I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Supplement No. 4 to agreement Number R2011-1481 (Agreement), with Target Engineering Group, Inc., in a total amount of \$7,626.75, to provide professional services for Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) for Blue Heron Boulevard and Congress Avenue (Phase II) Intersection Improvements.


