## I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement (R2008-1301) with the City of Greenacres (City) to extend the term of the Agreement for direct access to the County's 800 MHz Radio System to July 21, 2017.

**Summary:** The Interlocal Agreement with the City, which provides the terms and conditions under which the City can directly access the County's 800 MHz Radio System, expires on July 21, 2013. The Agreement provides for two (2) renewal options, each for a period of four (4) years. Both parties must approve the renewal option. The City has approved a renewal to extend the term of the Agreement to July 21, 2017. The renewal now requires Board approval. The terms of the Agreement are standard and have been offered to all municipalities and local branches of State/Federal agencies where connection through an established municipal hub is not technically feasible. The annual fees are consistent with those being charged to the County departments. The City is required to pay all costs associated with subscriber units and to comply with the established operating procedures for the System. The Agreement may be terminated by either party, with or without cause, on October 1<sup>st</sup> of any year, with a minimum of 6 months notice. The First Amendment renews the term, replaces Attachment I and deletes outdated attachments, updates contact information, provides for disclosure of County Ordinance No. 2011-009 establishing the Office of the Inspector General and provides for the exclusion of third party beneficiaries. Other than the changes set forth herein, all other terms remain the same. **(ESS) Countywide (JM)** 

**Background and Justification:** On July 22, 2008, the Board approved the Interlocal Agreement for direct access for a period of five (5) years expiring on July 21, 2013. The City of Greenacres does not have a city regional radio hub which can accommodate the City's needs and, therefore the City meets one of the established criteria for direct access to the County's 800 MHz Radio System. After approval of this First Amendment, one (1) renewal option will remain.

## FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT CITY OF GREENACRES DIRECT ACCESS

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to Agreement R2008-1301, dated July 22, 2008, (the "Agreement") is made as of \_\_\_\_\_\_, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, ("County") and the City of Greenacres, a municipal corporation ("City").

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the County and City agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the Agreement expires on July 21, 2013, and shall be extended to July 21, 2017, pursuant to the exercise of the first of two (4) year renewal options.
- 2. Attachment I to the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and is hereby replaced by Attachment I attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3. Attachment II and Attachment III to the Agreement are hereby deleted in their entirety.
- 4. All references in the Agreement to the 800 MHz Trunked Radio System shall be deleted and replaced with the Public Safety Trunked Radio System ("System").
- 5. Section 2.01 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

2.01 The Palm Beach County Electronic Services & Security Division's System Administrator will be the City's day to day contact and can be reached at 561-233-0837. The Electronic Services & Security Division is staffed from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding County holidays. After hours emergency contact will be made through the County's Emergency Operations Dispatch Center at 561-712-6428 and the appropriate on-call contact will be made.

6. Section 2.02 of the Agreement is modified by deleting the first sentence and replacing it with the following:

The System Maintenance and Administration Plan dated June 6, 2002, as referenced on Attachment I hereto, identifies the general procedures for the management of the system and procedures for input through the user committees into operating procedure development.

Section 2.021 of the Agreement is modified by deleting the first sentence and 7. replacing it with the following:

> 2.021 The CRSSC is supported by User Committees in each discipline utilizing the System.

Section 4.07 of the Agreement is modified by deleting the last sentence and 8. replacing it with the following:

> The County's talk group and radio ID allocations are on file with the County and available upon request.

#### The Agreement is hereby modified to add the following: 9.

# SECTION 21: PALM BEACH COUNTY OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL AUDIT REQUIREMENTS

Palm Beach County has established the Office of the Inspector General in Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 - 2-440, as may be amended. The Inspector General is authorized with the power to review past, present and proposed County contracts, transactions, accounts and records. The Inspector General's authority includes, but is not limited to, the power to audit, investigate, monitor, and inspect the activities of entities contracting with the County, or anyone acting on their behalf, in order to ensure compliance with contract requirements and to detect corruption and fraud. Failure to cooperate with the Inspector General or interfering with or impeding any investigation shall be a violation of Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 - 2-440, and punished pursuant to Section 125.69, Florida Statutes, in the same manner as a second degree misdemeanor.

The Agreement is hereby modified to add the following: 10.

## **SECTION 22: NO THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARY**

No provision of this Agreement is intended to, or shall be construed to, create any third party beneficiary or to provide any rights to any person or entity not a party to this Agreement, including, but not limited to, any citizen or employees of the County and/or City.

Except as modified by this First Amendment, the Agreement remains in full force 11. and effect in accordance with the terms thereof, and the parties hereby ratify, confirm and adopt the Agreement, as amended.
