I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Contract with Layne Inliner, LLC for the Westgate Avenue & Seminole Boulevard Gravity Sewer Lining Project in the amount of \$438,497.

Summary: On October 29, 2014, four (4) construction bids were received for the completion of rehabilitation work on gravity wastewater pipe along Westgate Avenue and Seminole Boulevard. Layne Inliner, LLC was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$438,497. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. Layne Inliner, LLC was determined to have 0% SBE participation by the Office of Small Business Assistance (OSBA) because their Schedule 2 document was not properly executed. Although the second low bidder Lanzo Lining Services, Inc is within the 10% range to be consider as the lowest bidder, we still recommend the award to Layne Inliner, LLC because the second lowest bidder was also determined to have 0% SBE participation by the OSBA. Layne Inliner, LLC is not a Palm Beach County Company. This project is included in the FY15 Capital Improvement Plan adopted by the Board of County Commissioners. (WUD Project No. 14-089) District 7 (JM)

Background and Justification: There is a significant need to rehabilitate existing Ductile Iron Pipe (DIP) gravity wastewater infrastructure in the Westgate area due to aging wastewater collection systems. This contract will facilitate the completion of rehabilitation work through the rehabilitation of 2500 linear feet of 16" DIP gravity wastewater pipe along Westgate Avenue, 500 linear feet of 20" DIP gravity wastewater pipe along Westgate Avenue, 850 linear feet of 24" DIP gravity wastewater pipe along Seminole Boulevard and 400 linear feet of 30" DIP gravity wastewater pipe along Westgate Avenue.



Hinterland Group, Inc.	\$698,802.00

The engineer's recommendation is to award to Layner Inliner, LLC as the lowest responsive bidder.

The engineer's opinion of probable construction cost was \$300,000. An evaluation of the low bid is as follows:

- 1. The Bid Form provided in the Contract Documents was properly executed.
- 2. Bid Bond equal to 5% of the total base bid was enclosed on the form provided in the Contract Documents.

- 3. The contractor holds a valid general contractor's license. Layner Inliner, LLC <u>does not</u> qualified for Local Preference.
- 4. SBE-M/WBE Schedule #1 provided in the Contract Documents was properly filled out. SBE-M/WBE Schedule #2 was not properly executed. The low bidder <u>did not</u> met the 15% SBE goal established under the SBE Ordinance. (A copy of the Office of Small Business Assistance SBE-M/WBE Compliance Review is attached.)

Based on their bid results, the completeness of their bid package. Contract award is recommended to the low responsive bidder, Layner Inliner, LLC in the amount of \$438,497.00.
