# AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR PROVISION OF RYAN WHITE PART A HIV HEALTH SUPPORT SERVICES

THIS AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR PROVISION OF THE RYAN WHITE PART A HIV HEALTH SUPPORT SERVICES (R2014 0584), made and entered into at West Palm Beach Florida, on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2015 by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, a political subdivision of the State of Florida hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and FoundCare, Inc. hereinafter referred to as the AGENCY, a not-for-profit corporation, entitled to do business in the State of Florida, whose address is 2330 South Congress Avenue, West Palm Beach, Florida 33406.

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the need exists to amend the contract to increase funding for Housing Services.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the above named parties hereby mutually agree that the Contract entered into on May 6, 2014 is hereby amended as follows:

- I. New Work Plan Exhibits "A2" attached hereto shall replace the Work Plan Exhibits "A1" in its entirety.
- II. New Budget Exhibits "B2" attached hereto showing the new total budgets for funding shall replace the New Budget Exhibits "B1" in its entirety.
- **III.** Increase funding for **Housing Services** as follows:
  - Increase **Housing Services** by \$20,300 not to exceed \$89,027.
- **IV.** Total contract not to exceed amount will be \$3,507,423.

#### **OTHER PROVISIONS**

All provisions in the Contract or exhibits to the Contract in conflict with this Second Amendment to the Contract shall be and are hereby changed to conform to this Amendment.

All provisions not in conflict with this Amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the same level as specified in the Contract.
