### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Ordinance 92-20, as amended, and Article 2.G.3.F.3 of the Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) provide for a seven (7) member GNRPB. The membership consists of one (1) professional engineer, one (1) attorney, one (1) hydrologist or hydrogeologist, one (1) a citizen possessing expertise and experience in managing a business, one (1) biologist or chemist, one (1) citizen of PBC, and one (1) member of an environmental organization. Ordinance 92-20 and Article 2.G.3.F.3. of the ULDC requires Seat No. 6 be filled by a Hydrologist or Hydrogeologist nominated by the Florida Association of Professional Geologists. Countywide (SF)

Background and Justification: The GNRPB has the powers and duties to hold hearings as necessary to enforce ULDC Article 14, Environmental Standards, and to issue any orders necessary to achieve compliance. Michael W. Bennett as a Principal Hydrogeologist meets the requirement. The new term will expire August 14, 2017. The diversity breakdown of the Board is six (6) Caucasian males and one (1) African-American male.

Budgeted and developed testing plan using specialty geophysical logging techniques (Stoneley wave and Nuclear Magnetic Resonance) to determine the porosity and permeability distribution within a carbonate aquifer. Developed study objectives to employ surface geophysical methods (cross-well tomography and seismic reflection techniques) to determine lateral continuity of productive and non-productive units as they related to the successful implementation of Aquifer Storage and Recovery technology in a deep carbonate aquifer system. Published multiple in-house technical publications and journal articles related to water resources issues, ASR and new technology in hydrogeology. Supervised and mentored junior staff members. Served as technical advisor on numerous regulatory and water resource advisory committees.

The Florida Association of Professional Geologists (FAPG Board), the Florida section of the American Institute of Professional Geologists, is responding to a request by the Palm Beach County Department of Environmental Resources Management. The County requested the Board to seek professional hydrologist/hydrogeologist applicants and to evaluate qualified respondents to fill a seat of the Groundwater and Natural Resources Protection Board (GNRPB Groundwater and Natural Resources Protection Board (GNRPB). It is our understanding that this task was to recommend one professional with the appropriate background, who is a resident of Palm Beach County and that it would be desirable if they (or their company depending on size and position within that company) had no contracts with the County.

Approximately 15 FAPG/AIGP members residing in Palm Beach County were contacted to determine interest. Three individuals responded and submitted resumes and completed Nominee Information Forms provided by the County. The four member FAPG Board reviewed and ranked these submittals separately. All respondents have exceptional experience and backgrounds that make each of them valuable for consideration of this GNRPB position. Based on the criteria outlined above, Michael Bennett was ranked highest by the FAPG Board and is the nominee for the GNRPB position. ## PALM BEACH COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS GROUNDWATER & NATURAL RESOURCES PROTECTION BOARD

### I. AUTHORITY:

Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) Art. 2.G.3.F, Groundwater and Natural Resources Protection Board. [Ord. 2003-067, effective January 1, 2004, as amended].

### II. APPOINTING BODY:

**Board of County Commissioners** 

### III. COMPOSITION, QUALIFICATIONS, TERMS & REMOVAL:

The Board shall be comprised of seven (7) members appointed by the BCC. Membership shall be as follows: 1) a professional engineer registered by the State of Florida; 2) an attorney licensed to practice in Florida; 3) a hydrologist or hydrogeologist; 4) a citizen possessing expertise and experience in managing a business; 5) a biologist or a chemist; 6) concerned citizen; and 7) a member of an environmental organization.

All members shall serve three (3) year terms. All members serving on the GNRPB on the effective date of this Code shall complete their terms according to their prior appointments.

### **EXTENDED COMPOSITION:**

### IV. MEETINGS:

Bi-Monthly. Special meetings may be called by the Chair or in writing by a majority of the members of the Board.

### V. FUNCTIONS:

The GNRPB shall have the following powers and duties:

1)to hold hearings as necessary to enforce Article 14, Environmental Standards, if there has been a failure to correct a violation within the time specified by the Code Inspector, if the violation has been repeated, or is of such a nature that it cannot be corrected; 2) to adopt rules of procedure for the conduct of hearings; 3) to issue subpoenas compelling the provision of evidence at Board hearings. Subpoenas may be served by the PBC Sheriff's Department, or other authorized persons consistent with Florida Law; 4) to issue subpoenas compelling the provision of evidence at GNRPB hearings; 5) to take testimony under oath; 6) to issue orders having the force of law commanding whatever steps are necessary to achieve compliance with the violation of Article 14 of the Environmental Standards; 7) to lien property and 8) to assess administrative fines and costs pursuant to Article 14, Environmental Standards.
