All the firms have offices in the County. The County advertised for these services in March 2015. When appraisal services are needed under these Agreements, the Engineering Department will request proposals from the firms for each separate project.

appraisal services, are screened and selected by the Engineering Department. On April 1, 2014, the Board approved nine renewal appraiser agreements with the firms to provide right-of-way acquisition appraisal services for the County. The firms have indicated a preference to be placed on the County's pre-qualified appraiser list for a period of three years from May 19, 2015 through May 18, 2018 with two options to renew for one additional year on each option. After a careful review of their qualifications, combined with their record of past performance, staff recommends the approval of the Agreements with the firms. The appropriate representatives of the firms have signed the Agreements.
