### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement with the City of Belle Glade in an amount not-to-exceed \$667,514 for funding of the Belle Glade Marina Project – Phase II to change the project scope to include additional asphalt resurfacing and to upgrade the campground electrical system, and extend the project completion date from January 15, 2016, to June 30, 2016.

**Summary:** This Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement R2013-0938, as amended by R2014-0297, provides for a scope change to include additional asphalt resurfacing, an upgrade to the campground electrical system and a five (5) month extension to the project completion date from January 15, 2016, to June 30, 2016. This Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement was requested by the City of Belle Glade to allow them additional time for project completion due to the change in project scope. All other terms of the Interlocal Agreement including funding not-to-exceed \$667,514 remain the same. Funding is from the 2002 \$50 Million Recreation and Cultural Facilities Bond. <u>District 6 (PK)</u>

**Background and Justification:** In 2007, the City of Belle Glade was allocated \$3 Million for designing and constructing improvements to its public marina located on Torry Island. Torry Island also offers opportunities to provide passive and active recreational activities, including boating, fishing, picnicking, camping, canoeing and kayaking, nature trails, hiking, and air boating. On August 21, 2007, the Board approved an Interlocal Agreement R2007-1362 for Phase I and the City was reimbursed \$2,453,486.54, leaving a balance of \$546,514 available for Phase II. The City completed Phase I in 2012, and is currently working on Phase II.

On July 16, 2013, the Board entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Belle Glade for the marina improvements an amount not to exceed \$546,514. Funding was allocated from 2002 \$50 Million General Obligation Waterfront Access Bond (\$517,514) and the Florida Boating Improvement Program (FBIP) reserves (\$29,000). On March 11, 2014, the Board approved a First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Belle Glade to reallocate an additional \$150,000 in funding from within the \$25 Million General Obligation Recreational and Cultural Facilities Bond Fund from South Bay RV and Recreation Center. Total funding provided to the City of Belle Glade was \$667,514. Due to the changes in project scope, the City has requested a project extension to complete the project by June 30, 2016.

The Amendment has been executed on behalf of the City of Belle Glade, and now needs to be approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

# SECOND AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF BELLE GLADE FOR FUNDING OF THE BELLE GLADE MARINA PROJECT – PHASE II

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT is entered into on \_\_\_\_\_\_, by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and the CITY OF BELLE GLADE, a Florida Municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "MUNICIPALITY".

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2013, COUNTY entered into an Interlocal Agreement with MUNICIPALITY (R-2013-0938) as amended on March 11, 2014 (R-2014-0297) to provide funding in an amount not-to-exceed \$667,514 for construction of Phase II improvements to the Belle Glade Marina (the "Project") to be completed on or before the Projection Completion Date of January 15, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, MUNICIPALITY has requested that the COUNTY approve changes to the approved project description; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY has requested that this change be reflected in a revised Project Description and Conceptual Site Plan (Exhibit A2); and

WHEREAS, MUNICIPALITY has requested an extension to the Project completion date until June 30, 2016 in order to complete the Project and provide reimbursement documentation to COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, both parties desire to amend the Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, entering into this second amendment serves a public purpose

**NOW THEREFORE**, the parties hereby agree as follows:


- 1. Section 1.03 of the Interlocal Agreement shall be amended to <u>delete</u> "COUNTY will pay to MUNICIPALITY a total amount not to exceed \$667,514 for the construction of the Project as more fully described in the Project Description, Conceptual Site Plan, and Cost Estimate attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A1"." and to <u>insert</u> "COUNTY will pay to MUNICIPALITY a total amount not to exceed \$667,514 for the construction of the Project as more fully described in the Project Description, Conceptual Site Plan, and Cost Estimate attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A2"."
- 2. All references to Exhibit "A1" in Amendment R-2014-0297 shall be replaced with Exhibit "A2".
- 3. All references to thirty (30) months in Agreement R-2013-0938 shall be replaced with thirty-five (35) months.

- 4. Section 5.01 of the Interlocal Agreement shall be amended to <u>delete</u> "MUNICIPALITY warrants that the Project shall serve a waterfront access purpose and be open to and benefit all residents of Palm Beach County and shall be available thereto on the same cost and availability basis as to residents of MUNICIPALITY. MUNICIPALITY shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, national origin, age, disability, religion, ancestry, marital status, familial, sexual orientation, or gender identity and expression with respect to use of the Project." and to <u>insert</u> "MUNICIPALITY warrants that the Project shall serve a waterfront access purpose and be open to and benefit all residents of Palm Beach County and shall be available thereto on the same cost and availability basis as to residents of MUNICIPALITY. MUNICIPALITY shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, national origin, age, disability, religion, ancestry, marital status, familial, sexual orientation, or gender identity and expression or genetic information with respect to use of the Project."
- 5. Except as provided herein, each and every other term of this Interlocal Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect and the Interlocal Agreement is reaffirmed as modified herein.

Thank you and your staff for your quick response to our September 23<sup>rd</sup> letter regarding the modification of the scope of work to the Belle Glade Marina Improvement – Phase II project.

Mr. Raymond has notified the City that both the additional resurfacing and the campground electrical system upgrade will be considered changes in scope and will require BCC approval. It is my understanding that the earliest possible BCC agenda for approval would be the November 17<sup>th</sup> meeting.
