<b>Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file:</b> Letter from S. Renée Narloch & Associates, dated May 13, 2015, correcting County Administrator selection rankings for the official record.						
<b>Summary:</b> On Tuesday, May 12, 2015, the Board of County Commissioners interviewed six candidates for the County Administrator position and selected Deputy County Administrator Verdenia Baker to succeed Mr. Weisman upon his retirement. After the results were announced at the end of the day, a recording and tabulation error was noticed. The search consultant, S. Renée Narloch misinterpreted the candidate rankings submitted by Commissioner Priscilla A. Taylor. The corrected rankings <i>do not</i> alter the final results.
