKE ALL PRECAUTIONS NECESSARY TO AVOID DAMAGE TO SURVEY MARKERS DURING CONSTRUCTION, UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY PBC.
- THE LOCATION OF UTILITIES SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE CONTRACTOR PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. IN ADDITION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO VERIFY IF OTHER UTILITIES (NOT SHOWN ON PLANS) EXIST WITHIN THE AREA OF CONSTRUCTION. - UTILITIES ARE TO BE ADJUSTED OR RELOCATED BY OTHERS AS DIRECTED BY PBC.
- ALL EXISTING DRAINAGE STRUCTURES AND PIPES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE PROJECT SHALL REMAIN UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL UTILIZE CONSTRUCTION METHODS AND DEVICES SUCH AS TURBIDITY CURTAINS AND FLOATING SILT BARRIERS WHERE NECESSARY IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH STATE AND LOCAL WATER QUALITY STANDARDS. COST OF SUCH METHODS OR DEVICES SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO AND INCORPORATED INTO THE COST OF THE EARTHWORK LINE ITEMS.
- UNLESS OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY THE CONTRACT, ALL WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION, 2010 EDITION (FDOT STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS).
- ALL CONCRETE PATHWAY AND RELATED WORK SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE STANDARDS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY AND FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
- ALL EXCAVATED OR GRUBBED UNSUITABLE MATERIAL SUCH AS MUCK, MARL, AND DEBRIS, SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION AND STOCKPILED ONSITE AS DIRECTED BY PBC.
- NO CONSTRUCTION SHALL COMMENCE UNTIL ALL REQUIRED PERMITS AND APPROVALS HAVE BEEN SECURED, AND THE CONTRACTOR IS ISSUED A NOTICE TO PROCEED.

- BASE MATERIAL SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF APPLICABLE SECTIONS AS APPROPRIATE OF THE FDOT STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND DENSITY AS DETERMINED BY ASHTO T-180.
- BEFORE ANY CONSTRUCTION OF THE BASE MATERIAL, A CHEMICAL AND SIEVE ANALYSIS OF THE MATERIAL SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE COUNTY.
- SUBBASE SHALL BE STABILIZED (IF REQUIRED) AND COMPACTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FDOT STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- SUBBASE SHALL BE STABILIZED (IF REQUIRED) AND COMPACTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FDOT STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- SUBBASE SHALL BE FREE OF MUCK, STUMPS, ROOTS, UNDERBRUSH, VEGETATIVE MATTER, GARBAGE, TRASH OR ANY MATERIAL THAT WILL NOT PROVIDE A SUITABLE STABLE, CLEAN SUBGRADE.
- ANY MUCK ENCOUNTERED ON THE SITE MUST BE COMPLETELY REMOVED TO 5 FEET OUTSIDE THE EDGE OF ANY PROPOSED PAVEMENT.
- WHERE GUMBO OR OTHER PLASTIC CLAY IS ENCOUNTERED, IT SHALL BE REMOVED FROM WITHIN THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION UP TO ONE FOOT BELOW THE COMPACTED SUBGRADE, EXTENDING HORIZONTALLY TO BEYOND THE EDGE OF PROPOSED CONCRETE PATHWAY OR PAVEMENT.
- ADDITIONAL FILL MATERIAL FOR SUBBASE SHALL BE FREE OF MUCK, STUMPS, ROOTS, UNDERBRUSH, VEGETATIVE MATTER, GARBAGE, TRASH OR ANY MATERIAL THAT WILL NOT PROVIDE A SUITABLE STABLE, CLEAN SUBGRADE.
- PAVEMENT STRIPING SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH PALM BEACH COUNTY TYPICAL DRAWING NO. T-P-04-001, THE MANUAL OF UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 710 OF THE FDOT STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.

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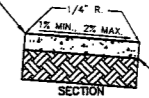

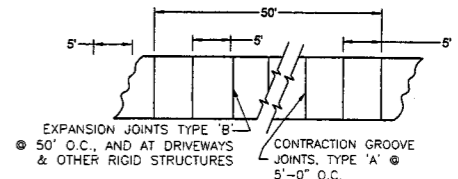

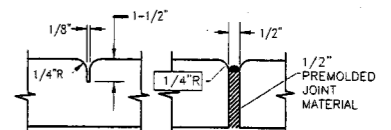


NATURE TRAIL (CONCRETE) SECTION & DETAILS

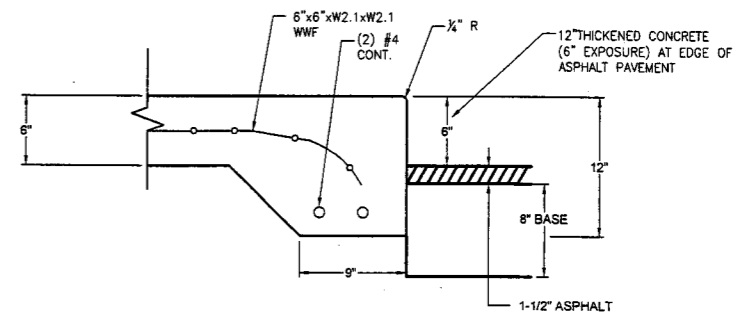

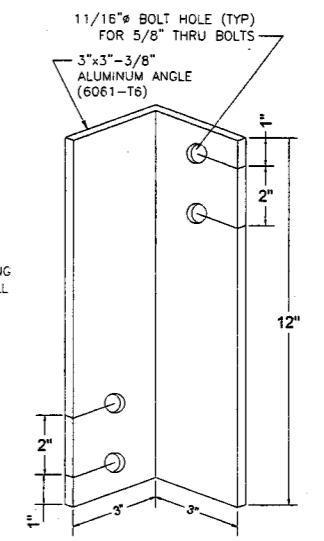
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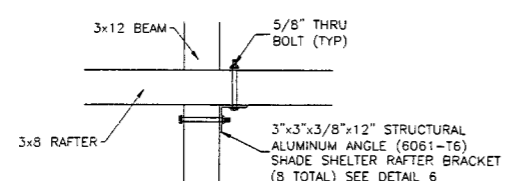
1 ROOF FRAMING PLAN

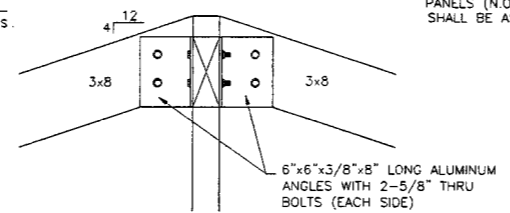
4 ELEVATION DETAIL AT EAVE

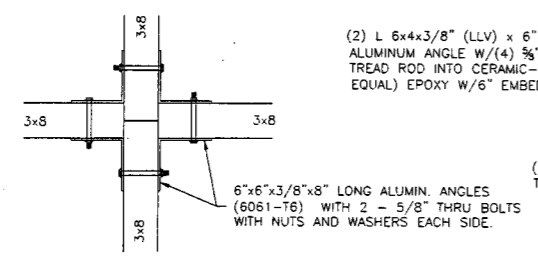
6 PICNIC SHELTER

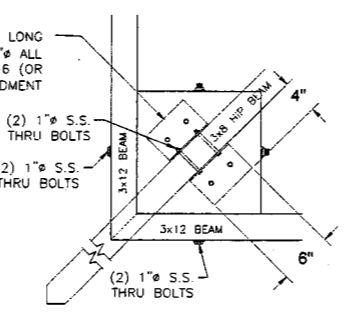
7 PLAN DETAIL AT BRACKET

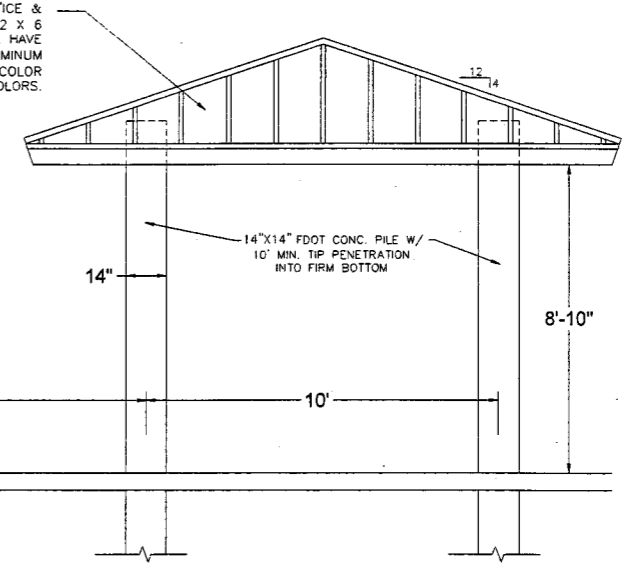


2 PLAN DETAIL AT RIDGE

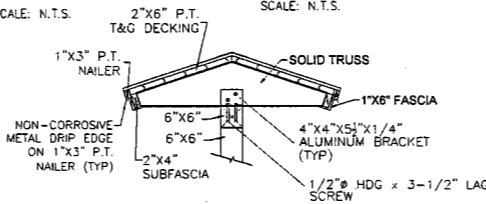

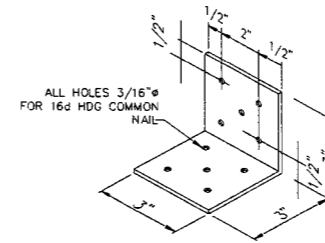

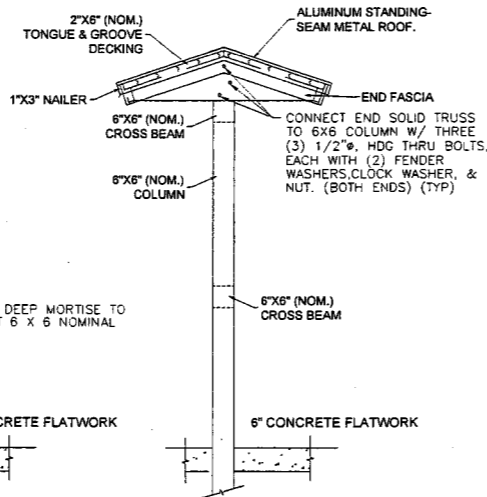


PRIVACY FENCE BRACKET DETAIL N.T.S.

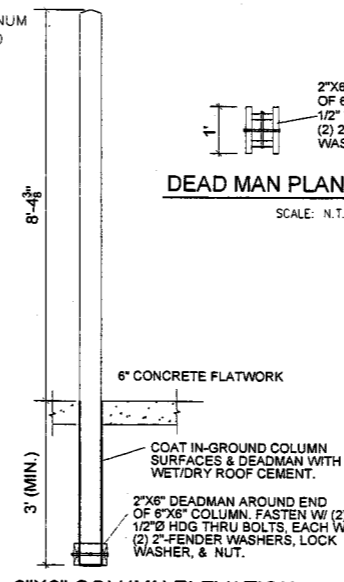

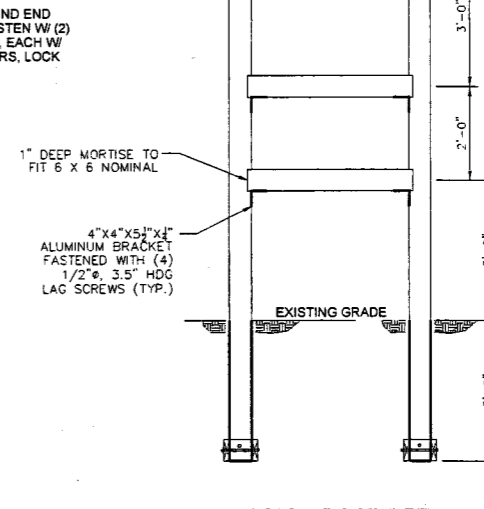
KIOSK FRONT ELEVATION

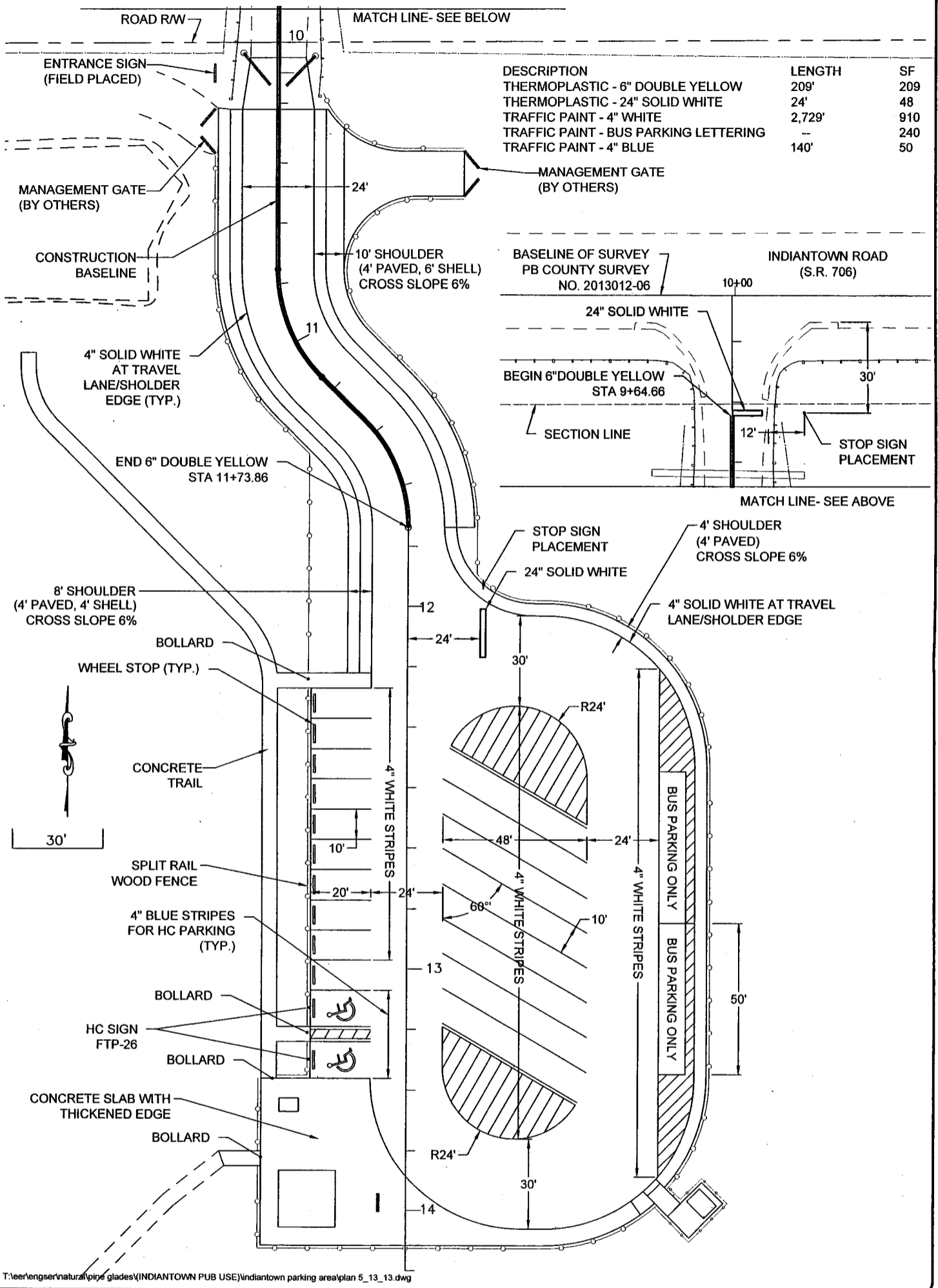

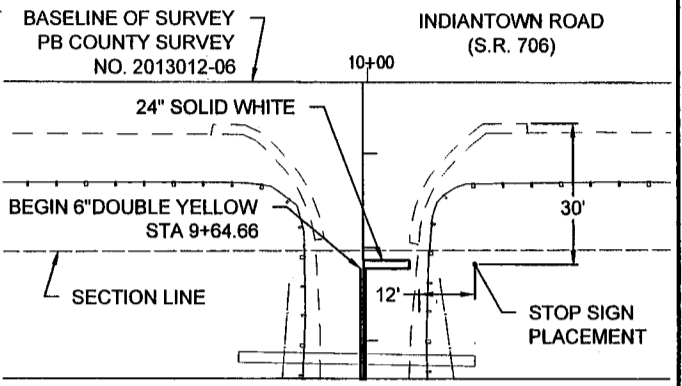


