I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A) Contract with Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. for Water Treatment Plant No. 8 (WTP 8) Well Replacement and Rehabilitation in the amount of \$1,704,960; and B) Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 11 to MWH Americas, Inc. (R2011-0632) for construction services related to the five (5) production wells for WTP 8 in the amount of \$298,419.46.

Summary: On June 6, 2013, four (4) bids were received for Project No. WUD 12-008 to construct one (1) new production well and rehabilitate four (4) production wells for WTP 8. The low bidder, Southeast Drilling Services, Inc., is the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,704,960. CSA 11 will provide construction services related to the five (5) wells and associated raw water mains. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. has met the SBE goal with a participation of 70.38% overall. Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. is a local company. The contract with MWH Americas, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 26% overall. This CSA includes SBE participation of 7.63%. The cumulative SBE participation, including this CSA is 27.55% overall. MWH Americas, Inc. is a local company. (WUD Project No. 12-008) Districts 2 (JM)

Background and Justification: On May 3, 2011, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the continuing Contract for Utility Hydrogeologic & Water Resources Engineering Services with MWH Americas, Inc. (R2011-0632). On February 7, 2012 the Board approved CSA No. 6 (R2012-0252) to evaluate the wells using video surveys and to design a rehabilitation plan for four (4) wells to include inner casing and screen replacements. One (1) well required replacement. Over time, some of the wells serving this system have shown signs of deterioration and repair or replacement is needed to maintain the integrity of the system; no new water allocation is required. The low bidder for Project No. WUD 12-008, Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. was determined to be the lowest responsive responsible bidder. Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. has met the SBE goal for this project. OSBA Schedules 1 and 2 contain conflicting dollar amounts, therefore the SBE participation is based upon the lowest dollar amount submitted on Schedule 1. The list of bid irregularities identified with the bid documents is detailed in Attachment 6. The irregularities provide no competitive advantage.

SCOPE OF WORK FOR

WATER TREATMENT PLANT 8 WELLS REHABILITATION AND REPLACEMENT ENGINEERING SERVICES DURING CONSTRUCTION

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (COUNTY) entered into an agreement entitled Contract for Engineering/ Professional Services - Palm Beach County Utilities Department Project No. WUD 11-003 (CONTRACT) with. <u>MWH Americas, Inc.</u> (CONSULTANT) to provide engineering services for various general activities on (Reference Document R2011-0632). This Consultant Service Authorization will be performed under that CONTRACT.

This Consultant Services Authorization encompasses providing services related to the design, bidding, and engineering services during construction for the rehabilitation or replacement of production wells at WTP 8.

BACKGROUND

In order to maintain additional rotational well capacity, the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) has constructed an extensive wellfield system to deliver raw water to Water Treatment Plant (WTP) 8. Over time, some of the wells serving this system have shown signs of deterioration and repair or replacement is needed to maintain the integrity of the system. PBCWUD has identified four existing WTP 8 raw water supply wells requiring rehabilitation (8W-1, 8W-2, 8W-3, and 8W-4) and one well requiring replacement (Well 8W-21) as part of this scope of services.

As part of Consultant Services Authorization No. 6, MWH was tasked with evaluating the wells from video surveys and determined the existing wells can be rehabilitated by inner casing and screen replacements. MWH also conducted an informal pricing survey from local Water Well Contractors to obtain rehabilitation cost estimates. MWH performed a reconnaissance to evaluate the wells to be rehabilitated and documented the results in a technical memorandum.

This Scope of Work consists of the engineering and hydrogeological services for the following:

Professional services required during the rehabilitation and replacement of five WTP 8 raw water supply wells include the following activities:

- Project Management Engineering Services During Construction
- Rehabilitation and Testing Technical Oversight Assistance

SCOPE OF SERVICES

CONSULTANT will perform the engineering Scope of Services as described herein.

Task 1 - Project Management and Engineering Services During Construction

The CONSULTANT will attend project progress meetings with the COUNTY, prepare invoices, maintain electronic project schedule, and coordinate project activities with staff. The CONSULTANT will review shop drawings, and requests for information (RFIs). The CONSULTANT's on-site staff will maintain contact with the COUNTY's Project Manager and O&M staff throughout the course of the project. The CONSULTANT will work with the COUNTY's CONTRACTOR where possible to minimize disruptions and impacts to the Plant and its staff. The CONSULTANT's work under this task will consist of the following:

- 1.1 **Pre-Construction Meeting.** The CONSULTANT and CONSULTANT's electrical SUBCONSULTANT Hillers Electric will attend a pre-construction conference. The CONSULTANT and SUBCONSULTANT will also attend a pre-construction site visit to familiarize the COUNTY's CONTRACTOR with the sites and walk through the CONTRACTOR's general construction plan.
- 1.2 **Submittal Review.** We anticipate that a total of 64 submittals and resubmittals will be received for this project (see table below for an initial list based on current knowledge of the project). The COUNTY will be responsible for reviewing a portion of these submittals with the balance to be reveiwed by the CONSULTANT and SUBCONSULTANT. The CONSULTANT and SUBCONSULTANT have budgeted for the review of up to 51 total shop drawings/submittals (including resubmittals rejected for deficiencies) for this rehabilitation project as noted in **Attachment E Submittal List**.
- 1.3 Requests for Information. The CONSULTANT will assist the COUNTY staff in preparing up to 10 responses to requests for information (RFIs) and 3 proposed construction contract modifications for this project.
- 1.4 **Progress Meetings.** The CONSULTANT will attend up to 12 site progress meetings, including a project closeout meeting, for this project with the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR staff.
- 1.5 **Payment Applications.** The CONSULTANT will review and provide recommendation to the COUNTY for acceptance of the contractor's progress applications for payment. The final approval for payment will be the COUNTY's responsibility.
- 1.6 **Record Drawings.** The CONSULTANT will prepare signed and sealed Record Drawings based on the CONTRACTOR provided red-line "As Builts."

Task 2 – Technical Oversight During Water Treatment Plant 8 Wells Rehabilitation

The CONSULTANT will provide part-time field construction management and technical oversight services from the onset of well construction activities until completion, but not more than a maximum duration of 12 months (365 calendar days).

- 2.1 Well Construction, Abandonment, Rehabilitation and Testing Services.
 The CONSULTANT will provide on-site technical oversight services during construction, rehabilitation and testing such as:
 - removal of the inner casing, screen, and gravel pack,
 - installation and cementing a liner inside the 24-inch diameter outer casing,
 - overdrilling, vibrating, or milling the 24-inch outer casing,
 - installation and cementing of a new 24-inch outer casing,
 - replacement of the screen and inner casing,
 - quantification of materials and observation of gravel pack placement,
 - describing drill cuttings,
 - well development and testing,
 - water sample collection,
 - · well disinfection.
 - · well abandonment.
 - well development and step drawdown testing, and
 - upgrades to the piping valves, wellhead, and instrumentation
- 2.2 **Technical Review and Evaluations.** The CONSULTANT will provide a technical review of the following:
 - water quality testing results,
 - screen and casing installation records,
 - gravel placement,
 - cementing records, and
 - well development data to determine acceptable well rehabilitation methods.
- 2.3 **Preparation of Daily Work Reports.** The CONSULTANT will prepare daily work reports supplemented by still photos on days when CONSULTANT performs technical oversight.

ASSUMPTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

CONSULTANT's scope of work is based on certain assumptions which determine the CONSULTANT's level of effort and therefore compensation, as follows:

- CONSULTANT and SUBCONSULTANTS shall comply with the COUNTY's security requirements in force at the time this work order is signed.
- The CONSULTANT's technical oversight services during construction Task 2 are based on 800 hours of well site geologist participation for the planned project duration (12 months). The COUNTY will provide the balance of required technical oversight and construction management services required to complete the project.
- Access will be provided by the COUNTY to the site of the work during construction activities.
- Laboratory work for water quality testing is not included.
- Public information, awareness, and involvement activities are not included in this scope of work.

- The COUNTY will perform all raw water pipeline inspection and verify installation of all materials.
- A copy of the Executed Contract Documents including Technical Specifications and Drawings will be furnished by the COUNTY for the CONSULTANT's use.
- Electronic files exchanged between the COUNTY and the CONSULTANT will be in a format compatible with MS Office 2007 and AutoCad.
- Records drawings will consist of the following:
 - o One Full size (22" x 34") hard copy
 - o One Half size (11" x 17") hard copy
 - o One PDF copy
 - One electronic copy in AutoCAD 2011
- All permits and permit application fees will be prepared and paid for by the COUNTY or the CONTRACTOR.
- One trip per day to the site on days when site visits are required.

COMPENSATION

The COUNTY shall pay the CONSULTANT a fee of \$298,419.46 for providing the services described in this scope of work, in accordance with Attachment A. Such fee shall be invoiced and paid for under the terms and conditions of the CONTRACT by the time plus expenses method of payment and once such amount is reached, CONSULTANT will not perform any additional work that would exceed this amount without prior written consent of the COUNTY.

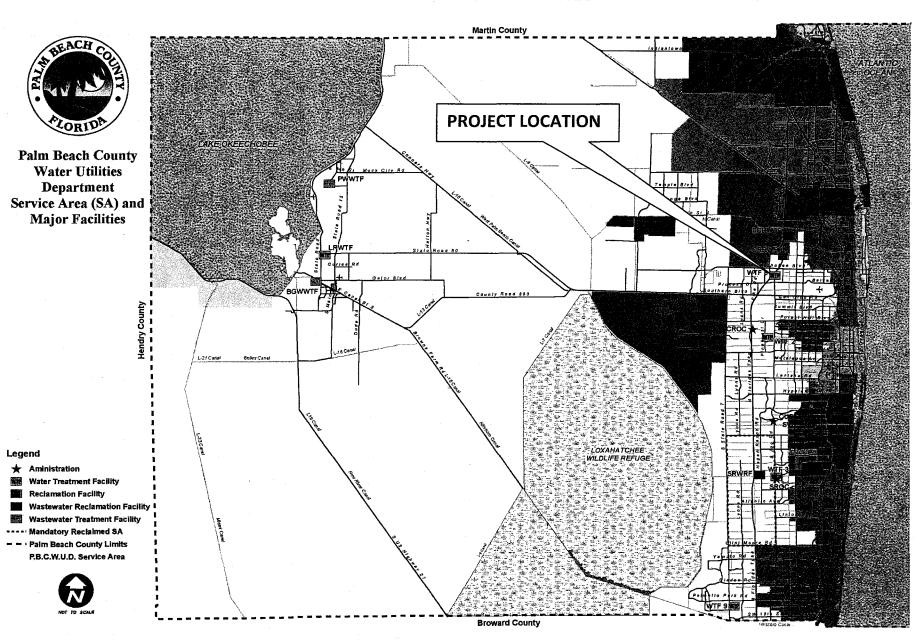

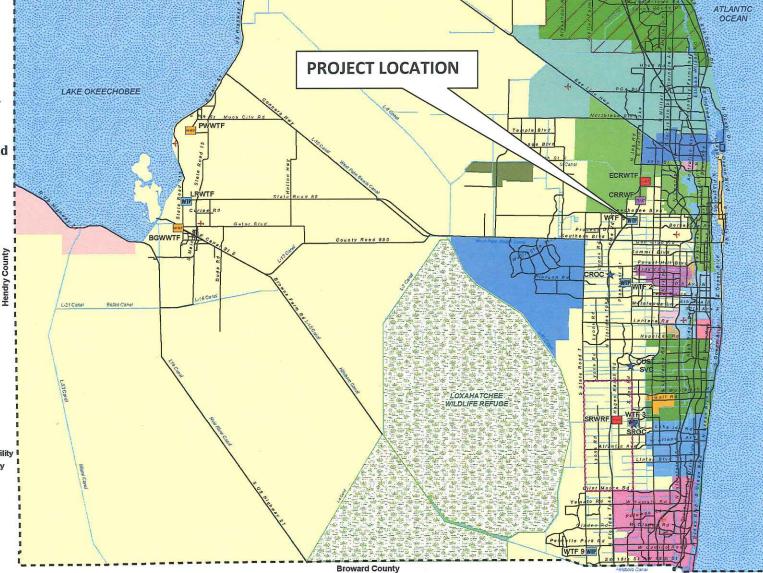

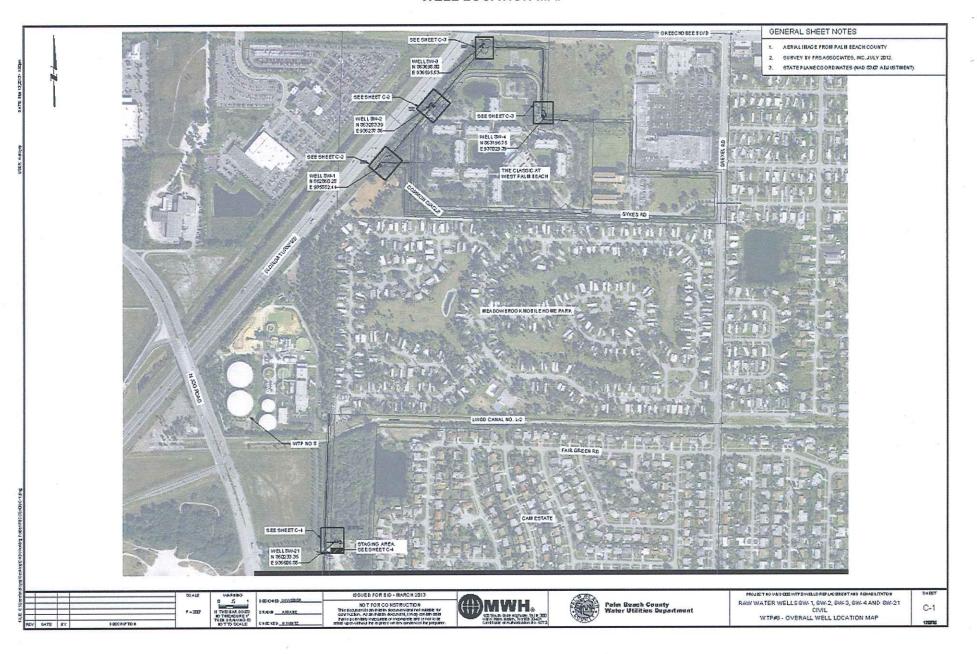

The bid opening for the above referenced project was held on Thursday, June 6, 2013. Proposals were received from four (4) contractors. The complete Bid Tabulation is attached. The engineer's opinion of probable construction cost was \$1,700,000 for Bid Item Numbers A-1 through E-2. An evaluation of the first low bid follows:

- 1. The low bidder, Southeast Drilling Services, Inc. properly executed the Bid Form provided in the Contract Documents.
- 2. The low bidder enclosed a Bid security equal to 5% of the total base bid.
- 3. The low bidder holds a valid state contractor's license and a water well contractor's license. A copy of the license information is included.
- 4. The low bidder has Local Preference and has submitted the required documentation.
