Summary: Palm Beach County Ordinance 89-31, as amended in 2002, established the Construction Board of Adjustment and Appeals (the "Board"). A memo requesting a nomination for a new regular citizen at large appointment was sent to the Board of County Commissioners on September 17, 2015. Commissioner Steven Abrams, Commissioner Melissa McKinlay, Commissioner Priscilla Taylor, Mayor Shelley Vana and Vice Mayor Mary Lou Berger have nominated Margie Walden for a term of three years. Ms. Walden is currently serving as an alternate member on the Board. Per Palm Beach County Ordinance 2015-028, Palm Beach County Amendments to the Florida Building Code, 5th Edition (2014), the Board is comprised of nine regular members: one architect; one engineer; two Division 1 contractors (general, building, or residential contractors); one electrical contractor; one HVAC contractor; one plumbing contractor; a member at large from the public; and any other contractor licensed category. In addition to these members, there should be two alternate members: one member with the qualifications referenced above; and one member at large from the public. This advisory committee membership has 11 seats, 9 currently filled, and a diversity count of White: 9 (100%). The gender ratio (male:female) is 8:1. Countywide (SF)

Background and Justification: The Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals shall have the power, as further defined in Section 113.3 of the Palm Beach County Amendments to the Florida Building Code, to hear appeals of decisions and interpretations of the Building Official, and consider variances of the technical codes. The Board shall establish rules and regulations for its own procedures consistent with the provisions of this code. The Board shall meet on call of the Chairman. The Board shall meet within 30 calendar days after Notice of Appeal has been received.

Margie J. Walden currently serves on the Palm Beach County Sports Commission and is the Chair of the Strategic Planning Committee. She also serves on the Delray Beach Sports Destination Committee where she was instrumental in helping to secure for Delray Beach the 2014 and 2015 NAIA Men's National Soccer Championships and the 2014 LPGA Legends Tour's Walgreens Charity Championship. She also serves on the Palm Beach County Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals and is a Commission member of the Allegany Franciscan Ministries, Inc. for Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie Counties.

Margie is a strong supporter of democracy and human rights and also worked at the United Nations representing Indigenous people from Central America. She has traveled extensively throughout Europe, the Americas and Asia.

Margie has also held leadership positions at the headquarters of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers and Girl Scouts of the USA.

She is a magna cum laude graduate of the University of Buffalo. She studied Landscape Architecture at SUNY College of Forestry and received diplomatic training at the Institute of Multi-Track Diplomacy in Washington, DC.



ITEM: The Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals (CBAA) has an unfilled regular vacant seat #9 that requires a new appointment. The requirement for the seat is to be a member from the public at large. The Building Division has received one application from our current member Margie Walden, who has previously served as an alternate member. Ms. Walden's term as an alternate member expires on October 6, 2015.

BACKGROUND: The Palm Beach County Amendments to the Florida Building Code, 5th Edition (2014) were adopted on July 27, 2015. In those amendments, the membership of the CBAA was modified to be comprised of 11 members, adding a new seat for a regular member at large from the public. All members of the CBAA are appointed by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners. Terms of office for regular members are for three years and the alternate members serve for one year. In addition, CBAA members are now limited to a maximum of three consecutive, three-year terms.

DISPOSITION: The application and resume for the candidate are attached for your review. If you have an additional nomination for this seat, please have the information included on the attached blank form provided. Please return your nomination to the Building Division before October 5, 2015. Staff will prepare an Agenda Item for the November 3, 2015, BCC meeting.

to disconnecting, the owner or occupant of the building, structure, or service system shall be notified in writing, as soon as practical thereafter.

SECTION 113 CONSTRUCTION BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND APPEALS

113.1 Appointment. There is hereby established a board to be called the Construction Board of Adjustment and Appeals, which shall consist of nine regular members and two alternates. The applicable governing body shall appoint the Board.

113.2 Membership and Terms.

- 113.2.1 Membership. The Construction Board of Adjustment and Appeals shall consist of nine regular members plus two alternate members. Regular board members shall be composed of individuals with knowledge and experience in the technical codes to include, to the greatest extent possible, an architect, engineer, two Division I contractors (GC, BC, or RC), electrical contractor, HVAC contractor, plumbing contractor, a member at large from the public, and any other contractor licensed category. In addition to the regular members, there should be two alternate members, one member with the qualifications referenced above and one member at large from the public. A board member shall not act in a case in which he or she has a personal or financial interest.
- 113.2.2 Terms. The terms of office of the regular board members shall be for three (3) years and staggered so no more than one-third of the board is appointed or replaced in any 12-month period. The two alternates shall serve three-year terms. Vacancies shall be filled for an unexpired term in the manner in which original appointments are required to be made. No board member shall be appointed or reappointed to this board for more than three (3) consecutive, three (3) year terms.
- **113.2.3 Quorum and voting.** A simple majority of the board shall constitute a quorum. In varying any provision of this code, the affirmative votes of the majority present, but not less than three affirmative votes, shall be required. In modifying a decision of the building official, not less than four affirmative votes, but not less than a majority of the board, shall be required. In the event that regular members are unable to attend a meeting, the alternate members shall vote.
- **113.2.4 Secretary of board.** The building official or his/her authorized representative shall act as secretary of the board and shall make a record of all of its proceedings, which shall set forth the reasons for its decision, the vote of each member, the absence of a member, and any failure of a member to vote.
- 113.2.5 Removal from office. Members shall be automatically removed for lack of attendance. Lack of attendance is defined as a failure to attend three (3) consecutive meetings or a failure to attend more than one-half of the meetings scheduled during a calendar year. Participation for less than three-fourths of a meeting shall be the same as a failure to attend a meeting. Members removed pursuant to this provision shall not continue to serve on the board and such removal shall create a vacancy.

113.3 Powers. The Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals shall have the power, as further defined in 113.4 of this code, to hear appeals of decisions and interpretations of the building official and consider variances of the technical codes.

113.4 Appeals.

- 113.4.1 Decision of the building official. The owner of a building, structure or service system, or duly authorized agent, may appeal a decision of the building official to the Construction Board of Adjustment and Appeals whenever any one of the following conditions are claimed to exist:
- 1. The building official rejected or refused to approve the mode or manner of construction proposed to be followed or materials to be used in the installation or alteration of a building, structure or service system.
- 2. The provisions of this code do not apply to this specific case.
- 3. That an equally good or more desirable form of installation can be employed in any specific case, which the building official has rejected or refused.
- 4. The true intent and meaning of this code or any of the regulations hereunder have been misconstrued or incorrectly interpreted.
- **113.4.2 Variances.** The Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals, when upon written request, has been so appealed to and after a hearing, may vary the application of any provision of this code to any particular case when, in its opinion, the enforcement thereof would do manifest injustice and would be contrary to the spirit and purpose of this or the technical codes or public interest, and also finds all of the following:
- 1. That special conditions and circumstances exist which are peculiar to the building, structure or service system involved and which are not applicable to others.
- 2. That the special conditions and circumstances do not result from the action or inaction of the applicant.
- 3. That granting the variance requested will not confer on the applicant any special privilege that is denied by this code to other buildings, structures or service system.
- 4. That the variance granted is the minimum variance that will make possible the reasonable use of the building, structure or service system.
- 5. That the grant of the variance will be in harmony with the general intent and purpose of this code and will not be detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare.
 - **113.4.2.1 Conditions of the variance.** In granting the variance, the board may prescribe a reasonable time limit within which the action for which the variance is required shall be commenced or completed or both. In addition, the board may prescribe appropriate conditions and safeguards in conformity with this code. Violation of the conditions of a variance shall be deemed a violation of this code.

- **113.4.3 Notice of appeal.** Notice of appeal shall be in writing and filed within 30 calendar days after the building official renders the decision. Appeals shall be in a form acceptable to the building official.
- **113.4.4 Unsafe or dangerous buildings or service systems.** In the case of a building, structure or service system, which in the opinion of the building official, is unsafe, unsanitary or dangerous, the building official may, in the order, limit the time for such appeals to a shorter period.

113.5 Procedures of the board.

- 113.5.1 Rules and regulations. The board shall establish rules and regulations for its own procedure not inconsistent with the provisions of this code. The board shall meet on call of the chairperson, subsequent to a request to call a meeting by the secretary. The board shall meet within 30 calendar days after notice of appeal has been received.
 - 113.5.1.1 Rules of Evidence. Formal rules of evidence shall not apply, but fundamental due process should be observed and govern the proceedings. Upon determination by the chairperson, irrelevant, immaterial, or unduly repetitious evidence may be excluded, but all other evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonable, prudent persons in the conduct of their affairs shall be admissible, whether or not such evidence would be admissible in a trial in the courts of Florida. Any part of the evidence may be received in written form. The Board may request certain evidence from the petitioner to be provided by an architect or engineer registered in the State of Florida, in which case, said evidence shall be signed, sealed, and dated.
 - **113.5.1.2 Testimony.** Any member of the Board or the attorney representing the Board may inquire of, or question, any witness before the Board. Any member of the Board, the petitioner or his/her attorney, and/or the building official shall be permitted to inquire of any witness before the Board. The Board may consider testimony presented by the building official, the petitioner, or any other witness.
- 113.5.2 Decisions. The Construction Board of Adjustment and Appeals shall, in every case, reach a decision without unreasonable or unnecessary delay. Each decision of the board shall also include the reasons for the decision. If a decision of the board reverses or modifies a refusal, order, or disallowance of the building official or varies the application of any provision of this code, the building official shall immediately take action in accordance with such decision. Every decision shall be promptly filed in writing in the office of the building official and shall be open to public inspection. A certified copy of the decision shall be sent by mail or otherwise to the appellant and a copy shall be kept publicly posted in the office of the building official for two weeks after filing. Every decision of the board shall be final; subject however to such remedy as any aggrieved party might have at law or in equity.
- 113.6 Local Construction Regulation Board. The local government may also utilize this Board to convene as the Local Construction Regulation Board (LCRB), as provided in Florida Statute 489.113. The LCRB may deny, suspend, revoke or limit the authority of a certified contractor to obtain a building permit or permit with specific

conditions, if the LCRB has found such contractor, through public hearing, to be guilty of fraud or a willful building code violation within the county or municipality that the LCRB represents. The LCRB may also, deny, suspend, revoke or limit the authority of a certified contractor to obtain a building permit or permit with specific conditions, if

it has proof through the public hearing process, that a contractor has been found guilty in another county or municipality within the past 12 months, of fraud or a willful building code violation and after providing notice of an opportunity to be heard to the contractor, finds that such fraud or violation would have been fraud or a violation if committed in the county or municipality that the LCRB represents. Notification of and information concerning such permit denial shall be submitted to the division within 15 days after the LCRB decides to deny the permit.

SECTION 114 VIOLATIONS

Any person, firm, corporation or agent who shall violate a provision of this code, or fail to comply therewith, or with any of the requirements thereof, or who shall erect, construct, alter, install, demolish or move any structure, electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, or part thereof, or has erected, constructed, altered, repaired, moved or demolished a building, structure, electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, or part thereof, without full compliance with applicable codes, laws, ordinances, rules and regulations, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Each such person shall be considered guilty of a separate offense for each and every day or portion thereof during which any violation of any of the provisions of applicable codes, laws, ordinances, rules and regulations is committed or continued, and upon conviction of any such violation such person shall be punished within the limits and as provided by state laws. Nothing in this section shall prevent the authority having jurisdiction from imposing fines, liens, or seek injunctive relief, or exercising other enforcement powers as permitted by law. Code enforcement and penalties of Chapter 162 Florida Statutes Part I shall be authorized if building work begins without payment of all required fees, and for the purposes of enforcing this code, code officials licensed under Florida Statute 468 Part XII are deemed "Code Inspectors," as defined in Florida Statute 162.04.

SECTION 115 STOP WORK ORDER

115.1Authority. Whenever the building official finds any work regulated by this code being performed in a manner either contrary to the provisions of this code, or in a dangerous or unsafe manner, the building official is authorized to issue a stop work order.

115.2 Issuance. The stop work order shall be in writing and shall be given to the owner of the property involved, or to the owner's agent, or to the person doing the work. Upon issuance of a stop work order, the cited work shall immediately cease. The stop work order shall state the reason for the order, and the conditions under which the cited work will be permitted to resume. Where an emergency exists, the building official shall not be required to give a written notice prior to stopping the work.

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
