**Motion and Title:**

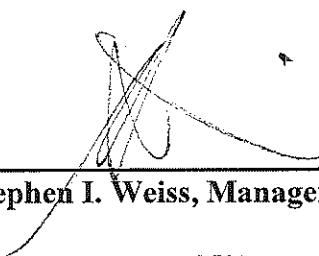
