2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO POSTING OF KRATOM WARNING SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR GENERAL REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR CAPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR APPLICABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
11 12	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida,
13	finds that the use of the plant substance kratom also known as Mitragyna speciosa, including
14	dietary supplements containing kratom, is a potential health concern in Palm Beach County;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, kratom is considered highly addictive and has effects on the body
17	including: respiratory depression, psychosis, delusions, tremors, nausea, constipation, anorexia,
18	vomiting, insomnia, and severe withdrawal signs and symptoms; and
19	WHEREAS, the Federal Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) has placed kratom
20	on its list of drugs and chemicals of concern; and
21	WHEREAS, the U.S. Food & Drug Administration has concluded that there is
22	inadequate information on kratom to provide reasonable assurance that kratom and products
23	containing kratom do not present a significant or unreasonable risk of illness or injury; and
24	WHEREAS, potential consumers or users of kratom should be aware of the risk and
25	potential for harm associated with use and consumption of kratom and products containing
26	kratom; and
27	WHEREAS, the posting of signs with information related to kratom consumption and
28	use will make the public aware of the potential health and behavioral effects and federal agency
29	placement of kratom on its list of drugs and chemicals of concern; and
30	WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Substance Awareness Coalition has endorsed
31	posting of these types of signs as an effective measure to generate awareness and discourage
32	use of kratom; and
33	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it will serve the public
34	health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Palm Beach County to educate the public as to the
35	risks associated with kratom use.

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# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

#### Section 1. Definitions

- The following words, phrases, or terms when used in this Ordinance shall, unless the content otherwise indicates, have the meanings provided below. No attempt is made to define ordinary words which are used in accordance with their established dictionary meaning except when necessary to avoid misunderstanding.
  - a) Business Establishment includes, but is not limited to, any place of business or any club, organization, person, firm, corporation or partnership, such as: a golf club; country club; veteran's fraternal or benevolent organization; grocery store; drug store; night club; bottle club; bar; tavern; restaurant; grill; kava bar, filling station; convenience store; or any other building, structure or location or portion thereof, wherein one person directly or indirectly pays another for the purchase or dispensing of kratom or a product containing kratom.
  - b) *Conspicuously posted* means clearly visible, easily readable and immediately apparent upon viewing.
  - c) *Dispense* means the storing, handling, apportionment, preparation, gift, distribution, or serving, directly or indirectly, of any amount of kratom or a product containing kratom to or for any person by any officer, owner, operator, lessee, or employee of a business establishment. For purposes of this definition, permitting or allowing any person to carry kratom or kratom containing products on the premises of any business establishment to be consumed thereon shall constitute "dispensing" of such substances.
  - d) *Person* means an individual, person, firm, joint venture, partnership, corporation, estate, trust, business trust, syndicate, fiduciary, association, and all other groups or combinations.
  - e) Sale means any transfer of kratom or kratom containing products for consideration, or any gift of kratom or kratom containing products in connection with or as a part of a transfer of any property or product for consideration.
  - f) *Vendor of* kratom or kratom containing products means any person who owns or operates a business establishment which sells or dispenses kratom or kratom containing products for consumption on or off the premises.

### Section 2. General Requirements

- a) All persons who own or operate a business establishment in Palm Beach County which sells or dispenses kratom or kratom containing products for consumption on or off the premises shall conspicuously post a notice within said business establishment. Failure to post such required notice pursuant to the requirements of this Section 2, shall constitute a violation of this Ordinance.
- b) Required notice shall consist of one or more signs or notices, each of which is not less than ninety-three square inches (8-1/2"x11"), and be in bold letters. Signs or notices shall be in a font-type as specified below, which contains the following information, clearly discernable by persons to whom kratom or kratom containing products may be sold or dispensed:
  - The word "WARNING" in a rectangular black background Myriad Pro BLACK font uppercase, font size 164 pts.
  - "The DEA has placed KRATOM on its list of Drugs and Chemicals of Concern" centered text Myriad Pro BLACK font lower and upper case, font size 44 pts.
  - 3. "KRATOM is considered highly addictive and has effects on the body including:" in a rectangular black background Myriad Pro BLACK font lower and upper case, font size 42 pts.
  - 4. The terms "Psychosis, Nausea, Respiratory Depression, Delusions, Anorexia, Tremors, and Insomnia" shall each have bullets as justified left text Myriad Pro BLACK font lower and upper case, font size 40 pts.
  - 5. The Palm Beach County logo along with the text "Posted Pursuant to Palm Beach County Code Section XXXXXXXX centered, Myriad Pro BLACK font lower and upper case, font size 22 pts.

### Section 3. Enforcement

It is unlawful to violate any provisions of this Ordinance. Such violations may be enforced by all means available at law including but not limited to enforcement proceedings before Palm Beach County Code Enforcement Special Masters, the prosecution of violations in the name of the State of Florida pursuant to the authority granted by Sec. 125.69, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, or any other lawful actions as are necessary to prevent or remedy

any violation of this Ordinance. Section 4. Severability 2 If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is for any 3 reason held by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, 4 such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance. 5 Section 5. Repeal of Laws in Conflict 6 All local laws and ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this Ordinance are 7 hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. 8 Section 6. Inclusion in the Code of Laws and Ordinances 9 10 The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Palm Beach County Code. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish 11 such, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate 12 13 word. Section 7. Captions 14 The captions, section headings, and section designations used in this Ordinance are for 15 16 convenience only and shall have no effect on the interpretation of the provisions of this Ordinance. 17 Section 8. Applicability 18 19 All provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the unincorporated areas of Palm Beach 20 County, Florida, and to all municipalities within Palm Beach County that elect to have the provisions of this Ordinance apply within their respective jurisdictions. 21 22 Section 9.
