### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title:** Staff recommends motion to approve: Supplement No. 1 to Work Authorization No. 19 with Globaltech, Inc. (R2012-0159) for the Western Region Waste Water Treatment Facility - Effluent Strainer and Screen Bypass increasing the contract time by 150 days.

**Summary:** On November 6, 2013, the Palm Beach County Contract Review Committee approved Work Authorization No. 19 with Globaltech, Inc. for Western Region Waste Water Treatment Facility - Effluent Strainer and Screen Bypass. This Supplement increases the contract time by 150 days at no additional cost to allow for project completion within 300 days. The original Work Authorization included the design, permitting and construction of a bypass around the effluent screens and installation of a new effluent strainer with a project schedule of 150 days to attain final completion. A time extension of 150 days is requested due to delays caused by site plan revisions required during the design phase. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance is 15% overall. The contract with Globaltech, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 75% overall.

The cumulative SBE participation, including this Supplement is 91.38% overall. Globaltech, Inc. is a Palm Beach County company. (WUD Project No. 13-093) <u>District 6</u> (JM)

**Background and Justification:** On November 6, 2013 the Palm Beach County Contract Review Committee approved Work Authorization No. 19 with Globaltech, Inc. for Western Region Waste Water Treatment Facility- Effluent Strainer and Screen Bypass. This Supplement will authorize the Contractor additional time and no cost increase due to delays cause by site revisions required during the design phase.



#### INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (County) entered into an agreement entitled Water, Wastewater & Reclaimed Water Improvements Design/Build Contract - Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Project No. WUD <u>11-134</u> (CONTRACT) with Globaltech, Inc. (CONTRACTOR) to provide design-build services for various general activities on the Contract for Water, Wastewater & Reclaimed Water Improvements Design/Build Services, dated January 24, 2012 (Design/Build Contract R2012-0159). This Work Authorization will be performed under that CONTRACT.

Work Authorization 19 was authorized to design and construct a bypass around the effluent screens and install a new effluent strainer at the Belle Glade WWTP (WRWWTF). This Supplement No. 1 to Work Authorization 19 requests a 150 day extension to the project completion schedule. Additional funding is not requested.

#### **SCOPE OF SERVICES**

#### **Construction Services**

During the initial design phase of the project, exploratory excavations were performed to confirm the pipe route. This work could not be completed until after Work Authorization 19 was executed. During the excavation, it was discovered that there was no room to route the new piping under the existing electrical duct bank because it was so close to the cap rock. Contractor then had to develop alternate routing options (including conducting hydraulic calculations) which included routing above the duct bank (and coming out of the ground) or making the tie-in in a different location using a different route. The new route required that a long-lead Tee-fitting be purchased. The fitting required custom fabrication and is not expected to be delivered until July 2014. While some work can be completed prior to arrival of this fitting, most of the underground work is dependent upon the arrival of the fitting.

The changes in the routing resulted in additional time to design, perform analysis, obtain approval, and fabricate resulting in a project delay of 150 days. This supplement requests only to modify the project completion schedule.

### **ASSUMPTIONS**

- 1. The project will be designed in accordance with the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Manual of Minimum Engineering Standards.
- 2. No modifications to the original contract assumptions are included in this Supplement.

#### **COMPENSATION**

No additional compensation is requested in this Supplement. Through this Supplement No. 1 to WA-19, Contractor seeks only a 150 day contract extension. The Compensation shall not exceed the original Guaranteed Maximum Price of \$182,163.55 in accordance with the unit prices established in the Contract for construction services dated \_\_January 24, 2012 \_ as approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

#### SBE PARTICIPATION

As described in the Contract (R2012-0159), SBE/M-WBE participation is included in ATTACHMENT - F under this Authorization. The attached Schedule 1 defines the SBE applied to this Authorization/Contract and Schedule 2 establishes the SBE contribution from each subcontractor (Letter of Intent to perform as an SBE).


