### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

# Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) The first amendment to the construction materials testing, geotechnical engineering & inspection annual contract, with Dunkelberger Engineering & Testing, Inc. (DET), R2014-1662, whose original contract was dated November 18, 2014;
- **B)** The first amendment to the construction materials testing, geotechnical engineering & inspection annual contract with Professional Service Industries, Inc. (PSI), R2014-1663, whose original contract was dated November 18, 2014; and
- **C)** The first amendment to the construction materials testing, geotechnical engineering & inspection annual contract, with Radise International, L.C. (Radise), R2014-1661, whose original contract was dated November 18, 2014.

**SUMMARY:** Approval of these first amendments will extend the expiration dates from November 17, 2015 to November 17, 2016. This will extend the required professional services for one year, on a task order basis, to the construction materials testing, geotechnical engineering & inspection annual contracts. The amendments with DET, PSI and Radise will also adjust the fee schedule as allowed in the original contracts. These amendments are the first renewals of



WHEREAS, this is the first of the two allowable one (1) year term CONTRACT extensions per section 4.1; and

WHEREAS, by this amendment, the CONSULTANT and the COUNTY mutually agree to amend the CONTRACT terms to extend the expiration date of the CONTRACT from November 17, 2015 to November 17, 2016, with all original terms, conditions and unit prices adhered to; and

WHEREAS, the original CONTRACT provides in section 5.3.2 that the rates may be adjusted by negotiation; and
