We offer low-income, at-risk students one-on-one mentorship, college readiness services, anti-crime/drug workshops, full-tuition college scholarships, post-secondary retention and hope for a brighter future. Our comprehensive services start in middle school, continue through high school and remain through post-secondary schooling. Students are given two research-driven factors for the prevention of crime & drugs: a positive role model and a guaranteed post-secondary education.

What results are you committed to achieving?

With a 98% success rate, the program has effectively provided a pathway to success for low-income, at-risk youth by providing students with the resources they need to remain crime & drug free, escape poverty, and attain post-secondary education.

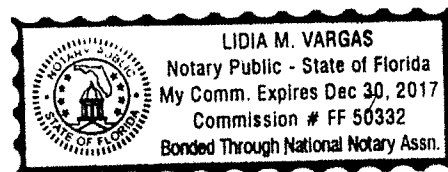

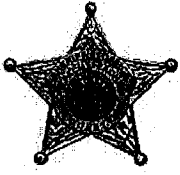

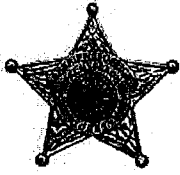
Clinics Can Help was founded in 2005 by Owen O'Neill, who while working as a hospice nurse, recognized that there was a wealth of durable medical equipment (DME) and supplies that were no longer needed but could and should be redistributed to those who could not afford it and would benefit from it.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

Annually 100's of families in PBC communities find they have no crib in which to put their new borns to sleep. Regretfully this has caused serious injuries for some new borns who roll off of adult beds/couches and this has resulted in deaths of some. In response to this CCH and working in partnership with the FL Dept. of Children and Families initiated CRIBS (Cribs 'R for Infant & Baby safety. With DCF safe sleep education and CCH cribs (GRACO Pack 'n Play™ portable cribs) families are able to provide cribs for their newborns. CCH is requesting support from PBC Sherriff's Office to buy cribs as they provide safe spaces for babies to sleep which will minimize eliminates injuries and actually saves lives. CCH provides "onesies" with safe sleeping messages to be worn by the newborns.

What results are you committed to achieving?

1. 100% of the families who use these cribs will learn how to put their new borns to sleep safely.
2. All families will have cribs which minimize the chances of injuries and possibly death as a result of the use of these cribs.
3. Deaths of infants under the age of 1 due to not having safe places to sleep and which had been the number one reason for infant deaths in 2011, will be eliminated by those who are trained how to put their new borns to sleep safely and also receive these cribs.



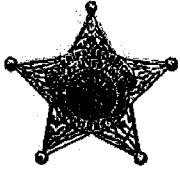
