I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order No. 1 to Contract (R2013-0064) with Industrial Divers Corp. Inc. (IDC) in the amount of \$39,564.88 for Mooring Buoys Project #2012ERM03 extending quarterly maintenance for two (2) years, maintaining four (4) additional buoys, and adding materials for replacement.

Summary: The proposed Change Order of \$39,564.88 to an original Contract value of \$61,344 with IDC renews quarterly maintenance for two (2) additional years as allowed in the Contract at a cost of \$32,400.80. The Change Order also provides maintenance for the four (4) new buoys installed by the Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) in September 2013 at a cost of \$3,215.68. A provision for replacement materials is added on an "as-needed" basis up to \$3,948.40. There is no Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation on this Contract. Costs for the maintenance are covered by Vessel Registration Fees previously allocated by Resolution R-2012-0501 on April 3, 2012. Districts 1, 4, 7 (JM)

Background and Justification: On April 3, 2012, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved a Grant Agreement (R2012-0500) for a FWC Florida Boating Improvement Program Grant for \$45,180 partially funding buoy purchase and placement. Approval of Resolution R2012-0501 further authorized disbursement of Vessel Registration Fee Trust Fund moneys for maintenance of the buoys. A Contract in the amount of \$61,344 was issued on September 11, 2012 to IDC (R2013-0064) to install twenty-eight (28) mooring buoys and thirty-eight (38) anchor pins at several locations in Palm Beach County. The initial Contract allowed for construction and one (1) year of quarterly maintenance with an option of two (2) one-year extensions. Buoys were installed in September2012. The Change Order's maintenance unit prices increased 1.5% as allowed in the Contract.



The undersigned Bidder agrees that, if awarded the Contract hereunder, it shall (a) commence the mooring buoy anchors/buoys installation (Installation) work (Commencement Date) to be performed under the Contract on the date set by the County in its written partial notice to proceed, (b) commence the quarterly inspections/maintenance under the Contract on the date set by the County in its written partial notice to proceed, (c) continue the work with diligence, (d) Substantially Complete <u>and</u> invoice all Installation work under this Contract within ninety (90) calendar days after the Commencement Date, and (e) complete <u>and</u> invoice the County for each quarterly inspection/maintenance by the end of each Quarter (March 31, June 30, September 30, December 31). The Contract Time for Substantial Completion of the Installation work includes four (4) Inclement Weather calendar days. Final Completion for the Installation work shall be 30 (thirty) calendar days after Substantial Completion and shall be specified in the Punch list. Substantial Completion is defined in the General Conditions. Following completion of the Installation work, the initial Contract Time for four (4) quarterly inspections/maintenance is one (1) year. The Contract Time may be extended for two (2) additional 1-year periods, upon approval by the Contractor and the Board of County Commissioners. The undersigned agrees that, if awarded the Contract, it shall complete said separable portions of work in accordance with such date(s).

1.6.1 Should the Contractor (or in the event of a default, its Surety) fail to achieve Substantial Completion by the contractually established date of the Installation work, the County will suffer damages, the amount of which is difficult if not impossible to ascertain, and the County shall be entitled to Liquidated Damages as specified for each calendar day beyond the Contractual end date for the Installation work, until certification of Substantial Completion and acceptance of the Installation work has been given by the County. The Liquidated Damages rate is \$275 per calendar day through the date of certification of Substantial Completion work.

1.6.2 Should the Contractor (or in the event of a default, its Surety) fail to achieve Final Completion for the Installation work within the time specified in the Punch list, the County will suffer damages, the amount of which is difficult if not impossible to ascertain, and the County shall be entitled to Liquidated Damages as specified for each calendar day beyond the date specified in the Punch list, until certified for Final Completion of the Installation work. The Liquidated Damages rate is \$275 per calendar day through the date of certification of Final Completion of the Installation work, except as provided in Paragraph 1.6.1 above.

Liquidated Damages due the County may be deducted from payments due the Contractor, or may be collected directly from the Contractor or its surety or sureties. The liability of the Contractor and its Surety or Sureties for delay damages shall be joint and several. These provisions for liquidated damages shall not prevent the County, in case of the Contractor's default, from terminating the right of the Contractor to proceed as provided in General Conditions.

1.7 The Costs Savings Incentive provisions of the General Conditions are in effect for this Contract.

1.8 If the undersigned is notified of the acceptance of this bid, the Bidder agrees to execute within fourteen (14) calendar days, a Contract for the above work, complete with all required insurance certificates, and any resolutions or other documentation the department may reasonably require.
