- D) Modification No. 17 to Subgrant Agreement (R2007-1027) with the State of Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for DRI2;
- E) Modification No. 15 to Subgrant Agreement (R2008-1312) with DEO for the 2005 Disaster Recovery Initiative Program – Supplemental Appropriation (DRI3);

The attached Amendments and Modifications have been fully executed on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) by the County Administrator, or designee, in accordance with Agenda Items R2006-1351, R2007-1524 and R2009-1677, as approved by the BCC on July 18, 2006, September 11, 2007 and October 6, 2009, respectively. These executed documents are now being submitted to the BCC to receive and file. <u>These are Federal Disaster Recovery Initiative funds which require no local match.</u> (DES Contract Development) <u>Countywide</u> (TKF)

Background and Justification: On June 27, 2012, the County entered into an Agreement (R2012-1252) with the City of Riviera Beach, as amended, by Amendment No. 001 (R2012-1803) on September 11, 2012, by Amendment No. 002 (R2013-0143) on December 10, 2012, by Amendment No. 003 (R2013-0914) on March 12, 2013, by Amendment No. 004 (R2013-0915) on June 11, 2013, and by Amendment No. 005 (R2014-0273) on December 13; 2013, to provide \$1,105,745 in DRI2 funds for the implementation of a housing rehabilitation program. Amendment No. 006 extends the project completion date to June 30, 2015, to allow completion of construction and project closeout.

On June 6, 2012, the County entered into an Agreement (R2012-1254) with the West Palm Beach Housing Authority, as amended by Amendment No. 001 (R2013-0922) on May 6, 2013, and by Amendment No. 002 (R2014-0274) on December 20, 2013, to provide \$190,256 in DRI3 funds and \$740,744 in DRI4 funds for hurricane hardening improvements at the Newton Woods housing complex. Amendment No. 003 extends the project completion date to March 30, 2015, to allow completion of construction and project closeout. **Continued on Page 3**

On August 27, 2011, the County entered into an Agreement (R2011-1796) with the West Palm Beach Housing Authority, as amended by Amendment No. 001 (R2012-1260) on June 12, 2012, by Amendment No. 002 (R2013-0146) on December 13, 2012, by Amendment No. 003 (R2013-0923) on May 6, 2013, by Amendment No. 004 (R2014-0275) on December 20, 2013, and by Amendment No. 005 (R2014-0780) on May 1, 2014, to provide \$46,912 in DRI 3 funds and \$884,913 in DRI4 funds for infrastructure improvements at the Colony Oaks and Southridge housing complexes. Amendment No. 006 extends the project completion date to March 30, 2015, to allow completion of construction and project closeout.

Modification No. 17 to Subgrant Agreement (R2007-1027) with DEO for DRI2 extended the Agreement deadline by nine (9) months to a new deadline of June 30, 2015, to allow the completion of ongoing projects.

Modification No. 15 to Subgrant Agreement (R2008-1312) with DEO for DRI3 reduced funding to the Belle Glade Housing Authority Osceola Apartments Hardening Project by \$12,108 to a current total of \$780,118; increased funding for the West Palm Beach Housing Authority Southridge Infrastructure Improvements Project by \$8,000 to a current total of \$24,661; increased funding for the Newton Woods Rental Development Hardening Project by \$4,108 to a current total of \$194,364; and made a line item adjustment within the City of Delray Beach Infrastructure Improvements project.
