I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 8 for CD03 South County Water Services Replacement Phase 4 project with Mock Roos and Associates, Inc. (R2014-0826) in the amount of \$149,210.

Summary: On June 3, 2014, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Water Utilities Department (WUD) Engineering/Professional Services Contract with Mock Roos and Associates, Inc. CSA No. 8 provides for services relating to the surveying, design, and permitting of water main replacements in the southwest area of Boca Raton. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15% overall. The contract with Mock Roos and Associates, Inc. provides for SBE participation of 97%. CSA No. 8 includes 100% overall participation. The cumulative SBE participation is 100% overall. Mock Roos and Associates, Inc. is a Palm Beach County company. (WUD Project No. 15-038) District 5 (JM)

Background and Justification: WUD provides potable water service in Sandalfoot Cove and the surrounding area in southwest Boca Raton. The existing water distribution system in this area is over 30 years old and has been experiencing frequent pipe and service line failures. The existing water mains are asbestos cement pipe, undersized and lack fire hydrants. The water service lines to the individual residences are composed of aging polyethylene pipe that is currently failing or leaking. The scope of the project is to replace the water system in this neighborhood with materials currently meeting WUD design and performance standards while decreasing service interruptions to customers and improving fire protection.

PALM BEACH COUNTY WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT ENGINEERING/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

SCOPE OF WORK FOR South County Water Services Replacement Phase 4

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (COUNTY) entered into an agreement entitled Contract for Engineering/ Professional Services - Palm Beach County Utilities Department (CONTRACT) with. Mock, Roos & Associates, Inc. (CONSULTANT) to provide engineering services for various general activities on R2014-0826. This Consultant Service Authorization will be performed under that CONTRACT.

This Consultant Services Authorization encompasses providing services related to the South County Water Services Replacement Phase 4.

BACKGROUND

PBCWUD (WUD) owns and operates the Water Distribution System in Sandalfoot Cove and surrounding area. The WUD has been experiencing frequent pipe failures (both services and mains) in this portion of the system and has implemented a multi-year replacement program. The replacement program has been divided into phases with Phase 3 currently under construction contract. The WUD wishes to proceed with design of Phase 4 which is in close proximity to WTP #9.

The area is immediately west and south of WTP#9 and includes approximately 9,350 lf of 2" galvanized steel, 6", 8", & 12" asbestos cement pipe primarily along SW 65th Avenues between SW 3rd Street and Sandalfoot Blvd. All piping and valves (originally constructed in 1969) do not meet current county standards, are of deteriorated or questionable condition, and require replacement.

This area also contains approximately 200 house service lines that have proven to be unreliable and also require replacement between the watermain and the existing water meter assemblies.

It is the WUD's desire to replace the system with materials currently meeting County design and performance standards and at the same time improve fire protection in this residential neighborhood.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

CONSULTANT shall perform the engineering Scope of Services as described herein.

- A. Mock•Roos will provide engineering and related services and act as the Project's Engineer of Record for the above-described project as more specifically set forth below.
- B. Preliminary Engineering Services:
 1. Meet with the WUD staff to review the scope of the project, general location of proposed improvements, and obtain the WUD's input regarding expectations for the project.
 2. Perform field review of the proposed watermain and water services replacement locations.
 3. Provide a topographic survey of the area in the immediate vicinity of the proposed pipeline routes and provide base maps of the survey data. (Services to be provided by subconsultant.) The topographic survey will provide GPS coordinates for all found existing water meter locations. The topographic survey will consist of field topography and horizontal and vertical locations for the project (approximately 9,350 linear feet of right-of-way) and will include the following:
 - a. Obtain topography at 100-foot intervals and at major ground elevation changes to depict existing ground profile at the proposed project area along streets. This shall be accomplished by creating a baseline in the field to collect pertinent data.
 - b. Locate all visible fixed improvements within the right-of-way or easements of the project limits, including physical objects, roadway pavement, driveways, sidewalks, curb, trees, signs, fences, power poles, buildings, and other encumbrances, including point of curvature and point of tangency.
 - c. Locate of all known above and below ground existing utilities: FPL, AT&T, Cable TV, Natural Gas, Potable Water (valves, fire hydrants, and water meters, including state plane coordinate values on the meter boxes), Force Mains (valves), Sanitary Sewer (pipe diameter, manhole inverts and direction, rim elevations, clean-outs), Reclaimed Water Mains (valves), Storm Sewers (pipe diameter, manhole inverts and direction, catch basins, and rim/grate elevations). Identify platted rights-of-way (including bearing and distances for centerline), lot numbers, addresses, ownership lines (per platted lot lines), block numbers and dedicated easements per the plats.
 - d. Depict elevations along road right-of-way or easement, as appropriate, every 100 feet, at a minimum, to indicate centerline grades, edge of pavement grades and

shoulder grades, low points and all right-of-way or easement lines. Intermediate grades shall be indicated at all grade breaks, driveways, sidewalks and 10 feet beyond R-O-W/easement line.

- e. Provide and reference benchmarks at maximum 600-foot intervals. Elevations to be referenced to an existing established County Benchmark.
 - f. Prepare topographical survey data in AutoCAD Civil 3D (Version 2015) format at a scale of 1"=20'.
- 4. Develop preliminary Pipeline Alignment Plan.
 - 5. Submit base drawings to local utilities for mark-up of their existing utilities. Plot utility locations received on the drawing base sheets. Local utilities include telephone, cable, and gas, as well as Palm Beach County Utilities.
 - 6. Provide subsurface utility targeting service and subsurface utility locating by test hole, maximum test hole 20 locations. (Services to be provided by subconsultant.)
 - 7. Submit preliminary base sheets with utility information included to WUD for review and comment. Consultant will collect, compile, organize, and address all comments in the PBCWUD Quality Review Form Spreadsheet that will be provided by the County.
 - 8. Develop preliminary construction sequencing plan to facilitate construction of proposed improvements while maintaining water service and vehicle access to existing homes during project construction.
 - 9. Meet with WUD staff to review preliminary submittal and respond to questions or comments.

C. Design Phase Services:

- 1. Provide design phase engineering services to develop the details of the replacement watermain and services design.
- 2. Develop one set of construction drawings consisting of a cover sheet, key sheet, plan and profile sheets, and detail sheets. Construction drawings will include depictions of conflict resolutions.
- 3. Prepare technical specifications and a bid form for the project anticipated to be bid as a single project.
- 4. Submit progress drawings at the 60-percent and 90-percent completion for review and comment. Consultant will collect, compile, organize, and address all comments in the PBCWUD Quality Review Form Spreadsheet that will be provided by the County

5. Meet with the WUD after each submittal to review progress drawings, discuss design options, and respond to questions.
6. Estimate quantities and prepare an Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost.
7. Prepare a Health Department and Fire Marshal permit application packages including attachments and submit for approval. (WUD will pay application fees.) Prepare and submit responses to Health Department comments, if required.
8. Prepare a PBC Roadway permit application for utility construction in the PBC right-of-way and submit for approval. (WUD will pay application fees.) Prepare and submit responses to PBC Roadway comments, if required.
9. Provide final design phase deliverables consisting of construction drawings and bid form in paper copies, electronic PDF files, and AutoCAD and word files, if requested.

COMPENSATION

The CONSULTANT shall provide assistance to the County in accordance with the attached budget, for a project total of \$149,210.00. The budget summary is shown in Attachment B.

SBE PARTICIPATION

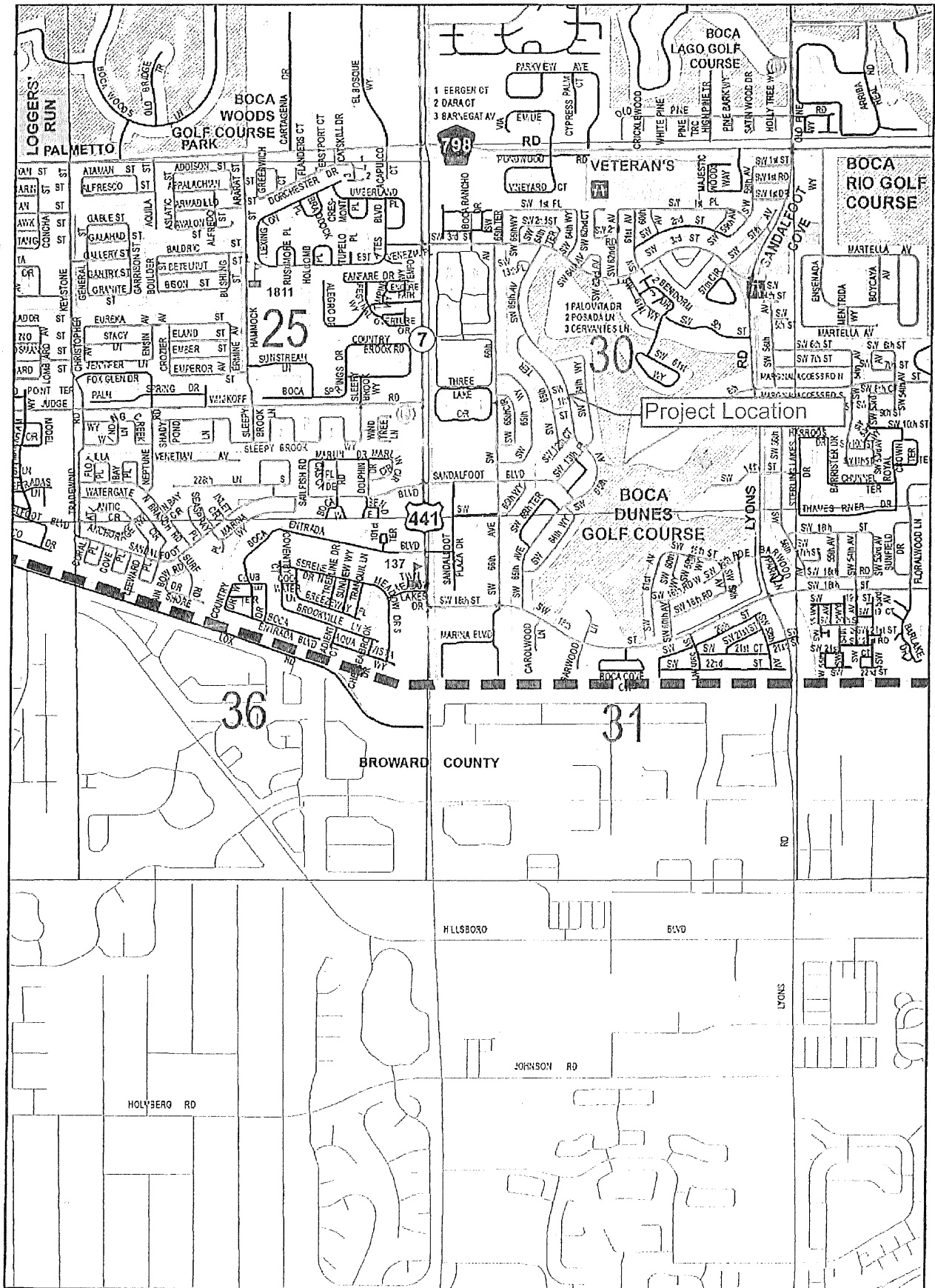

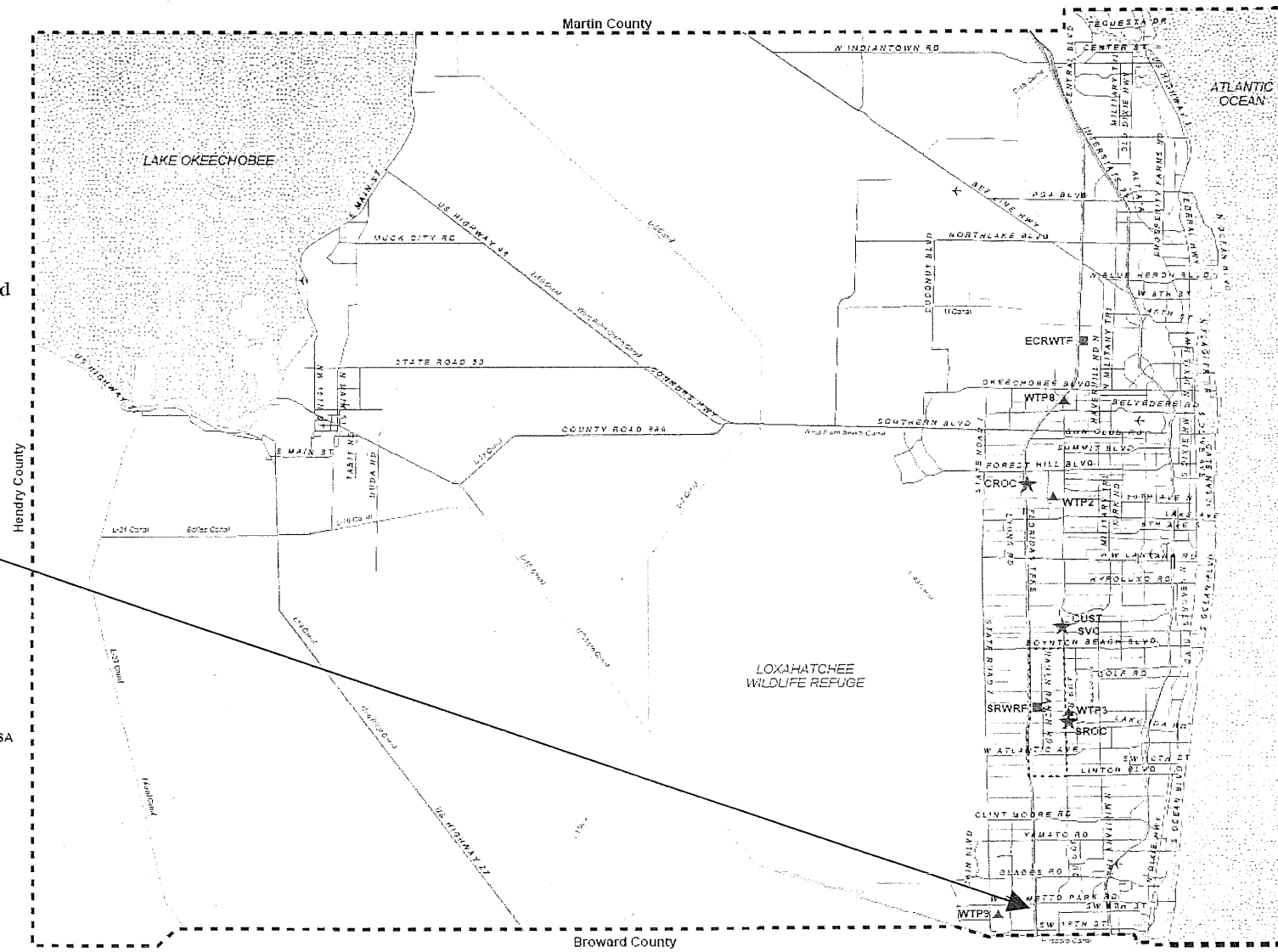
