RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF FEES AND FINES FOR THE DIVISION OF ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL AND REPEALING RESOLUTION R2011-0849.

WHEREAS, pursuant to its authority, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners has enacted Palm Beach County Animal Care and Control Ordinance 98-22, as amended (the "Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance imposes certain fines for noncompliance and provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall by resolution establish the amount of such fines;

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Division of Animal Care and Control (ACC) imposes certain fees for sheltering and other services; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to revise the fees and fines to be imposed by ACC; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to repeal the previous resolution establishing such fees and fines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- A. The schedule of fines and fees attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted and shall be effective immediately.
 - B. Resolution R2011-0849 is hereby repealed.
