I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Grant Modification to extend the agreement period, for the Miami Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Regional Fusion Center Analysts, from April 30, 2013, through June 30, 2013.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners accepted this grant for \$140,000, on November 20, 2012; the original period for this grant was effective through April 30, 2013 (R-2012-1751). This agenda item will extend the grant period from April 30, 2013, through June 30, 2013. This agreement provides a means of funding various domestic security activities within the County and region using federal Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) funds through the City of Miami as the Miami UASI's fiscal agent. These funds will be used for contractual services for Regional Virtual Fusion Center analysts. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. <u>Countywide</u> (PGE)

Background and Justification:

The Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) is intended is to create a sustainable national model program to enhance security and overall preparedness to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism. In general, the UASI provides financial assistance to States to address the unique equipment, training, planning, and exercise needs of large urban areas, and to assist them in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism. It also includes awards to (1) selected State and local governmental entities and commercial companies to develop plans and approaches to ensuring the safety and protection of the Nation's ports, and (2) selected State and local governmental entities to develop plans and approaches to ensuring the safety and protection of the Nation's transit systems.
