**Summary:** The Palm Beach County Internal Audit Committee consists of five members appointed at large by the BCC. Prospective members must have experience in business or finance, government accounting, auditing, operations or financial management, or other relevant experience. Memos were sent to all Board members seeking nominations for Seat 1 on July 1 and August 13, 2013. Countywide (PFK)

**Background and Justification:** The Audit Committee was established in August, 1987 by resolution R-87-1226. In February, 2005 the Audit Committee was restructured and a new process for approval of the two citizen members of the Committee was established by Resolution R-2005-0372. Ordinance 2010-006, adopted March 23, 2010, eliminated the former 7 member audit committee and established a new five member audit committee consisting of individuals who are independent of the County organization and have experience in business or finance; government accounting, auditing, operations or financial management; or other relevant experience. Applications from interested individuals meeting the required qualifications were solicited and three individuals submitted applications to serve on the Internal Audit Committee. The Internal Audit Committee was established for the purpose of assisting the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners in fulfilling its oversight and governance responsibilities of county operations and providing advice and recommendations to the County Internal Auditor. The membership of the Internal Audit Committee will consist of three white males and one Asian-American male after the reappointment. The prospective members include to two white males and an African-American female.

#### BOARD APPOINTMENT APPLICATION BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Committee was established by Ordinance 2010-006 that was adopted March 23, 2010. Section 4 – Composition of the Ordinance establishes the membership requirements and composition of the Committee. The Section reads as follows:

- A. The Internal Audit Committee shall be composed of five members appointed by the BCC and shall not include any county commissioners as members.
- B. All five members shall be citizens of Palm Beach County, independent of elected and appointed county officials and employees, and not employed in any capacity by the BCC or by an entity subject to audit by the County Internal Auditor.
- C. Membership of the Internal Audit Committee will be to the greatest extent possible representative of the community-at-large and reflect the racial, gender and ethnic make-up of the community.
- D. The members' terms shall be three years and staggered so that the Internal Audit Committee annually includes a new member and members with one and two years of service.
- E. Each member shall serve no more than two consecutive full terms.
- F. Committee members shall have experience in business or finance; government accounting, auditing, operations or financial management; or other relevant experience.
- G. The chair of the Internal Audit Committee will be elected by the members of the Internal Audit Committee to serve a single two year term.

**Audit Committee Vacancies** 

Ordinance 2010-006 established the Palm Beach County Internal Audit Committee with five members appointed at-large by the BCC. The Audit Committee's purpose is to assist the BCC in its oversight and governance responsibilities, and in providing advice and recommendations to the County Internal Auditor. Members serve three year terms.

The terms of two of the five members will expire on August 16, 2013. One currently serving member, David Rosenstein, is eligible for reappointment and is willing to continue serving on the Committee. Mr. Rosenstein has satisfactorily completed the appropriate Ethics and Sunshine Law training requirements. Mr. Rosenstein has had one excused absence since being appointed in 2010. His original term was for three years as required to establish the staggered rotation schedule for the five seats. The other currently serving member, Dorritt Miller, has decided to step down from the audit committee after serving since March 2006. The audit committee is currently searching for candidates and Board recommendations are encouraged.


