I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to Appoint: L. Marc Cohn as the Alternate Member to serve on Internal Audit Committee for the remainder of a three year term ending September 30, 2016.

Summary: The Palm Beach County Internal Audit Committee ordinance was revised November 19, 2013 to provide for five regular members and one alternate member appointed at large by the BCC. At the September 10, 2013 BCC meeting, the Board directed staff to revise the ordinance to incorporate an alternate member for the committee and suggested Mr. Cohn serve as the alternate member once that position was established in the ordinance. Countywide (PFK)

Background and Justification: The Audit Committee was established in August, 1987 by resolution R-87-1226. Ordinance 2010-006, adopted March 23, 2010, established a new five member audit committee consisting of individuals who are independent of the County organization and have experience in business or finance; government accounting, auditing, operations or financial management; or other relevant experience. Ordinance 2013-030, adopted November 25, 2013, added an alternate member to the existing five members. The Internal Audit Committee was established for the purpose of assisting the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners in fulfilling its oversight and governance responsibilities of county operations and providing advice and recommendations to the County Internal Auditor. The membership of the Internal Audit Committee will consist of four white males, one Asian-American male and one African-American female after this appointment.

PALM BEACH COUNTY INTERNAL AUDIT COMMITTEE

BOARD APPOINTMENT APPLICATION BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Committee was established by Ordinance 2010-006 adopted March 23, 2010 and revised by Ordinance 2013-030 adopted November 25, 2013. Section 4 – Composition of the Ordinance establishes the membership requirements and composition of the Committee. The Section reads as follows:

- A. The Internal Audit Committee shall be composed of five members, and one alternate member, appointed by the BCC and shall not include any county commissioners as members. The alternate member may only participate and vote when another member is absent from a committee meeting.
- B. All members shall be citizens of Palm Beach County, independent of elected and appointed county officials and employees, and not employed in any capacity by the BCC or by an entity subject to audit by the County Internal Auditor.
- C. Membership of the Internal Audit Committee will be to the greatest extent possible representative of the community-at-large and reflect the racial, gender and ethnic makeup of the community.
- D. The members' terms shall be three years and staggered so that the Internal Audit Committee annually includes a new member and members with one and two years of service. The members terms shall begin on October 1st and end on September 30th.
- E. Each member shall serve no more than three consecutive full terms. Any vacancy occurring during a term shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the tern and shall not count towards the member's term limits. Members must reside in the County at the time of appointment and while serving of the committee.
- F. Committee members shall have experience in business or finance; government accounting, auditing, operations or financial management; or other relevant experience.
- G. The chair of the Internal Audit Committee will be elected by the members of the Internal Audit Committee to serve a single two year term.

Committee meeting schedule:

The Ordinance requires the Committee to meet at least quarterly.

The Committee currently meets on the third Wednesday of March, June, September and December. Additional meetings are scheduled as necessary.

CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIPS: Pursuant to Article XIII, Sec. 2-443 of the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics, advisory board members are prohibited from entering into any contract or other transaction for goods or services with Palm Beach County. Bxceptions to this prohibition include awards made under sealed competitive bids, certain emergency and sole source purchases, and transactions that do not exceed \$500 per year in aggregate. These exemptions are described in the Code. This prohibition does not apply when the advisory board member's board provides no regulation, oversight, management, or policy-setting recommendations regarding the subject contract or transaction and the contract or transaction is disclosed at a public meeting of the Board of County Commissioners. To determine compliance with this provision, it is necessary that you, as a board member applicant, identify all contractual relationships between Palm Beach County government and you as an individual, directly or indirectly, or your employer or business. This information should be provided in the space below. If there are no contracts or transactions to report, please verify that none exist. Staff will review this information and detormine if you are eligible to serve or if you may be eligible for an exception or waiver pursuant to the code.
