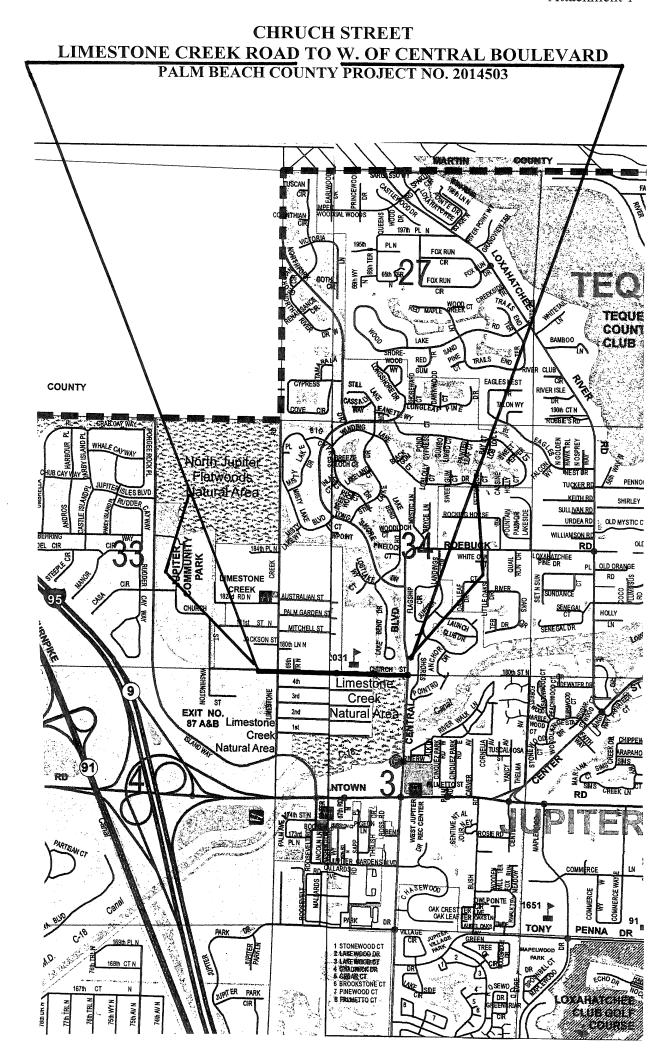

We are pleased to submit the following proposal for professional services in connection with the surveying, design and permitting for the approximately 2000 LF of Church Street paving and drainage improvements. Plans will comply with Palm Beach County Thoroughfare Road Design Procedures, Manual of Uniform Minimum Standards for design, construction and maintenance for streets and highways (Florida Green Book), and the Florida Department of Transportation Roadway and Traffic Design Standards. - 2. Geotechnical Engineering will be subcontracted to Tierra South Florida, Inc.
- 3. Plan submittals (5 sets of 11 x 17" plans (not bound) and a PDF version) will be prepared and submitted at the Typical Section 35%, 65%, 96% and 100% stages for Palm Beach County review and approval. - 6. Church Street roadway to drain to Limestone Creek Road. Design section to be three-lanes with east and westbound lanes to be 11' wide, center lane to be 12', 3' shoulders, 2' curb, 2.5' for grass and 5' wide sidewalk.

The subsurface exploration will include laboratory testing of the samples obtained to evaluate the classification, and other characteristics of the subsurface materials. 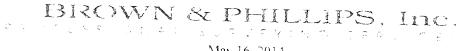

Thank you for the opportunity to provide you with the following services for the subject site. This proposal is based on documentation and information provided by your office. We will review any title work supplied by you. The scope of services is as follows:

SCOPE OF SERVICES

HORIZONTAL PROJECT NETWORK CONTROL 3

Using the information supplied by Palm Beach County, we will establish the Right-of-Way for Church Street and Limestone Creek Road. A traverse will be run through the route and all found monumentation will be tied in. The survey will be oriented to Palm Beach County horizontal control (NAD 83.90 Adjustment). We will obtain the sectional and geodetic control information from the Palm Beach County Survey Department. The limits of the survey are shown on Attachment 'B'.

H. VERTICAL PROJECT NETWORK CONTROL

A level run will be performed along the route using the existing Palm Beach County benchmarks (NAVD 1988). Benchmarks will be set along the route, not exceeding 600 feet apart, so that we will have at least one benchmark per plan sheet. All benchmarks will be set outside of the proposed right of way.

III. **BASELINE LAYOUT**

We will lay out the baseline at 100-foot intervals, staking to be performed at a 100° interval and in accordance with the Design Standards Page 20 Phase IIE, setting appropriate points at each station. The baseline will be laid out within the limits of the 2600'± route. These baseline points will be used in the topographic and cross section phase to locate features and facilitate cheeks.

IV. REFERENCE POINTS

We will reference the baseline at intervals not exceeding 1400 feet along the route and in accordance with the Design Standards Page 10, e4, referencing all existing monumentation to be reset after construction. These points will be used to replace disturbed baseline stations. A topographic survey will be performed along the route. This survey will tie in all visible features such as, but not limited to, signs, light poles, guardrails, trees, utilities, walks, edge of pavement, curbing, drainage structures, etc. We will also include driveways, finish floors, mailboxes, etc. These locations will show all features within the corridor from right of way to right of way extending to 25 feet outside the proposed right of way (if provided prior to start of the field work).

VII. CROSS SECTIONS

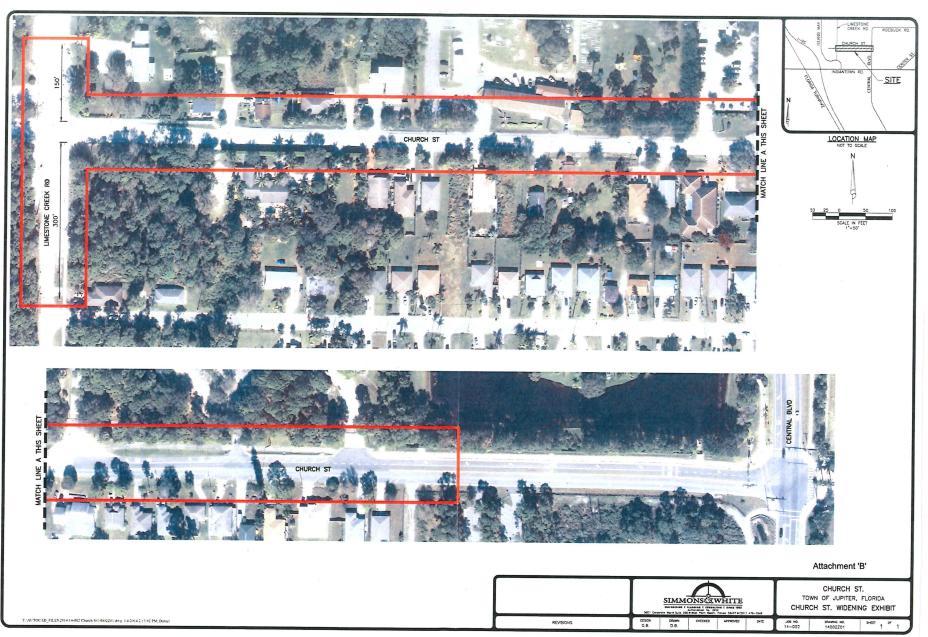
