On May 6, 2014, the BOCC received and filed an agenda item extending the grant period from February 28, 2014 through August 31, 2014(R-2014-0655). This agenda item will extend the grant period from August 31, 2014 through February 28, 2015. The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) received an award to implement Palm Beach County's Child Sexual Predator Strategy. The purpose of the strategy is to enhance the PBSO's Sexual Predator Offender Tracking Unit; maintain PBSO's Strategically Targeting Online Predators Program at its current staffing level; develop a multidisciplinary team to assist in the development, implementation, and evaluation of the strategy; and to increase community awareness through education forums and a public awareness campaign. 
