#### FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to Interlocal Agreement R2011-0736 (the	'Agreer	ment"),
dated May 17, 2011, is made and entered into on	<u>l</u> , by	and and
between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("Cou	ınty"), a	and the
Village of Palm Springs, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida ("F	articipa	ant" or
"Village").		

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the County and Participant agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the Agreement expired on May 17, 2014, and shall be retroactively extended to the earlier of May 17, 2017, or until the termination of Agreement R2003-1206, as amended by R2008-2061 and R2013-1011.
- 2. Attachment I to the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and is hereby replaced by Attachment I attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 3. Section 4.02 is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- 4. Section 17 is hereby added to the Agreement as follows:

# SECTION 17: PALM BEACH COUNTY OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL AUDIT REQUIREMENTS

Palm Beach County has established the Office of the Inspector General in Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 - 2-440, as may be amended. The Inspector General is authorized with the power to review past, present and proposed County contracts, transactions, accounts and records. The Inspector General's authority includes, but is not limited to, the power to audit, investigate, monitor, and inspect the activities of entities contracting with the County, or anyone acting on their behalf, in order to ensure compliance with contract requirements and to detect corruption and fraud. Failure to cooperate with the Inspector General or interfering with or impeding any investigation shall be a violation of Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 - 2-440, and punished pursuant to Section 125.69, Florida Statutes, in the same manner as a second degree misdemeanor.

5. The Agreement is hereby modified to add the following:

#### SECTION 18: NO THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARY

No provision of this Contract is intended to, or shall be construed to, create any third party beneficiary or to provide any rights to any person or entity not a party to this Contract, including but not limited to any citizen or employees of the County and/or Participant.

6. The Agreement is hereby modified to add the following:

#### **SECTION 19: NONDISCRIMINATION**

Agency assures and certifies that it shall comply with Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and Palm Beach County Resolution No. R92-13, and shall not discriminate against any individual on the basis of their race, color, national origin, religion, ancestry, sex, age, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, disability, gender identity or expression, or genetic information.

7. Except as modified by this First Amendment, the Agreement remains unmodified and in full force and effect in accordance with the terms thereof and is hereby ratified and confirmed by the Participant and the County.
