

- MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC, IF NEEDED, SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT FDOT ROADWAY TRAFFIC DESIGN SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS AND THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (M.U.T.C.D., 1988 EDITION).
- ANY PUBLIC LAND CORNER WITHIN THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE PROTECTED.
