I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 45 with Mathews Consulting, Inc. (R2011-0633) for design of the reclaimed office and storage building facility at the East Central Regional Water Reclamation Facility (ECRWRF) in the amount of \$164,546.25.

Summary: On May 3, 2011, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Contract for Utility, Architectural and Value Engineering Services with Mathews Consulting, Inc. (R2011-0633) to obtain engineering/professional service for utility related projects. On June 18, 2013, the BCC approved Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement with the ECRWRF and the City of West Palm Beach related to the construction, operation and maintenance of reclaimed water facilities (R2013-0762). The proposed warehouse and office facilities at the ECRWRF onsite reclaimed water facilities will be paid from bond proceeds and reimbursed by FPL. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The contract with Mathews Consulting, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 55% overall. This Authorization includes 97.64% overall The cumulative SBE participation, including this CSA is 55.56% overall. participation. Mathews Consulting, Inc. is a local company. (WUD Project No. 13-061) District 7 (JM)

Background and Justification: Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department is under contract to supply from the ECRWRF allocation, reclaimed water to end users. In order to improve operations of the reclaimed facility and at the request of FPL and ECRWRF Board, the County desires to upgrade the ECRWRF onsite reclaimed water facilities by adding an additional building within the footprint of the onsite water reclamation facility, for the purpose of storing inventory, chemicals, parts and equipment as required for the reclaimed water production facilities.



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CONSULTANT SERVICE AUTHORIZATION NO. 45 PALM BEACH COUNTY WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT ENGINEERING/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

SCOPE OF WORK FOR

East Central Regional (ECR) Reclaimed Office & Storage Facility Site Planning, Permitting, Design Bid Documents and Bidding Services

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (COUNTY) entered into an agreement entitled Contract for Engineering/ Professional Services - Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Project No. WUD <u>11-004</u> (CONTRACT) with <u>Mathews Consulting</u>, Inc. (MC or CONSULTANT) to provide engineering services for various general activities on <u>May 3, 2011 with an effective date of June</u> <u>3, 2011</u> (Reference Document <u>R-2011-0633</u>). This Consultant Service Authorization will be performed under that CONTRACT.

BACKGROUND

This Consultant Services Authorization provides for the services for the site planning services, surveying, geotechnical, architectural and engineering design, permitting, preparation of bid documents, bidding services and cost estimating of a 3,750 square foot building including office and warehouse space for uses associated with the Reclaimed Water Treatment System located at the East Central Regional Water Reclamation Facility (ECRWRF).

Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (COUNTY) is under contract to supply from their allocation, reclaimed water to end users. The reclaimed water storage and transmission pump station is located at the ECRWRF and is operated by ECR staff under the direction of the City of West Palm Beach. As such, the design improvements proposed under this scope of work will be coordinated and reviewed with both COUNTY and ECR staff.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

TASK 1: SITE TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY & SITE PLANNING SERVICES

CONSULTANT shall hire a sub-consultant, Dennis J. Leavy, Associates (DJLA), to perform the following survey tasks:

• Provide topographic survey of the area of the proposed building including crosssections of the existing asphalt paved roadway and the shellrock roadway located east of the ground storage tank. Locate the above ground features in the area south of DIW #3, including but not limited to grates, rims, invert elevations, etc. of utilities, the wastewater lift station, trees, electrical panels, concrete pads etc. and below ground utilities as marked by the City of West Palm Beach and other utilities upon request.

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 Survey data shall be provided on the 88 NAVD Datum and be provided in Autocad format, version 2012.

CONSULTANT shall hire a sub-consultant, Urban Design Kilday Studios (UDKS), to perform site planning services as follows:

- Attendance at up to two (2) meetings with the COUNTY to discuss the project scope and goals.
- Review past approvals, documents and City of West Palm Beach Zoning Codes for applicable development regulations.
- Prepare a Site Plan utilizing a base drawing provided by the COUNTY. It is anticipated that modification of the civil/site plan base drawing from the *Reclaimed Water Facility at ECRWRF* project, (WUD #08-031) will be an acceptable document for the application to the City of West Palm Beach Planning Department. The site plan will include only the immediate vicinity of the COUNTY reclaimed water facilities and not the entire site within the ECRWRF property boundary.
- Prepare the following application documents:
 - 0 Informal Site Plan Application
 - Project Narrative/Justification Statement addressing review standards
 - Project Fact Sheet
 - Statements for parking, staffing and drainage
 - O Owner's Consent
- Attend one (1) Pre-Application meeting with the City of West Palm Beach Planning Department to receive the review the proposal.
- Submit one (1) complete Informal Site Plan Review application to the City. Obtain review comments and coordinate with the COUNTY and ECR staff on the response.
- Attend up to one (1) meeting with the City to review the comments.
- Prepare one (1) response letter, update application and site plan and resubmit to the City Planning Department.
- Provide one (1) copy of the final signed, approved site plan. A copy of the final submitted site plan shall be provided to the COUNTY in .pdf format.

CONSULTANT shall hire a sub-consultant, InfraMap, to perform soft digs utility locates on site.

TASK 2: DESIGN BID PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND COST ESTIMATES

CONSULTANT shall hire a sub-consultant, Dunkelberger Engineering & Testing, Inc. (DET), to perform geotechnical engineering services as follows:

 Stake one (1) boring and provide clearance through Sunshine utility network and coordinate with plant personnel for location of existing underground facilities. It is assumed that ECR staff will provide locating services within the proposed boring area.

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- Drill one (1) Standard Penetration Test (SPT) to a depth of 25 feet.
- Prepare a geotechnical engineering report of the results which will include a recommendation for the floor slab and foundation design for the proposed building.
- Provide two (2) signed and sealed copies of the report to the COUNTY.

CONSULTANT shall perform engineering services for the preparation of project design bid plans, specifications and costs estimates as detailed below. CONSULTANT shall hire as subconsultants Colome & Associations/JLRD Consulting Engineers, Bridge Design Associates and UDKS to assist in performance of the following design tasks:

- Prepare schematic (30%) civil and architectural design plans for the floor plan and general layout of the Reclaimed Office and Storage Facility and the associated utility connections, parking and driveway facilities.
- CONSULTANT shall submit three (3) sets of the 30% design documents (full scale drawings, no specifications or cost estimate) and a copy in .pdf format for review.
- Attend one (1) meeting with ECR and PBCWUD staff to receive the 30% review comments.
- Based upon the approved preliminary layout and design concepts presented in the 30% schematic design phase, MC and its sub-consultants shall prepare 60% design documents consisting of drawings and specifications for the Reclaimed Office and Storage Facility. The design shall include architectural, fire protection, structural, mechanical, plumbing, building electrical and associated civil utility connections, paving and grading, landscape and irrigation improvements. The design will include card swipe access control at the building doors as per the County's access control standards. The design will comply with the Palm Beach County Facilities Development and Operations Department's *Policy and Procedures Manual for Design Professionals*, dated May 2009, including the requirements for meeting or exceeding the Florida Energy Efficiency Code and the Building Code requirements of the City of West Palm Beach Building Department Standards.
- CONSULTANT shall prepare an Opinion of Cost based on the 60% level of design.
- CONSULTANT shall submit three (3) sets of the 60% design documents (full scale drawings) and a copy in .pdf format and technical specifications for review.
- CONSULTANT and design team shall attend one meeting with ECR and PBCWUD staff to review and discuss the 60% submittal.
- Upon receipt of 60% comments from ECR and PBCWUD, MC shall prepare 90% design documents consisting of drawings and specifications for the proposed improvements. The 90% design documents will include front end contract documents as provided by PBCWUD.

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- The color and interior finish selections shall be made by ECR and PBCWUD and incorporated into the design. A single color selection board shall be provided to ECR and PBCWUD in order to assist in the selection process.
- CONSULTANT shall prepare an Opinion of Cost based on the 90% level of design.
- CONSULTANT shall submit three (3) sets of the 90% design documents (full scale drawings) and a copy in .pdf format and technical specifications for review.
- CONSULTANT and design team shall attend one meeting with ECR and PBCWUD staff to review and discuss the 90% submittal.
- Upon receipt of 90% comments from ECR and PBCWUD, CONSULTANT shall prepare 100% design documents (bidding documents) consisting of drawings, specifications and cost estimate for the proposed improvements.
- CONSULTANT shall provide three (3) copies of the final contract documents (full size drawings) and a copy in .pdf format for ECR/PBCWUD's use.
- CONSULTANT shall provide project management coordination for the design project, including scheduling and conducting meetings between ECR/COUNTY staff and the design team, team coordination for receipt of comments, addressing comments, design drawings, specifications and cost estimate submittals, etc. In the event of disagreements between the two reviewing parties, the COUNTY shall resolve the issue and provide the final determination to the CONSULTANT.

TASK 3: PERMIT APPLICATION

CONSULTANT shall provide the following permit application tasks:

- CONSULTANT shall prepare and submit a permit application to the City of West Palm Beach and the Palm Beach County Health Department for design and construction approval of the potable water and fire line improvements.
- CONSULTANT shall address comments received on the application and submit final permit applications as necessary.
- CONSULTANT shall prepare and submit a Primary Building Permit Application to the City of West Palm Beach Development Services Department (Building Department). The application shall include a signed and sealed construction cost estimate for the purposes of calculating the review fees.
- CONSULTANT shall address comments received on the Building Permit application and submit revised plans as necessary to address the comments.

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TASK 4: BIDDING SERVICES

Bid Documents Advertisement:

CONSULTANT shall assist the COUNTY in advertising for and obtaining bids for the project. CONSULTANT shall provide twenty (20) sets of bidding documents and shall receive and process deposits for bidding documents and shall maintain a record of prospective bidders. <u>Pre-Bid Conference, Bid Opening:</u>

CONSULTANT shall attend Pre-Bid Conference, issue addenda and provide supplemental information or clarification, as appropriate, to all prospective bidders during the bid period.

CONSULTANT shall attend the Bid Opening, review bids and provide recommendation for award of the construction contract.

It is anticipated that a single lump sum base bid will be utilized.

Bid Clarification / Addenda:

CONSULTANT shall address questions and Requests for Information (RFI's) received by developing addendum document(s) for use by the COUNTY to issue to potential bidders. Addendum to provide corrections, supplemental information or clarification, as appropriate, to interpret, clarify, or expand the bidding documents. CONSULTANT shall address questions from potential bidders by directing a bidder to the section of the bid that answers their questions(s) or directing the bidder to submit a RFI.

Award Recommendation:

COUNTY will open bids and prepare bid tabulation. COUNTY will provide CONSULTANT with bid tabulation and bid responses received, either electronic copy or a hard copy. CONSULTANT shall assist COUNTY in evaluating bids, including reference checks, for an award recommendation to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. CONSULTANT shall submit to COUNTY written recommendation concerning contract award.

ASSUMPTIONS

- 1. Scope of work does not include property search or acquisition services, Phase 1 or 2 environmental studies or mitigation, boundary surveys, traffic studies or offsite roadway improvements.
- 2. A site plan shall be prepared on a base civil site drawing that includes only the immediate area of the proposed improvements and not the entire ECRWRF site. The base drawings (WUD #08-031) shall be provided in Autocad format by the COUNTY.
- 3. The design plans shall be prepared on the NAVD 1988 Datum.
- 4. Preparation of color renderings are not included herein.
- 5. The scope of work does not include preparation of documentation or application for LEED credits or LEED certification for the project.

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- 6. Application for City of West Palm Beach Fire Department review for life safety is assumed to be conducted during the Building Permit application.
- 7. Provision of emergency power (e.g. connection to emergency generator) to the building is not included in this scope of work.
- 8. The design plans prepared by CONSULTANT shall reflect lighting of the parking lot and surrounding areas of the building by building wall mounted LED fixtures. Separate site lighting plans are not included.
- 9. No permit application is anticipated for the sanitary sewer lateral connection to the existing site sanitary sewer system. In the event that wastewater service cannot be provided via a sanitary lateral and gravity sanitary sewer is required, the permitting of these improvements will be additional services.
- 10. All design drawings shall be prepared in AutoCad v. 2012 format.
- 11. Palm Beach County Water Utility Minimum Engineering Standards (2012) will be incorporated into the water and wastewater system design. It is anticipated that potable water for domestic and fire protection will be provided from a tap on the existing watermain located along the roadway to the north of the proposed building. The building will be served by extending a sanitary sewer <u>lateral</u> to the existing gravity sewer west of the existing wastewater lift station.
- 12. Building power shall be fed from existing electrical service location within a maximum of 300 feet of the proposed building.
- 13. The COUNTY shall pay all fees associated with permit applications.
- 14. The landscape plans shall be prepared to address minimum code requirements for planting quantities, types, and specifications.
- 15. The scope assumes that the existing irrigation system may be expanded to accommodate the proposed improvements.
- 16. Application for a Water Use Permit from the South Florida Water Management District for irrigation purposes is not included in this scope of work.
- 17. Construction Administration and Inspection services are not included in this Authorization.
- 18. A modification to the site's FDEP Environmental Resource Permit for management of stormwater is not anticipated to be required due to the project being less than 10 acres total, and less than 2 acres new impervious area.

COMPENSATION

COUNTY agrees to pay CONSULTANT a fee of <u>\$ 164,546.25</u> for the scope of services to be invoiced under the payment terms and conditions of the CONTRACT on a Not-To-Exceed basis. An approximate breakdown of the fee is shown in Attachment B.


