I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change order No. 6 in the amount of \$87,399.30 and a 49 day time extension to the contract with J.W. Cheatham, LLC for the Seminole Pratt Whitney Road, South of the M Canal to South of Orange Boulevard project (R2012-1211) (Project).

SUMMARY: Approval of change order No. 6 will compensate for costs and delays associated with additional work required on the Project, due to unforeseen soil conditions encountered during lake excavation and utility trench dewatering. Change order No. 6 is being brought to the Board of County Commissioners because the total value, (including the monetary value of the time extension) exceeds the individual change order threshold of \$100,000 referenced in PPM-CWF-50.

District 6 (MRE)

Background and Justification: During construction, it was discovered that a layer of rock existed where water management ponds one and two were being dug as well as in various locations where utility trench dewatering was being performed. Due to the differing site conditions, unforeseeable work was required to perform the pond excavations and the utility trench dewatering. An additional 49 contract days was required to complete the unforeseeable work.



We have evaluated the impact of the unforeseen and non-disclosed hardened rock formation in our scope of work since our notification letter was provided to you on 4/5/13. This rock formation impacted the following scope items with cost values:

Dewatering System Well-points:

The rock to the northern portion of the impacted areas took as long as 20 minutes additional time per point to penetrate with our well-point drilling rig whereas the southern portion of the impacted areas took as long as 3 minutes additional time to penetrate. This is an average of 10 minutes additional time spent per point. With our points installed at 3 feet on centers, that is 1550 points x 10 additional minutes = 15,500 Minutes or 258 Hours of additional well-point drilling required. Our Komatsu 138 Excavator w/ Drill Attachment = \$150/HR x 258 HRS= \$38,700.00

We have obtained and reviewed additional soils information based on new SPT borings performed along the segment of drainage system previously discussed.

Based upon this review, Roadway Production agrees it is reasonable to conclude that the Contractor encountered materials during the trench dewatering, that was significantly different from what was anticipated when the project was bid.

We are therefore recommending that a change Order be issued increasing the quantity of Subsoil Excavation for the project by the amount of 7,128 cy with a comparable decrease in the quantity of Lake Excavation – both quantities to be verified prior to final payment by actual cross sectioning (net value \$24,948), and also that additional payment be made to the Contractor for work required to dewater for the drainage system (net value (62,451,13). Total recommended additional payment is \$87,399.30

Also we would recommend that 49 additional days be granted for this work. Please see the background information supporting our recommendations attached.

CONTRACT AND FDOT SPEC (2010 GOVERNS) EXCERPTS FOLLOW:

SP-13 SUBSOIL EXCAVATION:

Where muck, <u>rock</u>, clay, or other material within the limits of the roadway is unsuitable in its original position, excavate such material to the cross-sections shown in the plans or indicated by the Engineer, and backfill with suitable material.

2-4 Examination of Plans, Specifications, Special Provisions and Site of Work:

Examine the Contract Documents and the site of the proposed work carefully before submitting a proposal for the work contemplated. Investigate the conditions to be encountered, as to the character, quality, and quantities of work to be performed and materials to be furnished and as to the requirements of all Contract Documents.

The Department does not guarantee the details pertaining to borings, as shown on the plans to be more than a general indication of the materials likely to be found adjacent to holes bored at the site of the work, approximately at the locations indicated. The Contractor shall examine boring data where available, and make his own interpretation of the subsoil investigations and other preliminary data, and shall base his bid on his own opinion of the conditions likely to be encountered.

The bidder's submission of a proposal is prima facie evidence that the bidder has made an examination as described in this Article.

4-3.7 Differing Site Conditions:

During the progress of the work, if subsurface or latent physical conditions are encountered at the site differing materially from those indicated in the Contract, or if unknown physical conditions of an unusual nature differing materially from those ordinarily encountered and generally recognized as inherent in the work provided for in the Contract are encountered at the site, the party discovering such conditions shall promptly notify the other party in writing of the specific differing conditions before the Contractor disturbs the conditions or performs the affected work.

Upon receipt of written notification of differing site conditions from the Contractor, the Engineer will investigate the conditions, and if it is determined that the conditions materially differ and cause an increase or decrease in the cost or time required for the performance of any work under the Contract, an adjustment will be made excluding loss of anticipated profits, and the Contract will be modified in writing accordingly. The Engineer will notify the Contractor whether or not an adjustment of the Contract is warranted.

4-4 Unforeseeable Work - DELETE AND INSERT THE FOLLOWING:

When the Department requires work that is not covered by a price in the Contract, and the Department finds that such work is essential to the satisfactory completion of the Contract within its intended scope, the Department will make an adjustment to the Contract. The Engineer will determine the basis of payment for such an adjustment in a fair and equitable amount.

120-2.3 Subsoil Excavation:

<u>Subsoil Excavation consists of the excavation and disposal of muck, clay, rock</u>, or any other material that is unsuitable in its original position and that is excavated below the finished grading template. For stabilized bases and sand bituminous road mixes, consider the finished grading template as the top of the finished base, shoulders and slopes. For all other bases and rigid pavement, consider the finished grading template as the finished shoulder and slope lines and bottom of completed base or rigid pavement. For pond and ditches that identify the placement of a blanket material, consider the finished grading template as the bottom of the blanket material. Subsoil Excavation also consists of the

excavation of all suitable material within the above limits as necessary to excavate the unsuitable material. Consider the limits of Subsoil Excavation indicated on the plans as being particularly variable, in accordance with the field conditions actually encountered.

The quantity of material required to replace the excavated material and to raise the elevation of the roadway to the bottom of the template will be paid for under Embankment or Borrow Excavation (Truck Measure).

120-3 Preliminary Soils Investigations:

When the plans contain the results of a soil survey, do not assume such data is a guarantee of the depth, extent, or character of material present.

125-4.4 Pipe Trench Excavation:

Excavate trenches for pipe culverts and storm sewers to the elevation of the bottom of the pipe and to a width sufficient to provide adequate working room. <u>Remove soil not meeting the classification specified as suitable backfill material in 125-8.3.2.2</u>, to a depth of 4 inches below the bottom of the pipe elevation. <u>Remove rock</u> boulders or other hard lumpy or unyielding material to a depth of 12 inches below the bottom of the pipe elevation.

125-14.7 Removal and Replacement of Material Unsuitable for Backfill:

When it cannot reasonably be anticipated from information contained in the plans, that material excavated for the structure will be unsuitable for use as backfill, and such material proves to be unsuitable for this use, the work of disposing of such material away from the site will be paid for as unforeseeable work and the work of bringing in substitute material for the backfill will be paid for as specified for the particular case shown below:

(c) When the necessary material is not available from the normal excavation or grading operations and no separate item for Borrow Excavation is included in the Contract, any backfill material obtained by increasing the volume of excavation within the roadway right of way will be measured and paid for as regular excavation subject to the provisions of 9-3.2.2.
