## I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title:** Staff recommends a motion to adopt: A Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, rescinding responding Resolution R-2008-0456 as required by Chapter 171, Part II, Florida Statutes; and providing an effective date.

**Summary**: On February 4, 2008, the City of Greenacres adopted an initiating Resolution No. 2008-05 pursuant to Chapter 171, Part II, Florida Statutes (F.S.), as a first step in the process of completing an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement (ISBA) for an area designated within the City's future annexation area. Pursuant to Statutory requirements, the County adopted a responding Resolution R-2008-0456 within 60 days after the receipt of the City's adopted initiating resolution, allowing the local governments to commence the negotiating process for the ISBA. After two years of negotiations, the City of Greenacres adopted Ordinance No. 2010-32 to execute the ISBA. On December 9, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) unanimously denied a motion to schedule a public hearing to consider adoption of an ordinance for the ISBA. This action ended negotiations with the City of Greenacres regarding the ISBA. To alleviate concerns of residents within the future annexation area of the City of Greenacres, this Resolution serves to rescind the responding Resolution R-2008-0456. <u>Districts 2 and 3 (RB)</u>

**Background and Justification:** Chapter 163.3171(3), F.S., authorizes municipalities and counties to jointly enter into agreements to exercise the powers granted to the County and municipalities. Additionally, the Municipal Annexation or Contraction Act, Chapter 171, Part I, F.S., and Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement Act, Chapter 171, Part II, F.S., recognizes the use of Interlocal Service Boundary Agreements as a means to coordinate future land use, public facilities and services, in advance of annexation. As such, the County complied with the Statutes in adopting a responding Resolution after receipt of the initiating Resolution from the City of Greenacres. The Resolution identified issues to be negotiated with municipalities related to annexation, municipal service areas, and joint planning. After several ISBA negotiating sessions, the local governments came to a consensus on an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement; however, the BCC unanimously denied a motion to schedule a public hearing to consider adoption of an ordinance for the ISBA. Therefore, negotiations ended, and the responding Resolution will be rescinded.

#### A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESPONDING RESOLUTION R-2008-0456 AS REQUIRED BY CHAPTER 171, PART II, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2008, the City of Greenacres adopted an Initiating Resolution No. 2008-05, pursuant to Chapter 171, Part II, F.S., to commence the negotiation process for an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2008, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the responding Resolution R-2008-0456 pursuant to Chapter 171, Part II, F.S., within 60 days after the receipt of an initiating Resolution to commence the negotiation process for an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement (referred to herein as the "ISBA") with the City of Greenacres; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2010, the City of Greenacres adopted an ordinance No. 2010-32 authorizing the City to execute an ISBA between the City and Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners made a motion to not move forward with the public hearing process for this ISBA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF

**PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that the responding Resolution R-2008-0456 is hereby rescinded. The Clerk is hereby directed to provide a copy of this Resolution by United States Mail to the Chief Administrative Office of every participating municipality listed in Exhibit "A". The provisions of this Resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.

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#### RESOLUTION NO. R-2008-0456

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A RESPONDING RESOLUTION, AUTHORIZING PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA TO COMMENCE THE NEGOTIATION PROCESS FOR AN INTERLOCAL SERVICE BOUNDARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF GREENACRES, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 171, PART II, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Coordination Element of the 1989 Comprehensive Plan states that Palm Beach County shall adopt policies and implement strategies which support municipal efforts to secure boundary changes that maintain cost-effective service delivery, assisting with the elimination of enclaves, pockets and finger-like areas, and ensure consistency between municipal and County land use; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Coordination Element Policy of the 1989 Comprehensive Plan requires Palm Beach County to support municipal efforts to secure boundary changes; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Coordination Element Policy of the 1989 Comprehensive Plan requires the County to work with municipalities to determine areas to be considered for annexation; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 171, Part II, Florida Statutes (2007), as amended, establishes the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement process as a flexible, joint planning option for Counties and municipalities to cooperatively adjust municipal boundaries while planning for service delivery and land use changes; and

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2008, the City of Greenacres adopted an Initiating Resolution pursuant to Chapter 171, Part II, F.S., to commence the negotiation process for an interlocal service boundary agreement for an area (referred to herein as the "Area") described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenacres complied with Chapter 171.203(1)(b), F.S., by sending a notification of the initiating resolution by United States certified mail to each municipality within Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 171, Part II, Florida Statutes (2007), states that the Responding Resolution be presented to the Board of County Commissioners within sixty (60) days of receipt of the City's adoption of their Initiating Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Palm Beach County to negotiate an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement with the City of Greenacres for the area described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

The Board of County Commissioners hereby agrees to negotiate in good faith with Section 1. the City of Greenacres, in accordance with Chapter 171.203, Florida Statutes, to prepare an Interlocal Agreement to provide for a streamlined annexation and land use amendment process and schedule for properties within the "Area" and to designate the service provider(s) for the services identified in Section 2 herein.

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Section 2.

Palm Beach County agrees that negotiations regarding an Interlocal Service

Boundary Agreement will address, at a minimum, issues concerning service delivery, fiscal responsibilities, and boundary adjustment as they concern the City's and the County's responsibilities for the funding and delivery of the following services:

- a. Police
- b. Fire rescue and emergency medical
- c. Water and wastewater
- d. Road ownership, construction and maintenance including street lights
- e. Conservation, parks and recreation
- f. Stormwater management and drainage

<u>Section 3.</u> Negotiations regarding an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement will address land use designations within the area outlined in Exhibit "A" and the future vision for this area.

<u>Section 4.</u> In accordance with Chapter 171.203, Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners hereby concurs with the City of Greenacres to invite the City of Atlantis, the Village of Palm Springs, and the Town of Lantana to participate in the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement negotiations, as the municipal borders and/or the future annexation areas are contiguous to the area.

<u>Section 5.</u> The provisions of this resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.


