I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 11 with Carollo Engineers, Inc. (R2011-0630) for Water Treatment Plant No. 2 Filter Replacement engineering services during construction in the amount of \$675,933.

Summary: On May 3, 2011, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the Contract for Water Plant and Water Resources Engineering Services with Carollo Engineers, Inc. (R2011-0630) to obtain engineering/professional service for utility related projects. This CSA will provide for construction services related to the Water Treatment Plant No. 2 Filter Replacement project. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The contract with Carollo Engineers, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 26% overall. This CSA includes 33.05% overall participation. The cumulative SBE participation, including this CSA is 29.67% overall. Carollo Engineers, Inc. is a Palm Beach County company. This project is included in the FY13-14 Capital Improvement plan adopted by the Board of County Commissioners. (WUD Project No. 12-066) <u>District 2</u> (JM)

Background and Justification: On December 4, 2012, the Board approved CSA No. 8 for Carollo Engineers, Inc. in the amount of \$926,373 to provide engineering services for the design of the replacement filters at Water Treatment Plant No. 2. CSA No. 11 provides for engineering services during construction of the Water Treatment Plant No. 2 Filter Replacement Project.



SCOPE OF WORK FOR

Water Treatment Plant NO. 2 – Filter Replacement; Engineering Services During Construction

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (COUNTY) entered into an agreement entitled Contract for Engineering/ Professional Services - Palm Beach County Utilities Department Project No. WUD <u>11-001</u> (CONTRACT) with. <u>Carollo Engineers, Inc.</u>(CONSULTANT) to provide engineering services for various general activities on (Reference Document <u>R2011</u> <u>0630</u>). This Consultant Service Authorization will be performed under that CONTRACT.

This Consultant Services Authorization encompasses providing services related to the construction of the Filter Replacement Project at Water Treatment Plant No. 2.

BACKGROUND

CONSULTANT has designed, permited, and bid a water treatment filter addition at WTP 2. These new dual media filters with reinforced concrete construction will replace the existing train 1 and 2 steel constructed filters (the filters associated with Precipitator Nos. 1 and 2). The filter addition will include backwash and transfer pumps, a filter air scour system, a washwater recovery basin and pump station, associated electrical and instrumentation, site and drainage improvements. The existing filters, ozone contact basin, and 1 MG water storage tank will be demolished. The CONSULTANT has completed the design and with this CSA will provide support services for construction of the new filters.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

CONSULTANT shall perform the engineering Scope of Services as described herein.

CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT SERVICES

Carollo Engineers (hereinafter referenced as ENGINEER) shall perform the following construction engineering support services associated with the construction of the filters and washwater recovery system addition at PBCWUD WTP NO. 2.

The following construction engineering support services have been based upon the direction provided by PBCWUD staff. The construction administration and inspection services will be primarily provided by PBCWUD staff. ENGINEER shall assist the

PBCWUD construction administrative and inspection staff in the execution of this construction project.

Task 1 Construction Administration

Work efforts for this task include the following:

- Construction Meetings. The ENGINEER shall attend and participate in regular construction progress meetings. Discussion topics, action items, and decisions made at these meeting will be recorded in the meeting minutes produced by PBCWUD staff. For the purposes of this scope of work it is anticipated that the there will be two meetings per month over the entire projected construction period.
- 2. Request for Information (RFIs) Processing. ENGINEER shall prepare written responses to questions from the Contractor regarding interpretation of the contract documents. The RFIs to be processed by the ENGINEER will be provided to the ENGINEER by PBCWUD construction staff. ENGINEER shall communicate with the CONTRACTOR through PBCWUD construction staff only. Responses will be provided to PBCWUD within 10 working days of receipt of RFI. A maximum of 125 RFIs are assumed for this task.
- 3. <u>Submittal Reviews.</u> ENGINEER shall review shop drawings, construction schedules, pay applications, material samples, laboratory tests, mill tests results, and related information and provide responses within twenty-one (21) calendar days to PBCWUD staff regarding the suitability of the proposed equipment and materials to be incorporated into the project. O & M manual reviews will be accomplished by PBCWUD staff. Items reviewed, actions taken (including allowed substitutions), and recommendations made will be maintained in a log. It is assumed that up to 125 submittals will be reviewed as part of this task. Additional reviews of a particular submittal after the second time it has been reviewed are not included in this assumed number of submittals.
- 4. Change OrderReview/Processing. ENGINEER shall review change requests provided to ENGINEER by PBCWUD staff and make recommendations to the PBCWUD regarding the acceptance or rejection of the proposed change. For the purposes of this scope of work it is anticipated that the there will be 10 change orders (including Field Orders) requiring ENGINEER'S support.

Task 2 Specialty Inspections & Materials Testing

Primary inspection services shall be provided by PBCWUD staff. The ENGINEER shall, at critical points of the construction, provide specialty inspection services in the construction areas of geotechnical, mechanical, structural, process, electrical, and instrumentation. No specialty inspections will be provided in the areas of civil construction. Specialty inspections shall be accomplished by engineers experienced in the identified discipline fields. Electrical and I & C inspections, loop checks, and PLC programming verification services shall be performed by the ENGINEER.

CONSULTANT shall retain and pay for services of independent testing laboratory to perform routine tests of materials to confirm compliance with requirements of Contract Documents. This includes sampling and laboratory testing for items such as proctor tests on soil samples, sieve analysis, organic content of soils, and testing concrete cylinders and grout prisms for compressive strength. Construction testing

services will include conducting slump, air content, and temperature on concrete; preparing concrete cylinders and grout prisms for curing and storage; providing asphalt field testing and observations; and providing a technician to collect samples at the project site. Re-tests, as a result of a failed test, shall be paid by CONTRACTOR.

Task 3 Start-up Services

For start-up services the CONSULTANT shall provide a Project Engineer onsite to facilitate startup with manufacturer's representatives, contractor, and Owner. This includes:

- Attend startup planning and coordination meeting with Owner, Contractor, and Filter System Supplier to discuss startup plan.
- Coordinate temporary water supply piping, washwater disposal, and controls with Owner
- Provide independent review of manufacturer's startup plan
- Review manufacturer's protocol for sample collection
- Provide independent review of analytical test results, including particle size distribution, acid solubility tests, specific gravity tests, and sieve analyses.
- Review contractor's sequencing plan for completing the functional testing, disinfecting the filter system, and placing the new filter system into operation.
- Provide Engineer of Record certifications to the Palm Beach County Health
 Department to obtain contingent clearance to place new filter system into service.
 Submit Engineer of Record certifications following startup and commissioning to
 obtain final clearance of filter system.
- Participate during plant shutdown and observe contractor's operations to place new filter system into service.
- · Participate in operational training
- Provide support during startup
- Provide programming services noted in contract documents and not designated to be the responsibility of the construction contractor.

In addition, provide Senior Process Engineer onsite for approximately 5 days to facilitate startup and testing. Senior Process Engineer will also review startup plan, provide general support during startup and performance testing.

Onsite support for electrical and instrumentation & controls to facilitate startup operations, testing, and training will be provided.

Task 4 Project Close-out Services

Project close-out services will be provided after substantial completion has been achieved. These services include the following:

- > Assist with the production of a construction deficiency list ("punch list").
- Prepare record drawings from contractor information that has been field verified by PBCWUD staff. Record drawings will be provided in electronic PDF and native format on CD, no hardcopies will be produced. Five copies of the CD will be provided.

> Prepare and submit Engineer of Record documentation to PBCWUD and regulatory agencies.




