I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: a resolution to abandon any public interest in the landlocked 30 foot by 35 foot portion of right-of-way lying within Lots A & B, Block 4, of the plat of Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 8, as recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 73, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

SUMMARY: Adoption of this resolution will allow release of this public dedication on the petitioner's site.

District 4 (MRE)

Background and Policy Issues: The owner, TD Bank, N.A., wants to clear this encumbrance from their site. A 30 foot wide portion of right-of-way from Boynton Beach Boulevard north to the southern limits of the proposed abandonment site was previously abandoned under Resolution number R76-802, recorded in Official Records Book 2586, Page 1378. Abandoning this portion of the unimproved right-of-way will not affect access to the site.

Reviewing agencies and utility service providers have no objection to the vacation because a replacement easement covering a portion of the abandonment site has been provided and will be recorded simultaneously with the abandonment.

Privilege Fee Statement: The petition is subject to a privilege fee of \$2,165.68. The calculations are as follows:



RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ABANDONING ANY PUBLIC INTEREST IN THE LANDLOCKED 30 FOOT BY 35 FOOT PORTION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY LYING WITHIN LOTS A & B, BLOCK 4, OF THE PLAT OF PALM BEACH FARMS COMPANY PLAT NO. 8, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 5, PAGE 73, PUBLIC RECORDS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida (Board), pursuant to authority in Section 336.09, Florida Statutes, and as provided in Palm Beach County (County) Code Chapter 22. Article III, Road Abandonment and Plat Vacation (Ordinance No. 2002-034), known as the Palm Beach County Right-of-Way Abandonment and Plat Vacation Ordinance, and the petition of Boynton Beach Associates XXIV, LLLP, called a public hearing to be held in the County Commissioners' Chambers, at the Governmental Office Complex, West Palm Beach, Florida, on December 2, 2014, to consider and determine whether or not the County would vacate, abandon, discontinue and close, renounce and disclaim any right or interest of the public in and for the landlocked 30 foot by 35 foot right-of-way lying within Lots A & B, Block 4, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 8, recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 73, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, as set forth on the sketch and legal description set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, as provided in County Code Chapter 22. Article III, Road Abandonment and Plat Vacation (Ordinance No. 2002-034), notice of the holding of such meeting was duly published in the Palm Beach Post on November 16, 2014; and

WHEREAS, this Board did hold said hearing as advertised and determined that such action will not materially interfere with the County Road System and will not deprive any person of a reasonable means of ingress and egress from at least one County, State or Federal highway.

COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:


- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby reaffirmed and ratified.

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


