I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion: A) Receive and File a Modification #1 to Subgrant Agreement between the Division of Emergency Management and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office amending a FY14 State Homeland Security Grant to provide an additional \$21,250 in reimbursable funding; and **B) Approve** a budget amendment of \$21,250 in the Sheriff's Grant Fund.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners accepted this grant for \$85,000 on April 21, 2015 (R-2015-0520). This agenda item will increase the grant award to include an additional \$21,250 in reimbursable funding. These funds will be used for direct homeland security initiatives. There is no match associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. <u>Countywide</u> (JB)

MODIFICATION #1 TO SUBGRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND PALM BEACH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

This Modification is made and entered into by and between the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management ("the Division"), and Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office ("Recipient"), to modify Contract Number **15-DS-P4-10-60-23-388**, which began on March 05, 2015 ("the Agreement").

WHEREAS, the Division and the Recipient have entered into the Agreement, pursuant to which the Division has provided a subgrant to Recipient under the State Homeland Security Grant program of <u>\$85,000.00;</u>

WHEREAS, the Division and the Recipient desire to modify the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of funds by \$21,250.00.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 17(a) of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - (17) FUNDING/CONSIDERATION
 - (a) This is a cost-reimbursement Agreement. The Recipient shall be reimbursed for costs incurred in the satisfactory performance of work hereunder in an amount not to exceed <u>\$106,250.00</u> subject to availability of funds.
- 2. The funds to be disbursed under this Agreement are increased by the sum of <u>\$21,250.00</u>, so that the total funding hereunder is <u>\$106,250.00</u>. The funds subgranted to the Recipient under this Modification must be used in accordance with the following requirements as outlined in the Agreement.
- 3. The Budget and Scope of Work, Attachment A to the Agreement, is hereby modified as set forth in 1st Revised Attachment A to this Modification, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. All provisions of the Agreement being modified and any attachments thereto in conflict with this Modification shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this Modification, effective as of the date of the last execution of this Modification by both parties.
- 5. All provisions not in conflict with this Modification remain in full force and effect,
