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Background and Justification: Since 1996, Gulfstream Goodwill Industries, Inc. has partnered with the County in the provision of services to the homeless. Since 1998, these contracts continue to fund case management services and match in support of the HUD funded Supportive Housing Program, which has been received annually. On May 1, 2007, the Board of County Commissioners established the Homeless Advisory Board to develop a Ten-Year Plan to End Homelessness in Palm Beach County (Ten-Year Plan). The BCC formally adopted the Ten-Year Plan in September 2008. Homeless individuals and families receive a diverse offering of high quality services from three community agencies, assisting clients in ending their homelessness. Services are available to Palm Beach County's homeless adults and families on a 24-hour basis, 365 days per year.
