I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: approve payment in an amount not to exceed \$6,500.00 for participation in the Florida Neighborhoods Conference to be held on July 10 and 11, 2015 at the Town of Jupiter Community Center, Jupiter, FL.

Summary: The Office of Community Revitalization (OCR) is participating with the Town of Jupiter, the Florida Neighborhoods Conference, Inc. Board of Directors with the assistance of the Florida Neighborhoods Conference (NFC) State Planning Committee, to present the 19th Annual Florida Neighborhoods Conference. This is the first I Florida Neighborhoods Conference held in Palm Beach County. More than 250 individuals representing hundreds of local governments, homeowners associations, civic groups and neighborhood organizations from around the State of Florida are expected to be at the conference. The County will contribute \$6,500 to participate in, and serve as a sponsor for the conference. Payment will be made on or before June 30, 2015 to Florida Neighborhoods Conference, Inc., the fiscal agent for the conference. The conference will provide community residents with an opportunity to learn about, share, and collaborate with others in the implementation of successful strategies used throughout the state to build stronger communities. **Countywide** (AH).

Background and Justification: On July 10 and 11, 2015, the Florida Neighborhoods Conference (FNC) State Planning Committee will present the 19th Annual Florida Neighborhoods Conference at the Town of Jupiter Community Center, Jupiter, FL. Established in 1997, the mission of the Florida Neighborhoods Conference is to provide statewide leadership in the development of sustainable communities by advocating excellence in education, development for its members, and working to protect and enhance the natural and built environments.

Participants will have the opportunity to attend a wide range of workshops and hear dynamic speakers on topics such as leadership, neighborhood revitalization, emergency preparedness, youth engagement, fundraising, and sustainability. Representatives from local governments around the state will join this celebration of neighborhoods and community. The FNC State Planning Committee is currently comprised of representatives from Hillsborough, Manatee, Orange, and Sarasota counties, and the cities of Fort Lauderdale, Jupiter, Melbourne, Orlando, Pensacola St. Petersburg, Tallahassee, and Tampa. Each entity contributes in different ways through technical assistance, funding and consolidated resources. The County's sponsorship of, and participation in the conference will enable the OCR to increase residents' access to additional community development and leadership training opportunities, share and market its community services and programs, and develop an ongoing partnership with Florida Neighborhoods Conference, Inc.
