EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) A contract with Drawdy Construction Company, Inc. (Drawdy) in the amount of \$647,089 for the construction of A1A Carlin Park Bridge Replacement (Project); and
- B) A budget amendment of \$11,520 in the Transportation Improvement Fund to recognize reimbursement funding from the Town of Jupiter and appropriate it to the Project.

SUMMARY: Approval of this contract will allow Palm Beach County to issue a notice to proceed to Drawdy, a Palm Beach County company, to begin construction of the Project. The Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for all projects is 15% overall. The SBE participation proposed for the Project by Drawdy is 97.56%.

District 1 (MRE)

Background and Justification: Bids for the Project were received by the Engineering Department on October 24, 2013. Drawdy was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The Office of Small Business Assistance issued its evaluation on November 8, 2013. Time to complete all work under this Contract shall be no more than 150 calendar days.

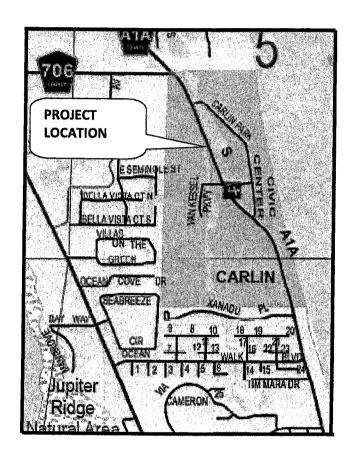
