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I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends Motion to Adopt: An Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, amending the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics, Ordinance 2011-11, amending Section 2-444(f) to provide the requirement to contemporaneously file a copy of the State Gift Law Report with the Palm Beach County Commission on Ethics; Providing for a Savings Clause; Providing for Repeal of Laws in Conflict; Providing for Severability; Providing for Inclusion in the Code of Laws and Ordinances; and Providing for an Effective Date.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners adopted the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics as a countywide Ordinance in May of 2011, in accordance with the County Charter. The Charter amendments, which were approved by the voters in November 2010, also called for the establishment of a drafting committee to review and recommended proposed changes to the Code of Ethics. This amendment was proposed by the Commission on Ethics and recommended for approval by the ordinance drafting committee. The amendment specifies that those who file state-required gift reports must contemporaneously file a copy of that report with the Palm Beach County Commission on Ethics. Countywide (LB)

Background and Policy Issues: The Palm Beach County Code of Ethics applies to all county and municipal officials and employees, lobbyists, their principals and employers, and vendors. This amendment only impacts those who are already required by the state to file quarterly gift reports.

1 AN **ORDINANCE OF** THE **BOARD OF COUNTY** 2 COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, 3 AMENDING THE PALM BEACH COUNTY CODE OF ETHICS, 4 ORDINANCE 2011-11, AMENDING SECTION 2-444(f) TO 5 PROVIDE THE REQUIREMENT TO CONTEMPORANEOUSLY FILE A COPY OF THE STATE GIFT LAW REPORT WITH THE 6 7 **COUNTY PALM BEACH COMMISSION** ON PROVIDING FOR SAVINGS 8 CLAUSE; PROVIDING REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; 9 **PROVIDING** SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE 10 OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN 11 12 EFFECTIVE DATE. 13 WHEREAS, based on a referendum on November 2, 2010, concerning proposed 14 amendments to the Palm Beach County Charter, a majority of voters in the County and in every 15 municipality in Palm Beach County elected to require the Board of County Commissioners to 16 17 adopt an ordinance to establish a countywide Commission on Ethics with the authority to review, interpret, render advisory opinions and to enforce the countywide Palm Beach County Code of 18 Ethics and to provide ethics training for the benefit of local governments, citizens groups and the 19 general public; and 20 WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners adopted the Palm 21 Beach County Code of Ethics Ordinance, Ordinance 2011-11 on May 17, 2011; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that amending the Code of Ethics Ordinance as set forth herein will clarify certain gift reporting requirements; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners further finds that this amendment 26 advances the purposes and intent of the Palm Beach County Charter amendments approved by the electorate on November 2, 2010; and 27 28 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, pursuant to its authority under Florida Constitution, Article VIII, Section 1(g), Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, 29 and the Palm Beach County Charter, hereby adopts this amendment to Palm Beach County Code 30 of Ethics Ordinance; and 31 32 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has conducted a duly noticed public 33 hearing to consider these amendments as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

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- **Part 1.** Section 2-444(f) is amended as follows:
- 37 (f) Gift Reports. Any official or employee who receives a gift in excess of one hundred dollars
- 38 (\$100) shall report that gift in accordance with this section.
- 39 (1) Gift reports for officials and employees indentified by state law as reporting
- 40 individuals. Those persons required to report gifts pursuant to state law shall report those gifts in
- 41 the manner provided by Florida Statutes, §112.3148, as may be amended. When a state
- 42 <u>reporting individual files a gift report with the state,</u> a copy of each report shall <u>also</u> be filed
- 43 <u>contemporaneously</u> with the county commission on ethics.

44 Part 2. Savings Clause.

- 45 All complaints, investigations, advisory opinions, recommended orders, final orders,
- 46 requests for advisory opinions, hearing processes, and all other functions of the Palm Beach
- County Commission on Ethics, initiated or completed pursuant to Ordinances 2011-10, 2011-11,
- or 2011-39, as may be amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

Part 3. Repeal of Laws in Conflict.

- All local laws and ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby
- 51 repealed to the extent of such conflict.

52 Part 4. Severability.

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- If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is for any
- reason held by the Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect
- 55 the remainder of this Ordinance.

Part 5. Inclusion in the Code of Laws and Ordinances.

- The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Laws
- 58 and Ordinances of Palm Beach County, Florida. The sections of this Ordinance may be
- renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to
- "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Part 6. Effective Date.

- The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the State of
- 63 Florida Department of State.
