Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- a contract with Coston Marine Services, Inc. (Coston) in the amount of \$125,995.94 for the construction of the Intracoastal Road Seawall Repair (Project);
- a budget transfer of \$155,000 in the General Fund from Contingency Reserves to the Capital B) Outlay Fund, and
- a budget amendment of \$155,000 in the Capital Outlay Fund to recognize the transfer and C) appropriate it to the Project.

SUMMARY: Approval of this contract, budget transfer, and budget amendment, will allow Palm Beach County to issue a notice to proceed to Coston, a Palm Beach County company, to begin construction of the Project. The Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for all projects is 15% overall. The SBE participation proposed for the Project by Coston is 56.99%.

Background and Justification: Bids for the Project were received by the Engineering Department on April 21, 2015. Coston was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The Office of Small Business Assistance issued its evaluation on May 12, 2015. Time to complete all work under this contract shall be no more than 90 calendar days.



This Contract, made this _____ day of ______, A.D. 2015, by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida, (hereinafter "County"), and Coston Marine Services, Inc., of Jupiter, Florida, and their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, (hereinafter "Contractor"):

WITNESSETH: The Contractor agrees with the County, for the consideration herein mentioned at their own proper cost and expense to do all the work and furnish all necessary labor, materials, equipment, machinery, tools, apparatus, services, state workmen's compensation and unemployment compensation taxes incurred in the performance of the contract, and means of transportation for the complete construction of:

in Palm Beach County, Florida, in the manner and to the full extent as set forth in the Contract Documents therefore and the Contract Documents relative thereto, are made a part of this Agreement as completely as if set forth herein, to the satisfaction of the County, or its duly authorized representative.

The Contractor further agrees for the consideration herein mentioned to commence the work with adequate forces and equipment within <u>fourteen (14) calendar days</u> of the date set forth in the "Notice to Proceed". The time limit for the completion of all work under this contract shall be <u>(90) calendar days</u>, <u>(see Special Provisions)</u>. The date fixing this period upon the calendar shall be established and stated in the "Notice to Proceed". After commencement of the work, it shall be properly dispatched toward completion, to the satisfaction of the Engineer, and shall be fully completed within the time limit. It is understood and agreed that the time limit for completion of said work is the essence of the contract and should the Contractor fail to complete the work within the time limit, it is agreed that for such calendar day that any work provided for in these Contract Documents shall remain incomplete after the time limit has expired, including any official extension of the time limit; the sum per day given in the contained schedules shall be deducted from monies due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages (in accordance with Section 8-10.2 of the Standard Specifications) and added expense for supervision.

The Contractor shall take into account all contingent work which has to be done by other parties arising from any cause whatsoever, and shall not plead his want of knowledge of such contingent work as an excuse for delay in his work, or for its non-performance.


