I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:

A) adopt a Resolution authorizing the Clerk to transfer \$40,000 from the Pollution Recovery Trust Fund (PRTF) to support the Native Canopy Education Program and waiving the requirement prohibiting use of PRTF funds for operations to the extent applicable; and

B) approve a budget transfer of \$40,000 from the Pollution Recovery Trust Fund Reserves to the Native Canopy Education Program.

Summary: This resolution authorizes the transfer of \$40,000 from the PRTF to support a two-year program managed by the County Cooperative Extension Department (CES) to enhance public understanding about preservation of native vegetation canopy on single family parcels. <u>Countywide</u> (SF)

Background and Justification: Funding will provide for an on-call program assistant, the creation of educational materials for single family parcel owners, and native tree vouchers to targeted communities. Providing single family parcel owners with environmental educational materials and access to native plant materials is anticipated to be an effective method in preserving native vegetation that may be otherwise removed. Native plant canopy plays an important role in combating air pollution and controlling stormwater runoff. Environmental Resources Management believes the best way to meet the program goals is through the enhancement of an existing CES program related to urban and community forestry entitled "Strengthening Our Community Tree Canopy through Education".

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A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PALM BEACH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL **RESOURCES MANAGEMENT TO UTILIZE A** PORTION OF THE POLLUTION RECOVERY TRUST FUND FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN EDUCATION PROGRAM TO **ENCOURAGE** PRESERVATION OF NATIVE CANOPY ON SINGLE FAMILY PARCELS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida adopted Resolution No. R-89-576 on April 4, 1989, establishing the Palm Beach County Pollution Recovery Trust Fund (PRTF) to receive monies collected in instances of environmental violations; and

WHEREAS, it has been established that monies from the PRTF shall be disbursed only for enhancement of environmental resources and pollution control activities in Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Department of Environmental Resources Management (ERM) recognizes that an effort to educate single family parcel owners about native vegetation canopy preservation is an enhancement to the environmental resource base of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Cooperative Extension Service (CES) has an existing educational program related to urban forestry and is capable of making further enhancements to the program to include native canopy preservation; and

WHEREAS, \$40,000 from the PRTF is necessary to implement the educational program over the next two years; and

31 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has the authority to designate 32 additional uses of the PRTF and to waive the prohibition against funding operations; and

WHERAS, hiring an on-call program assistant will be instrumental in the success of
the Native Canopy Education Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
 COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:
