EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER NATIONAL BOARD PROGRAM PHASE 31 LOCAL RECIPIENT ORGANIZATION CERTIFICATION

By signing this Local Recipient Organization (LRO) Certification Form, our agency certifies we have read and understand the Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP) Phase 30 Responsibilities and Requirements Manual and Phase 31 Addendum, including the Grant Agreement Articles, Financial Terms and Conditions, and Other Terms and Conditions as well as the Eligible and Ineligible Costs and Documentation sections and agree to comply with all program requirements.
