I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title:** Staff recommends motion to approve: a task order to the annual contract, R2014-0119, in the amount of \$113,642.62, with Alan Gerwig & Associates, Inc. (AGA), for professional services for the Davis Road over Lake Worth Drainage District L-6 Canal bridge replacement project (Project).

**SUMMARY:** Approval of this task order will provide the professional services necessary for the preparation of design plans and construction bid documents for the Project. AGA is a Palm Beach County company. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the Project is 15%. AGA has achieved 93.23% SBE participation for this Project.

**Background and Justification:** On February 4, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved an annual contract, R2014-0119, with AGA to provide professional services required for Palm Beach Countywide (County) structural engineering projects. The County now desires AGA to prepare design plans and construction bid documents for the Project, as detailed in Exhibit "A" of the attached task order. The fee, as detailed in Exhibit "A" of the attached task order, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:

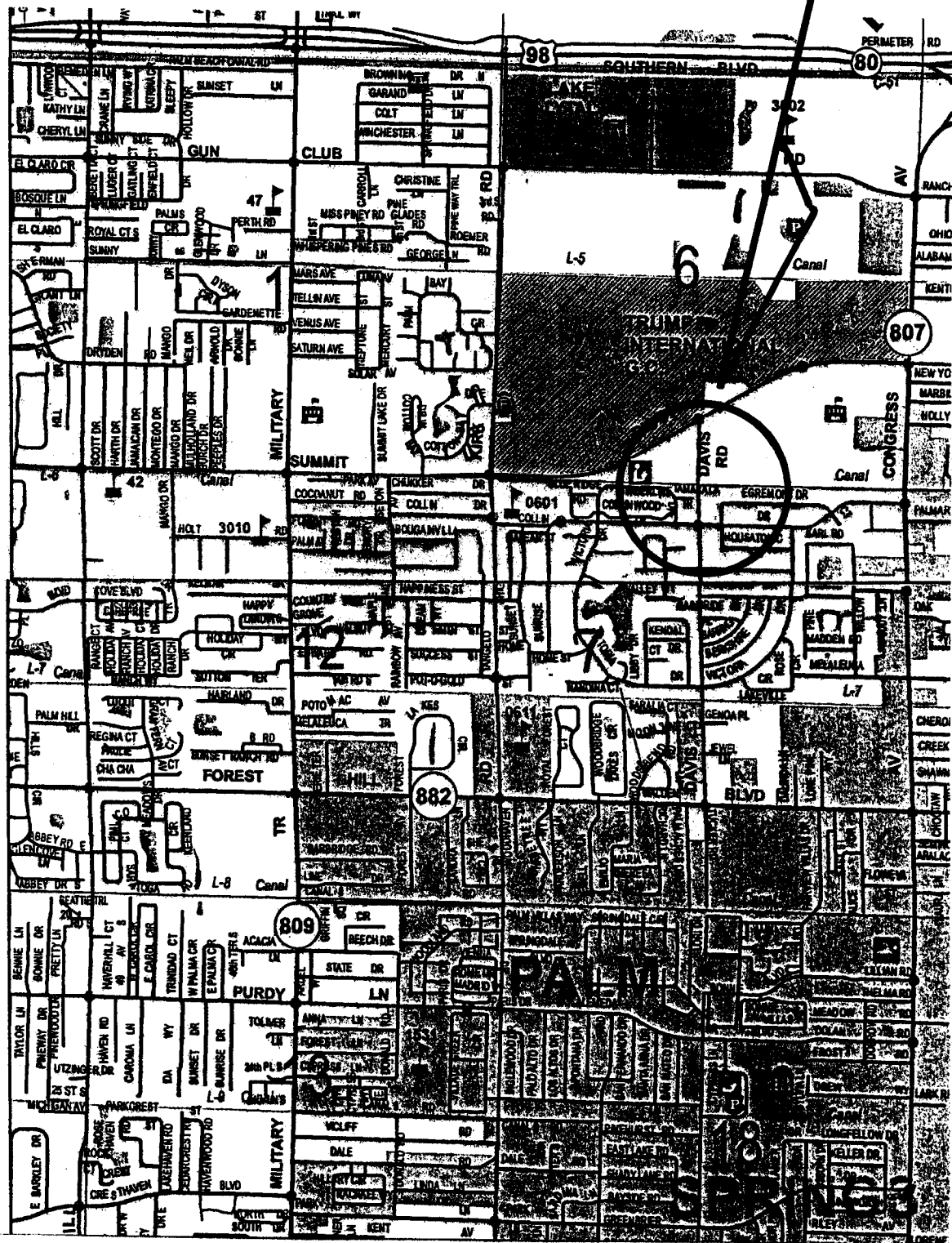

4. The **CONSULTANT** has provided a sub-consultant Letter of Intent to perform as an SBE as described in Exhibit "D" of the Work Task Order.

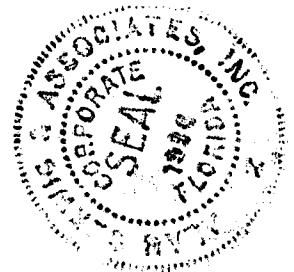

Alan Gerwig & Associates (AGA) ("Consultant") is pleased to submit this letter of agreement ("Agreement") for providing professional engineering services to Palm Beach County, ("Client") for the above referenced project. Our project understanding, scope of services and fees are as follows.

#### **Project Understanding**

Palm Beach County Roadway Production Division is proposing to widen a stretch of Davis Road on either side of the Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) L-6 Canal. The widening will involve expanding the existing 2-lane road to a three lane road with a central left turn lane. The third lane will start just north of Taconic Drive and will end at the existing 3-lane section at the south entrance to the Palm Beach County School Board facility north of the Canal. With the distance required to transition from the 3-lane section north of the Canal, the limits of the project are expected to extend over approximately 1100 LF.

The existing crossing of the L-6 Canal consists of a short single-span road bridge, which needs to be replaced and an aluminum pedestrian bridge. The bridges will be replaced with a circular concrete culvert with concrete headwalls.



The widened section of road will include a new drainage system to convey the runoff from the right-of-way to the canal. The drainage system will incorporate exfiltration trench to provide water quality treatment. The existing drainage outfalls to the canal will be incorporated into the proposed culvert in the canal.

**Scope of Work – Basic Services**

AGA will provide the design services required to prepare construction documents and specifications for the road widening, drainage modifications and replacement of the existing bridge over the L-6 Canal with a pipe culvert. Design surveying services and geotechnical engineering services will be provided by AGA with sub consultants. The sub consultants' fees for these professional services are included in this proposal. The scope of services includes the following design tasks:

- Design Survey – see attached details from sub-consultant HSQ Group.
- Geotechnical Investigation – see attached details from sub-consultant Dunkelberger Engineering and Testing.
- Design of the roadway widening within the required limits of construction.
- Design of new drainage system including exfiltration trench for water quality treatment with outfalls into the L-6 Canal.
- Design of culvert and headwalls in canal.
- Identify and address exiting utility conflicts within the right-of-way. Existing utility coordination will be managed by Palm Beach County.
- Plan submittals at 35%, 65%, 96% and 100%. Preliminary calculations will be submitted with the 65% and 96% submittals. Final design calculations will be furnished with the 100% submittal.
- Provide preliminary quantities and cost estimates with the 65% and 96% submittals.
- Provide final quantities and cost estimate with the 100% submittal.

The basic scope of services will include obtaining the following permits:

- Lake Worth Drainage District Culvert Crossing Permit.
- Lake Worth Drainage District Drainage Permit.
- Joint South Florida Water Management District and Army Corp of Engineers, Environmental Resource Permit.
- South Florida Water Management District Dewatering Permit



### Optional Services

The following optional design and permitting services are offered in relation to relocating the existing water utilities.

- Prepare preliminary design and layout for the relocation of the existing water utilities at the L-6 Canal crossing.
- Coordinate with Palm Beach County Water Utility Department (WUD) on design requirements.
- Prepare final construction documents for the relocation of the existing utilities including standard WUD details and specifications.

The optional scope of services will include obtaining the following permits:

- Palm Beach County Health Department Permits for Water and Force Main relocation.

### Assumptions

- Palm Beach County will be responsible for utility coordination.
- Sufficient cover and clearance will be available for the water utilities using circular pipe culvert(s).
- As Built drawings will be provided by the contractor.

**Project Limits:**

The project limits for the survey are as follow:

- 1- From approximately 350' south of Collin Drive to 325' north of LWDD L-6 Canal for a total distance of approximately 1200'.
- 2- 100' east and 100' of Davis Road along Collin Dr.

**Scope:**

1. Review title search supplied by Palm Beach County prior to commencement of field topo to establish right-of-way width, and compile all plats and deeds into a map.
2. Collect benchmarks and global positioning control data.
3. Set control points tied to State plane at 600-foot intervals. "NAD 83, 1990 adjustment"
4. Run a closed level loop and set Benchmarks at 600-foot intervals outside the limits of constructions. Survey to be prepared based on the NAVD 1988 datum.
5. Locate subdivision corners, section corners and any other existing control monuments that will assist in the establishment of the location of the right-of-way lines for this project.
6. Locate above ground features with elevations.
7. Cross-section the project at 100' intervals extending 25 feet outside the right of way.
8. Acquire cross sections of L-6 canal at 50-foot intervals as follow; at face of headwall, 50' 100' and 150' away from the headwall for both east and west directions.
9. Perform a detailed survey of the existing bridge over the L- 6 canal.
10. Acquire the finished floor elevation for all structures that adjoin the right of way and show on the survey. The elevations will be obtained from either as built or approved site plans but not from actual survey.
11. Detail drainage structures within the right of way. Locate drainage outfall pipes
12. Acquire topo on each side street up to 100'
13. Acquire topo and elevations at driveways up to either a low point or a high point
14. Locate all trees with size and type within right of way and 25' beyond right of way.

**Optional Services**

- 1- Prepare sketch and legal descriptions for temporary construction easements. Assume 3 for the purpose of the fee proposal.
- 2- Provide assistance to the Geotechnical Engineer in locating the soil borings in relationship to the alignment.
- 3- Obtain horizontal and vertical locations of existing utilities that possibly will be in conflict with proposed drainage structures.

**Survey Deliverables**

- 1- Two signed and sealed 11" X 17" copies of the Specific Purpose Survey and a copy of the CADD file.
- 2- One copy of the topographic file, drainage file, utility file, right of way file, and point file in a Microstation digital CADD format or ACADD format
- 3- One copy of the ASCII file of all elevations in terms of x,y,z, description.
- 4- Four signed and sealed copies of the cross sections for the LWDD L-6 at 1"= 10' both horizontal and vertical.
- 5- Create DTM drawing.

Presented hereafter is a description of the scope of work to be undertaken and a schedule for implementation of the work. Compensation for the services is also discussed. Unit rates used to develop this proposal are consistent with our current continuing services contract with Palm Beach County.

## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

We understand that current plans are to remove the existing bridge over the Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) L-6 Canal and to replace the bridge with a concrete pipe culvert. The culvert will include headwalls on each end in order to provide for grade separation. The project will also provide for widening the existing Davis Road for a distance of approximately 300 feet to the north of the existing bridge to approximately 600 feet south of the bridge. The widening will involve adding a lane to the center of the existing roadway. Drainage improvements are likely to take the form of exfiltration trench.

Subsurface information in the form of stratigraphy, groundwater level, lateral earth pressure criteria and environmental (corrosivity) classification are needed at this time for the culvert and roadway design process. The project site is accessible for conventional truck mounted drilling equipment. However, the borings will need to be positioned carefully considering both underground and overhead utilities. We have assumed that a Right-of-Way Use permit will not be required from Palm Beach County.

## **2.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES**

### **2.1. Base Geotechnical Services**

The subsurface study will entail the following tasks:

1. Exploration of the subsurface conditions at the culvert crossing site using two 40-foot deep Standard Penetration Test borings. One of the borings will be drilled within the roadway requiring a lane closure. Samples of the subsurface materials will be obtained at frequent vertical intervals using procedures prescribed in ASTM D 1586 (the Standard Penetration Test). The borings will be sealed with neat cement grout upon completion.
2. Auger profile borings will be drilled on the east and west sides of Davis Road within the limits of the proposed widening. These borings will be advanced to 6 feet deep using either a solid stem auger or hand bucket auger. Based upon the length of the project, 9 auger borings are anticipated.
3. Two (2) field permeability tests will be completed along the project corridor. The permeability tests will be completed in accordance with the South Florida Water Management District Usual Open Hole Test method.
4. Review of the data from the culvert borings and classification of the subsurface components in accordance with the Unified Soil Classification System (ASTM D 2487) and appropriate geologic nomenclature. The samples from the roadway borings will be classified in accordance with the AASHTO classification system. Representative samples will be tested for grain size distribution to aid in the classification process. One canal water sample and one soil sample will be tested for the corrosion parameters of pH, Resistivity, sulfates and chlorides.
5. Preparation of a CADD generated boring location plan and subsurface profiles for the borings.
6. Preparation and submittal of a report which presents the factual information obtained and geotechnical engineering design criteria, namely:
  - environmental classification of the soil/water samples
  - field permeability test results
  - recommendations for excavations and backfilling around the culvert
  - foundation soil support for the pipe culvert
  - soil moist and saturated unit weights, cohesion, friction angles for computation of lateral earth pressures adjacent to culvert headwalls
  - recommendations for roadway construction, including an estimate of the Modulus of Resilience for subgrade soils
  - geotechnical related construction recommendations



## 2.2 Schedule

We are prepared to initiate our work within ten days after receiving your written notification to proceed. The work will begin with field marking the boring locations and notifying the Sunshine Utility Network for clearance of underground utilities. After the mandatory utility locate request and waiting period (48 hours), we expect to complete the field work over a three day period, barring wet weather related delays. Engineering data evaluation and report preparation will require about two weeks. Thus the overall time frame for our work will be approximately 4 weeks. Three copies of the report will be transmitted to you at the completion of the work.



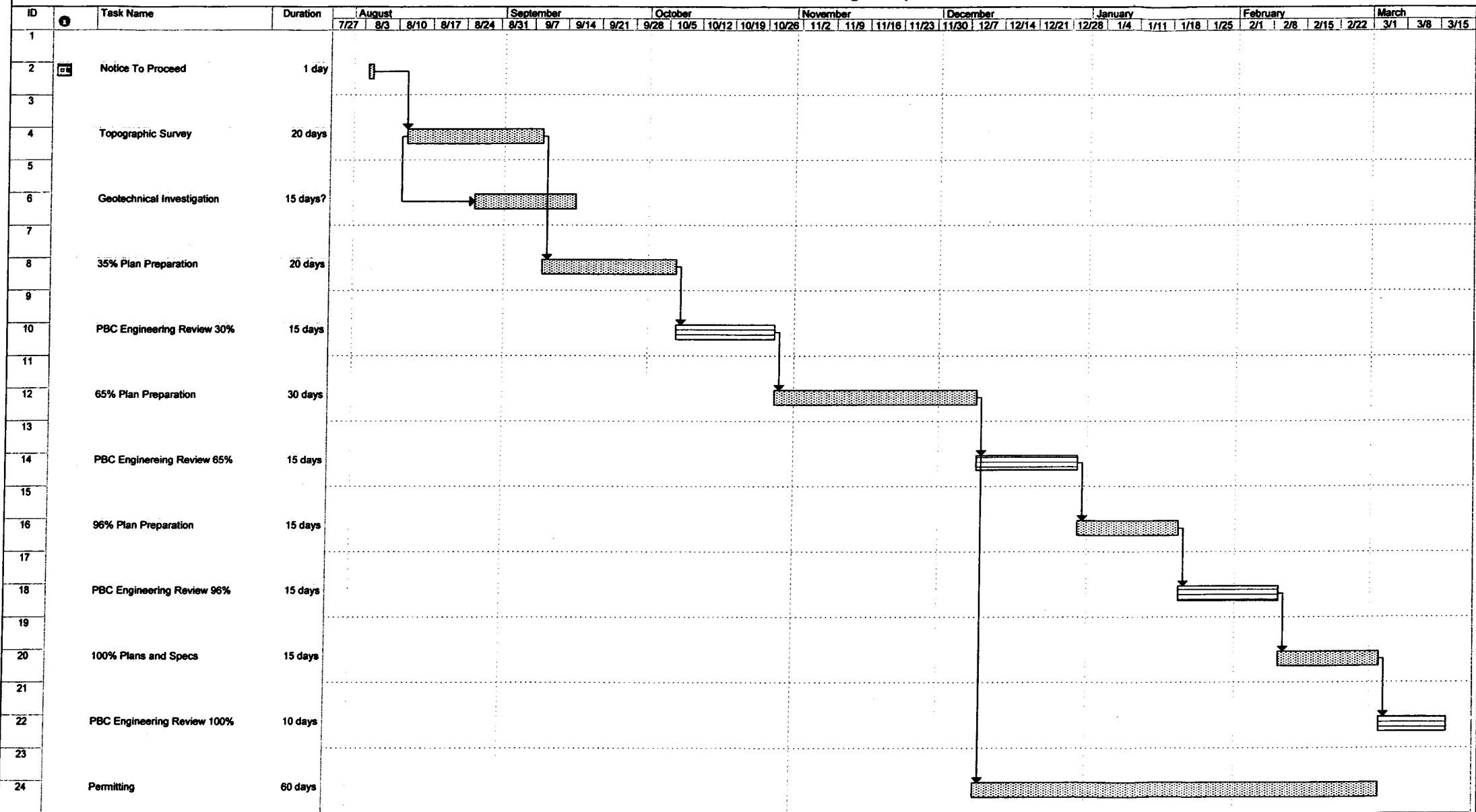
