On April 21, 2015, the BOCC received and filed an agenda item increasing the grant award by \$124,470 (R-2015-0518). On June 23, 2015, the BOCC received and filed an agenda item increasing the grant award by \$31,902 (R-2015-0810). This modification will provide an additional \$22,000 in reimbursable funding to support a Drug Awareness Education Program in partnership with the Palm Beach County Substance Awareness Coalition and the Palm Beach Narcotics Task Force. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. Countywide (JB)
