Summary: The Westgate/Belvedere Homes Community Redevelopment Agency (Westgate CRA) Board consists of seven (7) At-Large members from the general public and local businesses within the CRA boundaries. Ordinance No. 89-6 requires that the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) appoint the Westgate CRA Board Members. After duly advertising, the Westgate CRA held its Annual Meeting on May 12, 2014 to appoint a candidate to fill seat 4. The Commissioners were notified of the vacancy by the Westgate CRA on May 21, 2014. District 2 & 7 (RB)

Background and Justification: Westgate CRA was created by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Ordinance No. 89-6, adopted in May, 1989 and amended by Ordinance No. 91-50, adopted in March, 1991. The Westgate CRA By-laws provide for board members and the public to nominate prospective candidates for the Westgate Belvedere Homes CRA Board and to forward the nominations to the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners for appointment. The Westgate/Belvedere Homes CRA Board consists of seven (7) members seats, six (6) of which are currently filled with a diversity count of Male: 3; Female: 3; White: 5 and Black: 1.

Section II Continued:

CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIPS: Pursuant to Article XIII, Sec. 2-443 of the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics, advisory board members are prohibited from entering into any contract or other transaction for goods or services with Palm Beach County. Exceptions to this prohibition include awards made under sealed competitive bids, certain emergency and sole source purchases, and transactions that do not exceed \$500 per year in aggregate. These exemptions are described in the Code. This prohibition does not apply when the advisory board member's board provides no regulation, oversight, management, or policy-setting recommendations regarding the subject contract or transaction and the contract or transaction is disclosed at a public meeting of the Board of County Commissioners. To determine compliance with this provision, it is necessary that you, as a board member applicant, identify all contractual relationships between Palm Beach County government and you as an individual, directly or indirectly, or your employer or business. This information should be provided in the space below. If there are no contracts or transactions to report, please verify that none exist. Staff will review this information and determine if you are eligible to serve or if you may be eligible for an exception or waiver pursuant to the code.

Section 1. AUTHORITY FOR ENACTMENT.

This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Community Redevelopment Act of 1969, as amended, Chapter 69-305, Laws of Florida. Section 2. <u>CREATION OF THE WESTGATE/BELVEDERE HOMES COMMUNITY</u> REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

There is hereby created a public body corporate and politic to be known as the Westgate/Belveders Homes Community Redevelopment Agency, hereinafter referred to as the "Agency."

Section 3. MEMBERSHIP

3.01. The agency shall consist of seven (7) commissioners 'a appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. Any person may be appointed as a commissioner if he or she resides or is engaged in business, which shall mean owning a business, practicing a profession, or performing a service for compensation, or serving as an officer or director of a corporation or other business entity so engaged, within the area of operation of the agency, which shall be coterminous with the area of operation of the county.

3.02. Terms of office of the commissioners shall be for 4 years except that three of the members first appointed shall be designated to serve terms of 1, 2 and 3 years, respectively, from the date of their appointments, and four (4) members shall be designated to serve for terms of 4 years from the date of their appointments. A vacancy occurring during a term shall be filled for the unexpired term. A certificate of the appointment or reappointment of any commissioner shall be filed with the clerk of the county, and such certificate shall be conclusive evidence of the due and proper appointment of such commissioner.

3.03. A commissioner shall receive no compensation for his services, but shall be entitled to the necessary expenses, including traveling expenses, incurred in the discharge of his duties, subject to prior approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

3.04. The powers of a community redevelopment agency shall be exercised by the commissioners thereof. A majority of the commissioners shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting business and exercising the powers of the agency and for all other purposes. Action may be taken by the agency upon a vote of a majority of the commissioners present, unless in any case the bylaws shall require a larger number.
